## News and Notes

### Preview

The Stetson women's basketball team will go for its seventh win in a row this afternoon as the Hatters host the Jacksonville Dolphins. Stetson (10-4, 3-0) is coming off a 71-57 victory over UNF on Saturday. The Hatters led wire-to-wire and received 19 points from Shanasa Sanders, and 11 points each from Jama Sharp and Sasha Sims. Jacksonville (6-8, 2-1), meanwhile, took its first A-Sun loss of the year, 74-57, at Florida Gulf Coast.

### Home Cooking

The Hatters have won 11 straight home games (7-0 this season), tying for the 12th-longest active home winning streak in the nation and the second longest in the state of Florida (UF, 15). The Hatters have also won 23 of their last 24 and 26 of their last 28 games at the Edmunds Center.

### The All-Time Series vs. Jacksonville

Today will mark the 31st all-time meeting between Stetson and Jacksonville, with Stetson leading the series 16-14. The Hatters have won five straight over the Dolphins, including conference tournament victories in each of the last two seasons.

### Double Overtime Thriller in 2012

Sasha Sims scored a career-high 25 points with 10 rebounds as Stetson survived an extremely tenacious Jacksonville squad 93-86 in double overtime on Jan. 7, 2012 at the Edmunds Center. Victoria McGowan notched 24 points, 11 rebounds and nine assists, narrowly missing a second straight triple-double, as the Hatters won a school record eighth consecutive game. McGowan hit a three-pointer late in regulation to send the game to overtime. Jessica George converted a game-tying leaner with four seconds left to send it to a second overtime. Sims took over early in the second overtime period, slashing to the basket for two basket-and-ones that gave Stetson a six-point lead it would not relinquish.

### Quick Hitters: News and Notes

- The Hatters have won six straight and nine of their last 10 games overall
- Stetson has outscored its last six opponents by a combined 122 points (20.3 ppg)
- It is the only the fifth time in school history Stetson has posted a winning streak of at least six games. Only two times have they achieved a seven-game win streak.
- The school record for an overall winning streak is 10 games, set last year.
- The Hatters have won 11 straight home games and are 23-1 in their last 24 home games
- Of the 280 minutes played at home this year, Stetson has trailed for only 4:17.
- Stetson is 9-2 in its last 10 January games (7-2 last year, 2-0 this year)
- Stetson is 33-14 (.702) over the last two seasons in Atlantic Sun regular season (28-13) and post season (5-1) games combined
- Stetson leads the A-Sun in scoring, field goal pct., 3-pt field goal pct., and free throw pct.

### McGowan's 33-Point Game

Victoria McGowan's 33 points against Kennesaw State was a career-high and the most points in a game by a Hatter since Nefertiti Walker scored 35 points vs. UNF on Mar. 2, 2006. Also,

- The 33 points was the highest point total in the A-Sun this year
- Tied for the sixth-highest single-game points total in school history
- Tied for the highest single-game scoring game on the road in school history
- McGowan played all 20 minutes in the second half
- She scored 20 of the team's 32 second-half points
- She scored eight straight points over four consecutive possessions as Stetson went from trailing by five to leading by three
- Her 15 free throws made was just one shy of the school record

### A-Sun Statistical Leaders

The Hatters currently lead the A-Sun in the top four team offensive categories - scoring (68.6 ppg), field goal percentage (.438), three-point field goal percentage (.354), and free throw percentage (.756). Individually, Victoria McGowan leads the league in scoring (17.4) and three-point field goal pct. (.452).

### NCAA Statistical Leaders

In the Jan. 4 release of NCAA national statistics, the Hatters ranked 16th in free throw pct. (.762), 33rd in 3-point FG pct. (.352), and 40th in field goal pct. (.436). Victoria McGowan ranked 40th in the nation scoring (18.4) and 13th in three-point field goal pct. (.458).

## The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At Deland's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.



## 2012-13 Hatter Awards

### McGowan Named Hatter Classic MVP

Senior Victoria McGowan was named Hatter Classic MVP after averaging 16.0 points, 6.5 rebounds, and 6.0 assists in the Hatter victories over Georgia Southern and UNC Asheville. Sophomore Cherisse Burris joined McGowan on the all-tournament team after scoring a career-high 18 points in the win over UNC Asheville.

### McGowan = A-Sun Player of the Week

For the first time this season and for the fifth time in her career, Victoria McGowan was named the Atlantic Sun Conference Player of the Week on Nov. 27. McGowan averaged 21.5 points, 6.0 rebounds, and 5.5 assists while leading the Hatters to a pair of victories. Against B-CU, she scored a season-high 27 points, including 13 in a row during a key second half-run, while adding eight rebounds and five steals. Against Ball State, McGowan tied with teammate Shanasa Sanders with a game-high 16 points. She hit four of the Hatters' school-record 14 three-pointers while dishing out seven assists. For the week McGowan shot 54 percent (13-for-24) from the field and 75 percent (9-for-12) from behind the arc.

## News and Notes

### More on the Home Win Streak

During the Hatters' 11-game home court winning streak, Stetson is outscoring its opponents by an average of 17.9 points per game. The Hatters are shooting 45% from the floor and 37% from behind the arc. Stetson has won 10 of the 11 games by 12 points or more and has trailed for only 12:50 of the total 440 minutes.

