News and Notes

Preview

In what may very well likely be the first-ever meeting between two 8-0 teams in conference history, the Stetson Hatters will visit the Florida Gulf Coast Eagles Saturday night in Fort Myers. Stetson (15-4 overall) won its school-record 11th consecutive game on Monday night, defeating Northern Kentucky 62-39 at the Edmunds Center. Victoria McGowan (16 points), Sasha Sims (13), and Jama Sharp (11) all scored in double figures, while Cherisse Burris pulled down 12 rebounds. The victory also marked Stetson's 14th straight win at home. FGCU (15-5) is also streaking, having won nine in a row overall and 26 consecutive conference games dating back to the start of the 2011-12 season.

A Win Today Would Give Stetson...

- Extend its school-record winning streak to 12 games in a row
- Extend its road winning streak to six games in a row
- Tie a school record for most wins in the month of January (8)
- Its first undefeated calendar month since December, 2000
- Its first ever 9-0 start in conference play (previous best 7-0 last year)

The All-Time Series vs. FGCU

The Eagles lead the all-time series 9-2 over the Hatters. FGCU won all three meetings last year, including a 67-39 win in the A-Sun Championship game. FGCU is 5-0 all-time vs. Stetson at Alico Arena.

Stetson's Recent Atlantic Sun Conference Success

Since the start of the 2010-11 season, Stetson is 33-13 (.717) in Atlantic Sun regular season games, 5-1 in A-Sun tournament games, and both years reached the A-Sun Tournament Finals. The Hatters won the A-Sun Championship in 2011.

In the Jan. 22 CollegeInsider.com Women's Mid-Major Top 25 Poll, the Hatters received 57 votes for an unofficial #28 ranking.

Sharp Gobbling Up Steals

In the first eight games of the season, junior Jama Sharp had collected just nine steals. But in the 11 games since, Sharp has gobbled up 38 steals. She has 18 steals in her last four games, including a career-best eight at USC Upstate, and ranks third in the conference with a 2.5 spg average.

Atlantic Sun Statistical Leaders

The Hatters currently lead the Atlantic Sun in three offensive categories - scoring (70.7 ppg), field goal percentage (.447), and three-point field goal percentage (.358). Individually, Victoria McGowan leads the league in three-point field goals made (42) and three-point field goal pct. (.477). Sasha Sims leads the A-Sun in blocks (29).

NCAA Statistical Leaders

In the Jan. 25 release of NCAA national statistics, the Hatters ranked 18th in the nation in field goal pct., 20th in three-point field goal pct., and 40th in scoring. Victoria McGowan ranked third in the nation three-point field goal pct. and 70th in scoring.

News and Notes

Janelle Mills Closing In On Games Played Record

Senior Janelle Mills has played in all 116 games in her career without missing any. She needs to play in just four more games to break the all-time school record of 119 games played, set by Tierra Brown from 2007-11.

McGowan Chasing School Points Record

Senior Victoria McGowan has been climbing the charts towards the school record for most career points. She currently ranks eighth in Stetson history with 1332 points, and needs 15 points to move into a tie for seventh. The school record holder is Michelle Michael with 1570 points. At her current season scoring pace, McGowan would have to play 14 more games to break the record.

Lighter Travel Schedule

After already making two conference road trips out of state, the Hatters are in the midst of playing seven straight games in the state of Florida. The Hatters will only make one more out-of-state trip (Northern Kentucky and Lipscomb) prior to the conference tournament.

Best Class Ever?

Stetson's senior class has the opportunity to be winningest four-year class in the history of the women's basketball program. Since the start of the 2009-10 season, the Hatters have won 64 games. The 1988-89 senior class won 68 games over four seasons, so the Hatters need five more wins this season to set a new high-water mark. Ashley Dennis, Janelle Mills, and Simone Taylor are each in their fourth season with the Hatters. Victoria McGowan also came to Stetson in 2009 as a sophomore transfer.

Senior CLASS Award

Senior guard Victoria McGowan has been selected as one of just 30 NCAA Division I women's basketball student-athletes as a candidate for the 2012 Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence — community, classroom, character and competition. Each of the 30 candidates will be narrowed to 10 finalists in Feb. 2013.

