News and Notes

Preview

The Stetson women's basketball team will go for its ninth win in a row this evening as the Hatters visit the ETSU Bucs. Stetson (12-4, 5-0) is coming off a 84-66 win at USC Upstate on Saturday in a game where the Hatters scored 52 points in the second half. ETSU (3-8, 1-3), meanwhile, is coming off a 97-60 home loss to FGCU.

The All-Time Series vs. ETSU

ETSU leads the all-time series 13-2 over Stetson, including a 6-0 advantage at the MHS Center in Johnson City, Tenn. Last year at ETSU, Stetson rallied from an 11-point deficit to take a one point lead with under two minutes to play, but the Bucs pulled ahead late to claim a 74-72 victory.

Best Three-Year Record

Stetson has currently won 55 games and counting over the last three years (20 in 2010-11, 23 in 2011-12, 12 this year). The most wins in program history over a three-year period is 56, set between 1986-89. Stetson is two wins away from breaking that mark.

Victoria McGowan Named A-Sun Player of the Week

For the second time this season and for the sixth time in her career, senior guard Victoria McGowan was named the Atlantic Sun Conference Player of the Week. McGowan averaged 21.7 points, 7.3 rebounds, 3.7 assists and 3.0 steals while leading the Hatters to three A-Sun victories last week. At Kennesaw State on Wednesday, she scored a career-high 33 points, including 20 in the second half, to help Stetson rally from a late 12-point deficit. McGowan was held to five points in 19 minutes of action against UNF on Saturday, but the Hatter senior put forth a 27-point performance behind 11-of-17 shooting against Jacksonville on Monday.

Stetson's Recent Atlantic Sun Conference Success

Since the start of the 2010-11 season, Stetson is 30-13 (.698) in Atlantic Sun regular season games, 5-1 in A-Sun tournament games, and both years reached the A-Sun Tournament Finals. The Hatters won the A-Sun Championship in 2011.

- The Hatters have won eight straight games and 11 of their last 12 games overall
- Stetson has outscored its last eight opponents by a combined 157 points (19.6 ppg)
- It is the only the second time in school history Stetson has posted a winning streak of at least eight games. The school-record is 10 wins in a row, set last year.
- Stetson is 11-2 in January games over the last two seasons (7-2 last year, 4-0 this year)
- The Hatters have won 12 straight home games and are 24-1 in their last 25 home games
- Of the 320 minutes played at home this year, Stetson has trailed for only 4:17.
- Stetson leads the A-Sun in scoring, field goal pct., and three-point field goal pct.
- Stetson has oushot its opponent 13 times, but has outrebounded them only six times

Atlantic Sun Statistical Leaders

The Hatters currently lead the Atlantic Sun in three offensive categories - scoring (69.9 ppg), field goal percentage (.444), and three-point field goal percentage (.358). Individually, Victoria McGowan leads the league in scoring (17.9), three-point field goals made/game (2.3) and three-point field goal pct. (.486). Sasha Sims leads the A-Sun in blocks per game (1.6).

NCAA Statistical Leaders

In the Jan. 11 release of NCAA national statistics, the Hatters ranked 21st in free throw pct., 23rd in 3-point field goal pct., and 32nd in field goal pct.. Victoria McGowan ranked 49th in the nation scoring and sixth in three-point field goal pct.

Block Party

Junior Sasha Sims has collected 15 blocks in her last six games, vaulting her to the top of the Atlantic Sun leaders in that category. She also needs just six more blocks to become the third Hatter all-time with 100 career blocks.

News and Notes

Home Cooking

The Hatters have won 12 straight home games (8-0 this season) and 24 of their last 25 games at the Edmunds Center. During the winning streak, Stetson has outscored its opponents by an average of 17.8 points per game. The Hatters are shooting 45% from the floor and 37% from behind the arc. Stetson has won 11 of the 12 games by 12 points or more and has trailed for only 12:50 of the total 480 minutes.

Best Class Ever?

Stetson's senior class has the opportunity to be winningest four-year class in the history of the women's basketball program. Since the start of the 2009-10 season, the Hatters have won 61 games. The 1988-89 senior class won 68 games over four seasons, so the Hatters need nine more wins this season to set a new high-water mark. Here is a list of the top winningest four-year classes in Stetson women's basketball history:

1. 68 wins 1985-86 through 1988-89
2. 63 wins 1986-87 through 1989-90
2. 63 wins 1993-94 through 1996-97
- 4. 61 wins 2009-10 through Present**
4. 60 wins 1984-85 through 1987-88

Ashley Dennis, Janelle Mills, and Simone Taylor are each in their fourth season with the Hatters. Victoria McGowan also came to Stetson in 2009 as a sophomore transfer.

