Preview

The Stetson Hatters hit the road for the first time in over a month with a three-game series at the Lipscomb Lady Bisons. The teams will play a doubleheader at 2 p.m. ET Saturday and a single game at 12 p.m. ET Sunday.

The All-Time Series

Stetson leads the all-time series 20-18 over Lipscomb. The Hatters won three of the four meetings last year, and two of the three meetings at Draper Diamond in 2015. Overall, the series is tied 7-7 at Draper Diamond.

Head Coach Frank Griffin

Stetson's Frank Griffin is in his 21st season as head coach of the Hatters and holds a school record of 696-443 (.611). Griffin is in his 28th season overall with a career record of 921-530 (.635).

Frank Griffin Among NCAA's Best

On Feb. 10, Frank Griffin became 47th coach in NCAA history and 29th coach in NCAA Division I history to record 900 career wins. He is five wins shy of 700 at Stetson.

Team Run Production

- ▶ Stetson ranks 16th in the NCAA in scoring (6.3)
- ▶ Stetson ranks second the ASUN in runs scored (203)
- ▶ The Hatters have already surpassed last year's runs total (195) in just 32 games
- ▶ The Hatters have had 20 innings of 4+ runs
- ▶ The Hatters have scored double-digit runs nine times this season

Team Stolen Bases

Stetson ranks third in the NCAA with 102 stolen bases:

- 112 - Marshall
- 105 - UT Martin
- 102 - Stetson
- 94 - Akron and Southeastern La.

The Hatters have already reached the 100-steal mark for the second year in a row and for the fourth time in school history.

Two hits from 200

Senior Jessie TenBroeck needs just two more hits to become the sixth player in school history with 200 hits.

Individual Stolen Bases

Senior Jessie TenBroeck is second in the NCAA with 37 stolen bases:

- 38 - Kelly Kapp (Bradley)
- 37 - Jessie TenBroeck (STET)
- 36 - Elicia D'Orazio (Marshall)

TenBroeck leads the NCAA with a 1.16 steals-per-game average.

More NCAA Leaders

Linda Ross ranks 14th in the NCAA in runs-per-game (1.13), Kelsey Waters ranks fourth in triples (6) and 24th in steals-per-game (0.69).

ASUN Team Leaders

Stetson leads all teams in the ASUN in on-base pct. (.403), walks (135 and stolen bases (102).

Stetson Runs Record

On March 15, Jessie TenBroeck set a new all-time school record for most career runs scored with her 142nd run. She now has 146 runs scored.

Stetson Stolen Bases Record

With her four steals against Savannah State on Feb. 12, senior Jessie TenBroeck not only eclipsed the 100-steal mark, but she broke the school's all-time record with her 103rd career stolen base. She now has 131 stolen bases.

ASUN Stolen Bases Record

Jessie TenBroeck is five steals shy of tying Brittany Elmore for the all-time ASUN record for stolen bases: 136 - Brittany Elmore (Lip), 2013-16

When Leading After Six

Stetson is 17-0 this season when leading after six innings. Overall, the Hatters have won 76 games in a row when leading after six innings dating back to Feb. 15, 2014.

Five Freshmen Starting

Stetson has had four of its five freshmen start every game, and all five freshmen starting 10 games. Over the past 12 games, Stetson has had four freshmen starting on the infield (1B, SS, 3B, C).

Stetson By The Numbers

- 22-2 when scoring four runs or more
- 17-1 when scoring first

- 16-0 when leading after five innings

Magic Number: 4

The Hatters are 22-2 when scoring four or more runs in a game but 1-7 when scoring three runs or less.

Big First Innings

The Hatters have scored 58 first inning runs this season, an average of 1.8 first inning runs per game. That is 28.6 percent of the team's total offense that comes in the first inning. The team is batting .395 in first innings this year. The Hatters have not scored more than 30 runs in any other inning.

ASUN Player of the Week - March 6

Kelsey Waters batted .750 and slugged 1.583 to help lead Stetson to a perfect 4-0 record at the Hatter Classic. She collected nine hits in 12 at-bats, including two triples and two home runs, and she registered nine RBI.

ASUN Player of the Week - Feb. 13

After collecting six hits including a grand slam and a run-rule walk-off home run, junior Maggie Fritts was named ASUN Conference Softball Player of the Week on Feb. 13.

Reaching Base Safely

Senior Jessie TenBroeck has started and batted lead-off in 188 games in her career, missing only one single game. She has reached base safely in 153 career games (81.4%).

Coaching Staff

The Hatter coaching staff is one of the longest tenured coaching staffs in the NCAA. Head coach Frank Griffin is in his 21st season, associate head coach Vanessa Bataille is in her 17th season, making her and Griffin the eighth-longest coaching tandem in the NCAA. Also, assistant coach J.J. Payette is in her 11th season. Approximately only 10 other schools currently have three coaches that have been together for 10 years or more. Griffin, Bataille and Payette are currently the three longest tenured coaches at Stetson University.

THE HATTERS NICKNAME

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university getting together produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the University's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all started back in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left Mr. DeLand in financial trouble, Mr. Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. When, at Mr. DeLand's request, Mr. Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889, the school was renamed in his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901, and the nickname "Hatter" was used then and is still used today.



Stetson is the only NCAA-member institution with "Hatters" as a nickname.