Hatters Sign Five For 2012-13

Stetson University women's basketball head coach Lynn Bria proudly announced the signing of five student-athletes to National Letters-of-Intent on Nov. 15. The signees were **Stacia Allen** (Lima, Ohio/Lima Senior HS), **Sydni Davis** (Southfield, Mich./Southfield-Lathrup HS), **Keara Finnerty** (Fairfax, Va./W.T. Woodson HS), **Amber Porter** (Woodbridge, Va./Potomac HS), and **Brianti Saunders** (Hilliard, Fla./Hilliard Middle-Senior HS).

The Head Coach

Lynn Bria is in her fifth season at the helm of Stetson women's basketball in 2012-13 after a second straight excellent campaign in 2011-12. Under Bria, the Hatters won a school record 23 games and advanced to the postseason for the second year in a row, participating in the WNIT for the first time in school history. Three players earned All-Atlantic Sun honors including A-Sun Player of the Year and All-Tournament Team selection Victoria McGowan, who led the nation with three triple-doubles. Also honored were Second Team All-Alantic Sun forward Sasha Sims and A-Sun All-Freshman Team forward Cherisse Burris.

Bria's 2010-11 Hatters won 20 games for the first time in 10 seasons, captured their third Atlantic Sun Conference tournament championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second time in school history and first time since 2005.

Stetson's turnaround under Bria from 6-24 to 20-13 (+12.5 games) was the second largest improvement in NCAA Division I women's basketball. Honors that came to members of the team included A-Sun Tournament MVP (Victoria McGowan), A-Sun All-Tournament Team (Tierra Brown, Sasha Sims), Second Team All-Atlantic Sun (McGowan), A-Sun All-Freshman Team (Sims), A-Sun Player of the Week (Natasha Graboski) and A-Sun Newcomer of the Week (McGowan twice, Sims). Graboski went on to sign a professional contract with Alexandria of Romania's Division 1 League in the summer of 2011.

In 2009-10 Bria led the Hatters to their seventh consecutive A-Sun tournament appearance. In her first season at Stetson, Bria made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as her 2009-10 incoming class was ranked by Michael T. White's noted scouting service All-Star Girls Report as the best in the Atlantic Sun and in the top third of all NCAA Division I teams.

Bria has coached women's basketball for 20 years with 14 seasons of Division I head coaching experience to her credit at UCF, Ohio University and Stetson. In addition to coaching, she has extensive classroom experience at the university level and is committed to developing young women both athletically and academically.

Prior to joining the Hatters, Bria spent the previous two seasons as an assistant coach at top-level programs West Virginia (2006-07) and most recently the University of Miami. Her excellent recruiting skills led to the Hurricanes signing a Top 25 incoming class according to recruiting experts at www.HoopGurlz.com. With WVU, Bria served as recruiting coordinator in addition to her on-court coaching duties. Her leadership helped the Mountaineers achieve one of their best seasons in school history, which featured an at-large bid to and second round appearance in the NCAA Tournament as well as the second-largest turnaround in W-L record in Big East Conference history (15-16 to 21-11 overall and from 4-12 to 11-5 in Big East games).

From 1999-2006, Bria was the head coach at Ohio University in Athens, Ohio. She is second all-time in career wins at Ohio and was the first coach in Bobcats history to sign a recruit that would become Mid-American Conference Freshman of the Year.

Prior to taking the position at Ohio, Bria led UCF for three seasons from 1996-99. Her final Golden Knights team in 1998-99 was the TAAC (now Atlantic Sun) regular season and tournament champions and appeared in the NCAA Tournament. For her efforts, Bria was named the 1998-99 TAAC Coach of the Year. In just three seasons, she ranked second in career wins at UCF.

Bria's first head coaching position came at Division II Texas Woman's University in Denton, Texas for three seasons from 1993-96. At the age of 24, Bria was the fourth-youngest head coach in the country when she was hired. She coached the team, coordinated fundraising and taught in the Kinesiology department in addition to serving on the NCAA Division II Tournament regional selection committee. Her Pioneer squads won more games each year of her tenure than the one previously.

Her first three years out of college at the University of Charleston (W. Va.) were spent on the coaching staffs at Marshall (where she obtained her Master's degree in 1992) and Radford, where she helped lead the Highlanders to the Big South regular season and tournament titles in 1992-93.

A standout performer for the Charleston Golden Eagles, the Class of 1990 graduate was inducted into her alma mater's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2003. She scored 1,146 points in her career, averaging 10.3 points pergame and was a 75.3 percentfree throw shooter over her career.

The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At Deland's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in

his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.
