### The All-Time Series

Stetson leads the all-time series 16-11 over FGCU. The Hatters hold a 13-1 advantage in DeLand and have won six in a row over the Eagles at Patricia Wilson Field. The Hatters lost two of the three meetings last year in Fort Myers.

### Head Coach Frank Griffin

Stetson's Frank Griffin is in his 21st season as head coach of the Hatters and holds a school record of 698-450 (.608). Griffin is in his 28th season overall with a career record of 923-537 (.632).

### Frank Griffin Among NCAA's Best

On Feb. 10, Frank Griffin became 47th coach in NCAA history and 29th coach in NCAA Division I history to record 900 career wins. He is two wins shy of 700 at Stetson.

### Team Run Production

- ▶ Stetson ranks 33rd in the NCAA in scoring (5.5)
- ▶ The Hatters have had 20 innings of 4+ runs
- ▶ The Hatters have scored double-digit runs nine times this season

### Team Stolen Bases

Stetson ranks fourth in the NCAA with 121 stolen bases, trailing only Marshall (139), UT Martin (131), and Southeastern Louisiana (125). The Hatters have already reached the 100-steal mark for the second year in a row and for the fourth time in school history.

Kelsey Waters batted .750 and slugged 1.583 to help lead Stetson to a perfect 4-0 record at the Hatter Classic. She collected nine hits in 12 at-bats, including two triples and two home runs, and she registered nine RBI.

After collecting six hits including a grand slam and a run-rule walk-off home run, junior Maggie Fritts was named ASUN Conference Softball Player of the Week on Feb. 13.

On April 8 at Lipscomb, senior Jessie TenBroeck became just the sixth player in school history with 200 career hits.

## THE HATTERS NICKNAME

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university getting together produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the University's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all started back in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left Mr. DeLand in financial trouble, Mr. Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. When, at Mr. DeLand's request, Mr. Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889, the school was renamed in his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901, and the nickname "Hatter" was used then and is still used today.



Stetson is the only NCAA-member institution with "Hatters" as a nickname.
