## THE HATTERS NICKNAME

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the wellknown Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in Del and, became interested in the school. At DeLand's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in his honor.

Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The is still in use today.

# **NEWS AND NOTES**

### The All-Time Series vs. High Point - 1st Meeting

Saturday marks the first all-time meeting between Stetson and High Point.

## **Quick Hitters**

- ▶ Stetson is 7-1 for just the third time in school history (1986-87, 2000-01).
- ▶ Stetson extended their hot starts to 9-1 in both 1986-87 and 2000-01.
- Stetson has won three in a row, all on the road.
- ► Stetson won seven games in November for the first time ever (previous record was five)
- Three different Hatters are averaging in double figures, and all five starters are averaging 8.8 ppg or more
- ▶ Brianti Saunders is second on Stetson's all-time scoring list, 28 points shy of the top spot
- ▶ The Hatters lead the ASUN in scoring (72.0), scoring margin (9.0), and field goal pct. (.421).
- ▶ The Hatters lead the ASUN and rank 12th in the NCAA in free throw pct. (.789)
- ▶ As of Thursday, the Hatters are one of 10 teams with seven victories on the season
- ▶ As of Thursday, Sarah Sagerer ranks 10th in the NCAA in blocks (22) and 14th in rebounds (72).
- ► Sarah Sagerer needs one block for 100 in her career

### **Road Success**

Stetson has won three straight on the road for the first time since 2014-15. Over the past three seasons, Stetson is 11-2 in non-conference road/neutral games against non-BCS opponents.

### **Third Quarter Success**

Stetson is outscoring its opponents 151-113 (+38) in 3rd Quarters this year. The Hatters have "won" seven of the eight third quarters, with the only "loss" coming to Bethune-Cookman 21-19.

### **Comeback Victories**

Stetson has twice rallied from double-digit deficits to win this year. The Hatters trailed by 14 points to Bethune-Cookman in the second quarter (won 63-60), and trailed by 10 points to Weber State in the first quarter (won 70-68). The Hatters have also rallied three times from second-half deficits to win (Bethune, Weber State, Northern Kentucky).

### **ASUN Newcomer of the Week**

Junior guard Brittney Chambers was named ASUN Newcomer of the Week Monday after scoring 13 points in a win over Robert Morris and 14 points in a win over Weber State.

### **Travel Warriors**

After playing the first four games of the year at home, the Hatters are playing six games in a row on the road, split up over four road trips and totaling 6,020 miles. By tip-off time at High, Stetson will have logged over 5.000 miles:

Brianti Saunders made 21 consecutive free throws to start the season. She leads the ASUN with 36 free throws made (15th in NCAA) and ranks second in free throw pct. (.923). In 2015-16, Saunders had free throw streaks of 16, 18, 21, and 22 in a row without a miss.

# **Scoring in Double Figures**

Brianti Saunders has scored in double figures in all eight games this season, and in 10 straight games dating back to last year. For her career, she has scored in double figures in 83 of her 106 games played.

### **Second Half Scoring**

Brianti Saunders has scored 69 percent of her points this season after halftime (92 of 134). She has scored in double figures after halftime in six out of eight games this year.

### **Post Play**

Post players Sarah Sagerer and Breana Bey have had a brilliant start to the season. Together they have combined for 22.9 points, 15.5 rebounds and 3.1 blocks per game. They each recorded double-doubles vs. Valparaiso and Eastern Illinois:

### Rebound Streak

Breana Bey has collected five or more rebounds in all eight games this season and in 25 consecutive games dating back to last year.

### Scoring Breakdown

Stetson has derived 86 percent of its scoring from its starters this year. Not counting the season opener against Webber, the starters have accounted for 90 percent of the team's scoring.

### Johnson-Matthews Taking Charge(s)

Sophomore Myka Johnson-Matthews has taken a team-high seven charges this year, and she has taken 17 charges in her career.

### **Home Cooking**

The Hatters have tough to beat at home over the past seven seasons, posting a combined .850 win percentage over that stretch at the Edmunds Center:

### 74 is the Magic Number

Stetson has won 59 consecutive games when scoring 74 points or more, dating back to the 2012-13 season opener (lost 77-75 vs. Hofstra).

### **Six-Year Success**

Since the start of the 2010-11 season, the Stetson women's basketball team has:
