THE HATTERS NICKNAME

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the wellknown Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in Del and, became interested in the school. At DeLand's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in his honor.

Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.

NEWS AND NOTES

The All-Time Series vs. SIUE / Tennessee State - First Meetings

Stetson will be meeting both SIUE and Tennessee State for the first time.

Team Notes

- ▶ Stetson has tied its best start in school history (also 10-2 in 1986-87 and 2000-01)
- ► Stetson moved to 11-2 in 2000-01 only
- ▶ Stetson is 11-1 in its last 12 Hatter Classic games (lost to Georgia State in OT last year)
- ▶ Stetson has won eight in a row at home (6-0 this year).
- The Hatters average 83.6 ppg at home this season (five players in double figures at home)
- ▶ The Hatters lead the ASUN and rank second in the NCAA in free throw pct. (.811), (Iowa State .841)
- ▶ The Hatters also lead the ASUN in scoring (74.4), scoring defense (57.8), scoring margin (16.7), field goal pct. (.459), blocks (4.6), assists (15.1), and won-loss pct. (.833).
- ▶ As of Friday, the Hatters are one of nine teams in the NCAA with at least 10 victories on the season, and the only mid-major in the group

Brianti Saunders

- ▶ Is Stetson's all-time leading scorer with 1,655 points
- ▶ Is Stetson's all-time leader in free throws made with 374
- ► Has scored in double figures in all 12 games (14 in a row overall)
- ► Ranks second in the ASUN in scoring (16.7 ppg)
- ▶ Leads ASUN and ranks seventh in the NCAA in free throw percentage (.933); has made 11 FT in a row
- ▶ Is also among ASUN leaders in steals (3rd), assists (5th), and 3-point field goals per game (4th)
- ► Has scored in double figures in 87 of her 110 games played
- ▶ Was ASUN Player of the Week December 5 (seventh time in her career)

Sarah Sagerer

- ► Leads the ASUN and ranks third in the NCAA with 40 blocks (as of Friday)
- ▶ Has 11 blocks in her last two games (four vs. Warner and seven vs. Palm Beach Atlantic)
- ▶ Leads the ASUN and ranks seventh in the NCAA with 114 rebounds (as of Friday)
- ▶ Leads the ASUN in rebounding (9.5), defensive rebounding (6.7), and blocks-per-game (3.3).
- ► Has four double-doubles on the season
- ▶ Is averaging 11.5 ppg, 11.0 ppg, and 4.3 bpg at home this season (six games)
- ▶ Is coming off a 14-point, 11-rebound, 7-block performance vs. Palm Beach Atlantic
- ▶ Tied school single-game record with eight blocks vs. Valparaiso on Nov. 12.
- ► Was ASUN Player of the Week November 14 (first time in her career)

Breana Bey

- ▶ Ranks second in the ASUN and 19th in the NCAA in field goal pct. (.598)
- ▶ Is also among ASUN leaders in scoring (3rd), rebounding (8th), and free throw pct. (4th)
- ► Has not missed a game in her career (44 games), has 3+ rebounds in all 44 games)
- ▶ Is averaging 15.0 ppg, 7.7 rpg, and shooting .630 at home this season (six games)
- ► Scored 19 points apiece vs. Warner and Palm Beach Atlantic
- ▶ Is shooting .895 (17-19) over her last two games, making her last eight straight field goals against PBAU
- ▶ Has three double-doubles on the season, including a 19-point, 10-rebound performance vs. Palm Beach

Myka Johnson-Matthews

- ► Has started 31 games in a row (all 12 this season)
- ▶ Ranks third in the ASUN in field goal pct. (.592) and fourth in A/TO ratio (1.4)
- ▶ Is shooting 71.8 percent (28-for-39) over her past seven games.
- ▶ Leads the team with eight charges drawn this season (18 career)
- ▶ Averages 30.2 minutes played (second on team), has committed only 16 turnovers

Kennedi Colclough

- ► Leads the ASUN in field goal percentage (.627)
- ▶ Is averaging 13.3 ppg, 5.5 rpg, and shooting 73.3 percent from the field over the past four games
- ► Career highs of 23 points and 12 rebounds in win over Warner
- ▶ Was ASUN Newcomer of the Week on December 5

Brittney Chambers

- ► Second on the team with 16 3-pointers (13 have come at home)
- ▶ Second on team with 31 assists and 18 steals
- ▶ Ranks 12th in the ASUN in scoring (10.6), ninth in assists, and ninth in 3-point field goal pct.
- ▶ Was ASUN Newcomer of the Week on November 28

McKenna Beach

NEWS AND NOTES

Scoring Record For Saunders

On Dec. 5 at Chattanooga, senior Brianti Saunders became Stetson's all-time leading scorer when she scored her 1,618th career point. It was a 3-pointer out of the left corner in the third quarter. She surpassed her friend and former teammate Sasha Sims, who scored 1617 points from 2010-14.

Free Throw Shooting Record

On Dec. 10 vs. Palm Beach Atlantic, Brianti Saunders became Stetson's all-time leading free throw shooter when she made her 371st free throw. She surpassed Kristy Brown who made 370 free throws from 2001-05.

Slow Stretch

Stetson played 12 games in the first 30 days of the season, more than any other school in the NCAA through 30 days. The Hatters are now in a stretch of playing just three times over 27 days.

Home Cooking

Stetson is 6-0 at home this season and on a eight-game home court winning streak. The Hatters have been tough to beat at home over the past seven seasons, posting a combined .856 win percentage over that stretch:

More so, the Hatters are 76-9 (.894) over their past 85 home games. Stetson is also 39-3 (.929) over their past 42 non-conference home games.

Third Quarter Success

Stetson is outscoring its opponents 238-162 (+76) in 3rd Quarters this year. The Hatters have "won" 10 of the 12 third quarters, with the only "losses" coming to Bethune-Cookman (21-19) and Chattanooga (14-11).

Shooting Accuracy

The Hatters boast the top three players in the conference when it comes to field goal shooting. Kennedi Colclough leads all players with a .627 field goal pct., Breana Bey ranks second with a .598 percentage and Myka Johnson-Matthews ranks third with a .592 percentage. As a team, the Hatters rank first in the ASUN with a .459 percentage.

Comeback Victories

Stetson has twice rallied from double-digit deficits to win this year. The Hatters trailed by 14 points to Bethune-Cookman in the second quarter (won 63-60), and trailed by 10 points to Weber State in the first quarter (won 70-68). The Hatters have also rallied three times from second-half deficits to win (Bethune, Weber State, Northern Kentucky).
