News and Notes

Preview

The Stetson women's basketball team will look to extend the nation's fifth-longest home court winning streak Saturday afternoon when the Hatters host the ETSU Lady Bucs at the Edmunds Center. Tip-off is scheduled for 1 p.m. Stetson is coming off a 72-51 victory in Jacksonville on Monday. Shanasa Sanders recorded 18 points, 11 rebounds, and scored her 1000th career NCAA point. Sasha Sims also scored 18 points and Victoria McGowan added 12.

Shanasa Sanders Named A-Sun Player of the Week

For the first time in her career, senior guard Shanasa Sanders was named the Atlantic Sun Conference Player of the Week last week. Sanders averaged 20.5 points, 9.0 rebounds, and 2.5 steals in two road games in her hometown of Jacksonville this past weekend. Against UNF on Saturday, Sanders scored a team-high 23 points while also collecting seven rebounds. On Monday, the Hatter senior registered a double-double of 18 points and 11 rebounds in Stetson's win over Jacksonville.

Already Clinched

With Stetson's win Monday over Jacksonville, the Hatters clinched a berth in the Atlantic Sun Conference tournament for the 10th consecutive year.

The All-Time Series vs. ETSU

ETSU leads the all-time series 13-3 over Stetson, including a 7-2 advantage in DeLand. Stetson has won two of the last three head-to-head meetings, including a 71-55 victory in Johnson City back on Jan. 14. Shanasa Sanders scored a game-high 22 points and Jama Sharp tied a career-high with 21 points in that contest. Stetson led by 12 at halftime, but ETSU closed the gap to 51-44 with 8:52 to play. The Hatters then went on a 7-0 run as Sharp hit a three and Sanders converted a fastbreak lay-up to help Stetson pull away for good.

Stetson's Recent Atlantic Sun Conference Success

Since the start of the 2010-11 season, Stetson is 34-15 (.694) in Atlantic Sun regular season games, 5-1 in A-Sun tournament games, and both years reached the A-Sun Tournament Finals. The Hatters won the A-Sun Championship in 2011.

Home Cooking

The Hatters have won 14 straight home games and 26 of their last 27 games at the Edmunds Center. During the 14-game winning streak, Stetson has outscored its opponents by an average of 19.9 points per game. Stetson has won each of the last 13 games by 12 points or more and has trailed for only 26:54 of the total 560 minutes.

Leading at Home

The Hatters are 10-0 at home this season and have led pretty much the entire time. Of the 400 minutes played at home this year, Stetson has trailed amazingly for only 18:21 (14:04 of that came in one game - Northern Kentucky). Stetson has never trailed by more than seven points at home this season.

News and Notes

NCAA Statistical Leaders

In the Feb. 8 release of NCAA national statistics, the Hatters ranked 21st in the nation in field goal pct., 29th in three-point field goal pct., and 50th in scoring. Victoria McGowan ranked fourth in the nation three-point field goal pct. and 81st in scoring.

McGowan Chasing School Points Record

Senior Victoria McGowan has been climbing the charts towards the school record for most career points. She currently ranks sixth in Stetson history with 1376 points, and needs one point to move into a tie for fifth. The school record holder is Michelle Michael with 1570 points. At her current season scoring pace, McGowan would have to play 12 more games to break the record.

Lighter Travel Schedule

After already making two conference road trips out of state, the Hatters are in the midst of playing seven straight games in the state of Florida. The Hatters will only make one more out-of-state trip (Northern Kentucky and Lipscomb) prior to the conference tournament.

Best Class Ever?

Stetson's senior class has the opportunity to be winningest four-year class in the history of the women's basketball program. Since the start of the 2009-10 season, the Hatters have won 65 games. The 1988-89 senior class won 68 games over four seasons, so the Hatters need four more wins this season to set a new high-water mark. Here is a list of the top winningest four-year classes in Stetson women's basketball history:

1. 68 wins 1985-86 through 1988-89
2. **65 wins 2009-10 through Present**
3. 63 wins 1986-87 through 1989-90
3. 63 wins 1993-94 through 1996-97
5. 60 wins 1984-85 through 1987-88

Ashley Dennis, Janelle Mills, and Simone Taylor are each in their fourth season with the Hatters. Victoria McGowan also came to Stetson in 2009 as a sophomore transfer.