### Preseason Accolades

The Stetson women's basketball team was picked to finish first in the Atlantic Sun Conference preseason coaches poll, and the league's head coaches also predicted the Hatters to win the conference tournament. For the second straight year, senior guard Victoria McGowan was selected as the Atlantic Sun Preseason Player of the Year. McGowan earned Player of the Year honors last season after leading the league in points, assists, steals, field goals made and free throws made. Joining McGowan on the preseason all-conference team were senior guard Shanasa Sanders and junior forward Sasha Sims.

### Best Class Ever?

Stetson's senior class has the opportunity to be winningest four-year class in the history of the women's basketball program. Since the start of the 2009-10 season, the Hatters have won 59 games. The 1988-89 senior class won 68 games over four seasons, so the Hatters need 10 more wins this season to set a new high-water mark. Here is a list of the top winningest four-year classes in Stetson women's basketball history:

### Senior CLASS Award

Senior guard Victoria McGowan has been selected as one of just 30 NCAA Division I women's basketball student-athletes as a candidate for the 2012 Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence – community, classroom, character and competition. Each of the 30 candidates will be narrowed to 10 finalists in Feb. 2013.

### Hatters Sign Five For 2012-13

Stetson University women's basketball head coach Lynn Bria proudly announced the signing of five student-athletes to National Letters-of-Intent on Nov. 15. # Lynn Bria

## HEAD COACH

**Charleston (WV), 1990**

**5th Season at Stetson**

Lynn Bria is in her fifth season at the helm of Stetson women's basketball in 2012-13 after a second straight excellent campaign in 2011-12. Under Bria, the Hatters won a school record 23 games and advanced to the postseason for the second year in a row, participating in the WNIT for the first time in school history. Three players earned All-Atlantic Sun honors including A-Sun Player of the Year and All-Tournament Team selection Victoria McGowan, who led the nation with three triple-doubles. Also honored were Second Team All-Atlantic Sun forward Sasha Sims and A-Sun All-Freshman Team forward Cherisse Burris.

Bria's 2010-11 Hatters won 20 games for the first time in 10 seasons, captured their third Atlantic Sun Conference tournament championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second time in school history and first time since 2005.

Stetson's turnaround under Bria from 6-24 to 20-13 (+12.5 games) was the second largest improvement in NCAA Division I women's basketball. Honors that came to members of the team included A-Sun Tournament MVP (Victoria McGowan), A-Sun All-Tournament Team (Tierra Brown, Sasha Sims), Second Team All-Atlantic Sun (McGowan), A-Sun All-Freshman Team (Sims), A-Sun Player of the Week (Natasha Graboski) and A-Sun Newcomer of the Week (McGowan twice, Sims). Graboski went on to sign a professional contract with Alexandria of Romania's Division 1 League in the summer of 2011.

In 2009-10 Bria led the Hatters to their seventh consecutive A-Sun tournament appearance. In her first season at Stetson, Bria made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as her 2009-10 incoming class was ranked by Michael T. White's noted scouting service All-Star Girls Report as the best in the Atlantic Sun and in the top third of all NCAA Division I teams.

Bria has coached women's basketball for 20 years with 14 seasons of Division I head coaching experience to her credit at UCF, Ohio University and Stetson. In addition to coaching, she has extensive classroom experience at the university level and is committed to developing young women both athletically and academically.

Prior to joining the Hatters, Bria spent the previous two seasons as an assistant coach at top-level programs West Virginia (2006-07) and most recently the University of Miami. Her excellent recruiting skills led to the Hurricanes signing a Top 25 incoming class according to recruiting experts at [www.HoopGurlz.com](http://www.HoopGurlz.com). With WVU, Bria served as recruiting coordinator in addition to her on-court coaching duties. Her leadership helped the Mountaineers achieve one of their best seasons in school history, which featured an at-large bid to and second round appearance in the NCAA Tournament as well as the second-largest turnaround in W-L record in Big East Conference history (15-16 to 21-11 overall and from 4-12 to 11-5 in Big East games).

From 1999-2006, Bria was the head coach at Ohio University in Athens, Ohio. She is second all-time in career wins at Ohio and was the first coach in Bobcats history to sign a recruit that would become Mid-American Conference Freshman of the Year.

Prior to taking the position at Ohio, Bria led UCF for three seasons from 1996-99. Her final Golden Knights team in 1998-99 was the TAAC (now Atlantic Sun) regular season and tournament champions and appeared in the NCAA Tournament. For her efforts, Bria was named the 1998-99 TAAC Coach of the Year. In just three seasons, she ranked second in career wins at UCF.

Bria's first head coaching position came at Division II Texas Woman's University in Denton, Texas for three seasons from 1993-96. At the age of 24, Bria was the fourth-youngest head coach in the country when she was hired. She coached the team, coordinated fundraising and taught in the Kinesiology department in addition to serving on the NCAA Division II Tournament regional selection committee. Her Pioneer squads won more games each year of her tenure than the one previously.

Her first three years out of college at the University of Charleston (W. Va.) were spent on the coaching staffs at Marshall (where she obtained her Master's degree in 1992) and Radford, where she helped lead the Highlanders to the Big South regular season and tournament titles in 1992-93.

A standout performer for the Charleston Golden Eagles, the Class of 1990 graduate was inducted into her alma mater's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2003. She scored 1,146 points in her career, averaging 10.3 points per game and was a 75.3 percent free throw shooter over her career.