Senior CLASS Award

Senior guard Victoria McGowan has been selected as one of just 30 NCAA Division I women's basketball student-athletes as a candidate for the 2012 Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence – community, classroom, character and competition. Each of the 30 candidates will be narrowed to 10 finalists in Feb. 2013.

Hatters Sign Five For 2012-13

Stetson University women's basketball head coach Lynn Bria proudly announced the signing of five student-athletes to National Letters-of-Intent on Nov. 15. The signees were **Stacia Allen** (Lima, Ohio/Lima Senior HS), **Sydni Davis** (Southfield, Mich./Southfield-Lathrup HS), **Keara Finnerty** (Fairfax, Va./W.T. 5th Season at Stetson

Lynn Bria is in her fifth season at the helm of Stetson women's basketball in 2012-13 after a second straight excellent campaign in 2011-12. Under Bria, the Hatters won a school record 23 games and advanced to the postseason for the second year in a row, participating in the WNIT for the first time in school history. Three players earned All-Atlantic Sun honors including A-Sun Player of the Year and All-Tournament Team selection Victoria McGowan, who led the nation with three triple-doubles. Also honored were Second Team All-Atlantic Sun forward Sasha Sims and A-Sun All-Freshman Team forward Cherisse Burris.

Bria's 2010-11 Hatters won 20 games for the first time in 10 seasons, captured their third Atlantic Sun Conference tournament championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second time in school history and first time since 2005.

Stetson's turnaround under Bria from 6-24 to 20-13 (+12.5 games) was the second largest improvement in NCAA Division I women's basketball. Honors that came to members of the team included A-Sun Tournament MVP (Victoria McGowan), A-Sun All-Tournament Team (Tierra Brown, Sasha Sims), Second Team All-Atlantic Sun (McGowan), A-Sun All-Freshman Team (Sims), A-Sun Player of the Week (Natasha Graboski) and A-Sun Newcomer of the Week (McGowan twice, Sims). Graboski went on to sign a professional contract with Alexandria of Romania's Division 1 League in the summer of 2011.

In 2009-10 Bria led the Hatters to their seventh consecutive A-Sun tournament appearance. In her first season at Stetson, Bria made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as her 2009-10 incoming class was ranked by Michael T. White's noted scouting service All-Star Girls Report as the best in the Atlantic Sun and in the top third of all NCAA Division I teams.

Bria has coached women's basketball for 20 years with 14 seasons of Division I head coaching experience to her credit at UCF, Ohio University and Stetson. In addition to coaching, she has extensive classroom experience at the university level and is committed to developing young women both athletically and academically.

Prior to joining the Hatters, Bria spent the previous two seasons as an assistant coach at top-level programs West Virginia (2006-07) and most recently the University of Miami. Her excellent recruiting skills led to the Hurricanes signing a Top 25 incoming class according to recruiting experts at www.HoopGurlz.com. With WVU, Bria served as recruiting coordinator in addition to her on-court coaching duties. Her leadership helped the Mountaineers achieve one of their best seasons in school history, which featured an at-large bid to and second round appearance in the NCAA Tournament as well as the second-largest turnaround in W-L record in Big East Conference history (15-16 to 21-11 overall and from 4-12 to 11-5 in Big East games).

From 1999-2006, Bria was the head coach at Ohio University in Athens, Ohio. She is second all-time in career wins at Ohio and was the first coach in Bobcats history to sign a recruit that would become Mid-American Conference Freshman of the Year.

Prior to taking the position at Ohio, Bria led UCF for three seasons from 1996-99. Her final Golden Knights team in 1998-99 was the TAAC (now Atlantic Sun) regular season and tournament champions and appeared in the NCAA Tournament. For her efforts, Bria was named the 1998-99 TAAC Coach of the Year. In just three seasons, she ranked second in career wins at UCF.

Bria's first head coaching position came at Division II Texas Woman's University in Denton, Texas for three seasons from 1993-96. At the age of 24, Bria was the fourth-youngest head coach in the country when she was hired. She coached the team, coordinated fundraising and taught in the Kinesiology department in addition to serving on the NCAA Division II Tournament regional selection committee. Her Pioneer squads won more games each year of her tenure than the one previously.

Her first three years out of college at the University of Charleston (W. Va.) were spent on the coaching staffs at Marshall (where she obtained her Master's degree in 1992) and Radford, where she helped lead the Highlanders to the Big South regular season and tournament titles in 1992-93.

A standout performer for the Charleston Golden Eagles, the Class of 1990 graduate was inducted into her alma mater's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2003. She scored 1,146 points in her career, averaging 10.3 points per game and was a 75.3 percent free throw shooter over her career.

The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At Deland's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.
