News and Notes

Preview

The Stetson women's basketball team will go for its school-record-tying 10th win in a row this afternoon as the Hatters host the Lipscomb Bisons live on ESPN3. Stetson (13-4, 6-0) is coming off a pair of road wins against USC Upstate (84-66) on Saturday ETSU (71-55) on Monday. The Hatters are also looking to extend their 12-game home court winning streak (see right panel for more on the two streaks). Lipscomb is 2-13, 1-4 on the season.

A Win Today Would Give Stetson...

- A school-record-tying 10-game winning streak
- A school-record 13-game home court winning streak
- Its first ever 13-1 record over a 14-game stretch
- Its second ever 7-0 start in conference play (also went 7-0 last year)
- Its most total wins in a three-year period (57)

The All-Time Series vs. Lipscomb

Stetson leads the all-time series 11-7 over Lipscomb including a 6-3 record in DeLand. The Hatters have won the last three head-to-head meetings in the series, including last year's 74-59 victory in DeLand. Shanasa Sanders scored 21 points and Victoria McGowan scored 18.

Stetson's Recent Atlantic Sun Conference Success

Since the start of the 2010-11 season, Stetson is 31-13 (.705) in Atlantic Sun regular season games, 5-1 in A-Sun tournament games, and both years reached the A-Sun Tournament Finals. The Hatters won the A-Sun Championship in 2011.

Quick Hitters: Team News and Notes

- The Hatters have won nine straight games and 12 of their last 13 games overall
- It is the only the second time in school history Stetson has posted a winning streak of at least nine games. The school-record is 10 wins in a row, set last year.
- The Hatters have won 12 straight home games and are 24-1 in their last 25 home games
- Of the 320 minutes played at home this year, Stetson has trailed for only 4:17.
- Stetson is 12-2 in January games over the last two seasons (7-2 last year, 5-0 this year)

Home Cooking

The Hatters have won 12 straight home games and 24 of their last 25 games at the Edmunds Center. During the 12-game winning streak, Stetson has outscored its opponents by an average of 17.8 points per game. Stetson has won each of the last 11 games by 12 points or more and has trailed for only 12:50 of the total 480 minutes.

Leading at Home

The Hatters are 8-0 at home this season and have led pretty much the entire time. Of the 320 minutes played at home this year, Stetson has trailed amazingly for only 4:17. The Hatters have not trailed at all for the last 158:24 since Georgia Southern led 2-0 on Dec. 18. Stetson has never trailed by more than three points at home this season. Other than Lynn University's brief 28-27 halftime lead, no other team has led past the 15:42 mark of the first half.

Sharp Shooting Weekend

Sophomore Jama Sharp was on fire this past weekend, shooting 71.4% (15-21) from the floor and 66.7% (4-6) from behind the arc in the two Stetson victories. Against USC Upstate she scored 17 points on 7-of-10 shooting and grabbed a career-high eight steals (six in the second half). On Monday at ETSU, Sharp tied a career-high with 21 points on 8-of-11 shooting including 3-of-4 makes from behind the arc.

Block Party

Junior Sasha Sims has collected 17 blocks in her last seven games, vaulting her to the top of the Atlantic Sun leaders in that category. She also needs just four more blocks to become the third Hatter all-time with 100 career blocks.

News and Notes

Atlantic Sun Statistical Leaders

The Hatters currently lead the Atlantic Sun in three offensive categories - scoring (69.9 ppg), field goal percentage (.445), and three-point field goal percentage (.358). Individually, Victoria McGowan leads the league in three-point field goals made/game (2.3) and three-point field goal pct. (.474). Sasha Sims leads the A-Sun in blocks per game (1.6).

NCAA Statistical Leaders

In the Jan. 18 release of NCAA national statistics, the Hatters ranked 22nd in the nation in field goal pct., 23rd in three-point field goal pct., and 37th in free throw pct. Victoria McGowan ranked fifth in the nation three-point field goal pct. and 64th in scoring.

Lighter Travel Schedule

After already making two conference road trips out of state, the Hatters will play their next seven games in the state of Florida. The Hatters will only make one more out-of-state trip (Northern Kentucky and Lipscomb) prior to the conference tournament.

Best Class Ever?

Stetson's senior class has the opportunity to be winningest four-year class in the history of the women's basketball program. Since the start of the 2009-10 season, the Hatters have won 62 games. The 1988-89 senior class won 68 games over four seasons, so the Hatters need seven more wins this season to set a new high-water mark. Ashley Dennis, Janelle Mills, and Simone Taylor are each in their fourth season with the Hatters. Victoria McGowan also came to Stetson in 2009 as a sophomore transfer.