5th Season at Stetson

Lynn Bria is in her fifth season at the helm of Stetson women's basketball in 2012-13 after a second straight excellent campaign in 2011-12. Under Bria, the Hatters won a school record 23 games and advanced to the postseason for the second year in a row, participating in the WNIT for the first time in school history. Three players earned All-Atlantic Sun honors including A-Sun Player of the Year and All-Tournament Team selection Victoria McGowan, who led the nation with three triple-doubles. Also honored were Second Team All-Atlantic Sun forward Sasha Sims and A-Sun All-Freshman Team forward Cherisse Burris.

Bria's 2010-11 Hatters won 20 games for the first time in 10 seasons, captured their third Atlantic Sun Conference tournament championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second time in school history and first time since 2005.

Stetson's turnaround under Bria from 6-24 to 20-13 (+12.5 games) was the second largest improvement in NCAA Division I women's basketball. Honors that came to members of the team included A-Sun Tournament MVP (Victoria McGowan), A-Sun All-Tournament Team (Tierra Brown, Sasha Sims), Second Team All-Atlantic Sun (McGowan), A-Sun All-Freshman Team (Sims), A-Sun Player of the Week (Natasha Graboski) and A-Sun Newcomer of the Week (McGowan twice, Sims). Graboski went on to sign a professional contract with Alexandria of Romania's Division 1 League in the summer of 2011.

In 2009-10 Bria led the Hatters to their seventh consecutive A-Sun tournament appearance. In her first season at Stetson, Bria made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as her 2009-10 incoming class was ranked by Michael T. White's noted scouting service All-Star Girls Report as the best in the Atlantic Sun and in the top third of all NCAA Division I teams.

Bria has coached women's basketball for 20 years with 14 seasons of Division I head coaching experience to her credit at UCF, Ohio University and Stetson. In addition to coaching, she has extensive classroom experience at the university level and is committed to developing young women both athletically and academically.

Prior to joining the Hatters, Bria spent the previous two seasons as an assistant coach at top-level programs West Virginia (2006-07) and most recently the University of Miami. Her excellent recruiting skills led to the Hurricanes signing a Top 25 incoming class according to recruiting experts at www.HoopGurlz.com. With WVU, Bria served as recruiting coordinator in addition to her on-court coaching duties. Her leadership helped the Mountaineers achieve one of their best seasons in school history, which featured an at-large bid to and second round appearance in the NCAA Tournament as well as the second-largest turnaround in W-L record in Big East Conference history (15-16 to 21-11 overall and from 4-12 to 11-5 in Big East games).

From 1999-2006, Bria was the head coach at Ohio University in Athens, Ohio. She is second all-time in career wins at Ohio and was the first coach in Bobcats history to sign a recruit that would become Mid-American Conference Freshman of the Year.

Prior to taking the position at Ohio, Bria led UCF for three seasons from 1996-99. Her final Golden Knights team in 1998-99 was the TAAC (now Atlantic Sun) regular season and tournament champions and appeared in the NCAA Tournament. For her efforts, Bria was named the 1998-99 TAAC Coach of the Year. In just three seasons, she ranked second in career wins at UCF.

Bria's first head coaching position came at Division II Texas Woman's University in Denton, Texas for three seasons from 1993-96. At the age of 24, Bria was the fourth-youngest head coach in the country when she was hired. She coached the team, coordinated fundraising and taught in the Kinesiology department in addition to serving on the NCAA Division II Tournament regional selection committee. Her Pioneer squads won more games each year of her tenure than the one previously.

Her first three years out of college at the University of Charleston (W. Va.) were spent on the coaching staffs at Marshall (where she obtained her Master's degree in 1992) and Radford, where she helped lead the Highlanders to the Big South regular season and tournament titles in 1992-93.

A standout performer for the Charleston Golden Eagles, the Class of 1990 graduate was inducted into her alma mater's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2003. She scored 1,146 points in her career, averaging 10.3 points per game and was a 75.3 percent free throw shooter over her career.

The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At Deland's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.