Senior CLASS Award

Senior guard Victoria McGowan has been selected as one of just 30 NCAA Division I women's basketball student-athletes as a candidate for the 2012 Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence - community, classroom, character and competition. Each of the 30 candidates will be narrowed to 10 finalists in Feb. 2013.

Hatters Sign Five For 2012-13

Stetson University women's basketball head coach Lynn Bria proudly announced the signing of five student-athletes to National Letters-of-Intent on Nov. 15. The signees were **Stacia Allen** (Lima, Ohio/Lima Senior HS), **Sydni Davis** (Southfield, Mich./Southfield-Lathrup HS), **Keara Finnerty** (Fairfax, Va./W.T. Woodson HS), **Amber Porter** (Woodbridge, Va./Potomac HS), and **Brianti Saunders** (Hilliard, Fla./Hilliard Middle-Senior HS).

5th Season at Stetson

Lynn Bria is in her fifth season at the helm of Stetson women's basketball in 2012-13 after a second straight excellent campaign in 2011-12. Under Bria, the Hatters won a school record 23 games and advanced to the postseason for the second year in a row, participating in the WNIT for the first time in school history. Three players earned All-Atlantic Sun honors including A-Sun Player of the Year and All-Tournament Team selection Victoria McGowan, who led the nation with three triple-doubles. Also honored were Second Team All-Atlantic Sun forward Sasha Sims and A-Sun All-Freshman Team forward Cherisse Burris.

Bria's 2010-11 Hatters won 20 games for the first time in 10 seasons, captured their third Atlantic Sun Conference tournament championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second time in school history and first time since 2005.

Stetson's turnaround under Bria from 6-24 to 20-13 (+12.5 games) was the second largest improvement in NCAA Division I women's basketball. Honors that came to members of the team included A-Sun Tournament MVP (Victoria McGowan), A-Sun All-Tournament Team (Tierra Brown, Sasha Sims), Second Team All-Atlantic Sun (McGowan), A-Sun All-Freshman Team (Sims), A-Sun Player of the Week (Natasha Graboski) and A-Sun Newcomer of the Week (McGowan twice, Sims). Graboski went on to sign a professional contract with Alexandria of Romania's Division 1 League in the summer of 2011.

In 2009-10 Bria led the Hatters to their seventh consecutive A-Sun tournament appearance. In her first season at Stetson, Bria made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as her 2009-10 incoming class was ranked by Michael T. White's noted scouting service All-Star Girls Report as the best in the Atlantic Sun and in the top third of all NCAA Division I teams.

Bria has coached women's basketball for 20 years with 14 seasons of Division I head coaching experience to her credit at UCF, Ohio University and Stetson. In addition to coaching, she has extensive classroom experience at the university level and is committed to developing young women both athletically and academically.

Prior to joining the Hatters, Bria spent the previous two seasons as an assistant coach at top-level programs West Virginia (2006-07) and most recently the University of Miami. Her excellent recruiting skills led to the Hurricanes signing a Top 25 incoming class according to recruiting experts at www.HoopGurlz.com. With WVU, Bria served as recruiting coordinator in addition to her on-court coaching duties. Her leadership helped the Mountaineers achieve one of their best seasons in school history, which featured an at-large bid to and second round appearance in the NCAA Tournament as well as the second-largest turnaround in W-L record in Big East Conference history (15-16 to 21-11 overall and from 4-12 to 11-5 in Big East games).

From 1999-2006, Bria was the head coach at Ohio University in Athens, Ohio. She is second all-time in career wins at Ohio and was the first coach in Bobcats history to sign a recruit that would become Mid-American Conference Freshman of the Year.

Prior to taking the position at Ohio, Bria led UCF for three seasons from 1996-99. Her final Golden Knights team in 1998-99 was the TAAC (now Atlantic Sun) regular season and tournament champions and appeared in the NCAA Tournament. For her efforts, Bria was named the 1998-99 TAAC Coach of the Year. In just three seasons, she ranked second in career wins at UCF.

Bria's first head coaching position came at Division II Texas Woman's University in Denton, Texas for three seasons from 1993-96. At the age of 24, Bria was the fourth-youngest head coach in the country when she was hired. She coached the team, coordinated fundraising and taught in the Kinesiology department in addition to serving on the NCAA Division II Tournament regional selection committee. Her Pioneer squads won more games each year of her tenure than the one previously.

Her first three years out of college at the University of Charleston (W. Va.) were spent on the coaching staffs at Marshall (where she obtained her Master's degree in 1992) and Radford, where she helped lead the Highlanders to the Big South regular season and tournament titles in 1992-93.

A standout performer for the Charleston Golden Eagles, the Class of 1990 graduate was inducted into her alma mater's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2003. She scored 1,146 points in her career, averaging 10.3 points per game and was a 75.3 percent free throw shooter over her career.

The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At Deland's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.
