Preview

The Stetson women's basketball team will play its final regular season road game of the year Monday night as they visit the Lipscomb Lady Bisons at Allen Arena. Tip-off is scheduled for 7:30 p.m. Eastern Time on ESPN3. Stetson is coming off a tough five-point loss at Northern Kentucky on Saturday, just the team's third A-Sun loss of the season.

The All-Time Series vs. Lipscomb / The Last Meeting

Stetson leads the all-time series 12-7 over Lipscomb including a 6-4 record in Nashville. The Hatters have won the last four head-to-head meetings in the series, including a 41-point victory in DeLand on Jan. 19 (92-51). It was the team's largest margin of victory in 26 years. Sasha Sims scored 22 points on 9-of-11 shooting while also collecting seven rebounds and three assists. Cherrise Burris (16 points), Victoria McGowan (15), and Ashley Dennis (10) also scored in double figures.

Stetson's Recent Atlantic Sun Conference Success

Since the start of the 2010-11 season, Stetson is 36-16 (.692) in Atlantic Sun regular season games, 5-1 in A-Sun tournament games, and both years reached the A-Sun Tournament Finals. The Hatters won the A-Sun Championship in 2011.

Quick Hitters: Team News and Notes

- Since starting the year 1-3, Stetson is 17-4 in its last 21 games
- The Hatters have won 16 straight home games and are 28-1 in their last 28 home games
- Stetson leads the A-Sun in field goal pct. (.443) and three-point field goal pct. (.349)
- Stetson has outshot its opponent 19 times, but has outrebounded them only 10 times
- Stetson is 16-1 this year when outscoring their opponent in the paint

- Shanasa Sanders is averaging 19.2 points and 7.8 rebounds in her last six games
- Victoria McGowan has scored in double figures 22 times this season, including the last 11 games in a row.

Shanasa Sanders Named A-Sun Player of the Week, Again

For the second consecutive week, senior guard Shanasa Sanders was named the Atlantic Sun Conference Player of the Week last week. Sanders averaged 20.0 points, 7.5 rebounds, and 2.5 assists per game last week as the Hatters posted home wins over ETSU and USC Upstate. Sanders shot 50 percent from the field (13-26) and was a perfect 11-for-11 from the free throw line. Defensively she had three blocks and three steals on the week without committing a foul.

Dynamic Duo

Stetson's senior backcourt duo of Victoria McGowan and Shanasa Sanders are averaging a combined 30.5 points per game and 13.1 rebounds per game. Only Mercer's Precious Bridges/Kendra Grant have a higher combined scoring average (30.8). Over the last five games McGowan and Sanders are averaging a combined 14.9 points and 13.3 rebounds per game.

Best Class Ever?

Stetson's senior class has the opportunity to be winningest four-year class in the history of the women's basketball program. Since the start of the 2009-10 season, the Hatters have won 67 games. The 1988-89 senior class won 68 games over four seasons, so the Hatters need two more wins this season to set a new high-water mark. Ashley Dennis, Janelle Mills, and Simone Taylor are each in their fourth season with the Hatters. Victoria McGowan also came to Stetson in 2009 as a sophomore transfer.

Atlantic Sun Statistical Leaders

The Hatters currently rank among the top three Atlantic Sun statistical leaders in nearly every category except rebounding. The Hatters lead the league in field goal percentage (.443), and three-point field goal percentage (.349). Individually, Victoria McGowan leads the league in three-point FG made (56) and ranks second in three-point FG pct. (.444).

News and Notes

NCAA Statistical Leaders

In the Feb. 15 release of NCAA national statistics, the Hatters ranked 19th in the nation in field goal pct., 34th in three-point field goal pct., 37th in free throw pct., and 42nd in scoring. Victoria McGowan ranked sixth in the nation three-point field goal pct.

Shooting the Three

Stetson's top three season's in school history for three-point field goals made have come in each of the last three seasons: 201 in 2011-12 ... 173 in 2010-11 ... 168 so far in 2012-13.

Free Throw Shooting

Stetson's top three season's in school history for free throw shooting pct. have come in each of the last three seasons: .754 in 2011-12730 so far in 2012-13725 in 2010-11.

McGowan Chasing School Points Record

Senior Victoria McGowan has been climbing the charts towards the school record for most career points. She currently ranks fourth in Stetson history with 1426 points, and needs 32 more points to move into third place. The school record holder for points scored is Michelle Michael with 1570. At her current season scoring pace, McGowan would have to play nine more games to break the record.

5th Season at Stetson

Lynn Bria is in her fifth season at the helm of Stetson women's basketball in 2012-13 after a second straight excellent campaign in 2011-12. Under Bria, the Hatters won a school record 23 games and advanced to the postseason for the second year in a row, participating in the WNIT for the first time in school history. Three players earned All-Atlantic Sun honors including A-Sun Player of the Year and All-Tournament Team selection Victoria McGowan, who led the nation with three triple-doubles. Also honored were Second Team All-Atlantic Sun forward Sasha Sims and A-Sun All-Freshman Team forward Cherisse Burris.

Bria's 2010-11 Hatters won 20 games for the first time in 10 seasons, captured their third Atlantic Sun Conference tournament championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second time in school history and first time since 2005.

Stetson's turnaround under Bria from 6-24 to 20-13 (+12.5 games) was the second largest improvement in NCAA Division I women's basketball. Honors that came to members of the team included A-Sun Tournament MVP (Victoria McGowan), A-Sun All-Tournament Team (Tierra Brown, Sasha Sims), Second Team All-Atlantic Sun (McGowan), A-Sun All-Freshman Team (Sims), A-Sun Player of the Week (Natasha Graboski) and A-Sun Newcomer of the Week (McGowan twice, Sims). Graboski went on to sign a professional contract with Alexandria of Romania's Division 1 League in the summer of 2011.

In 2009-10 Bria led the Hatters to their seventh consecutive A-Sun tournament appearance. In her first season at Stetson, Bria made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as her 2009-10 incoming class was ranked by Michael T. White's noted scouting service All-Star Girls Report as the best in the Atlantic Sun and in the top third of all NCAA Division I teams.

Bria has coached women's basketball for 20 years with 14 seasons of Division I head coaching experience to her credit at UCF, Ohio University and Stetson. In addition to coaching, she has extensive classroom experience at the university level and is committed to developing young women both athletically and academically.

Prior to joining the Hatters, Bria spent the previous two seasons as an assistant coach at top-level programs West Virginia (2006-07) and most recently the University of Miami. Her excellent recruiting skills led to the Hurricanes signing a Top 25 incoming class according to recruiting experts at www.HoopGurlz.com. With WVU, Bria served as recruiting coordinator in addition to her on-court coaching duties. Her leadership helped the Mountaineers achieve one of their best seasons in school history, which featured an at-large bid to and second round appearance in the NCAA Tournament as well as the second-largest turnaround in W-L record in Big East Conference history (15-16 to 21-11 overall and from 4-12 to 11-5 in Big East games).

From 1999-2006, Bria was the head coach at Ohio University in Athens, Ohio. She is second all-time in career wins at Ohio and was the first coach in Bobcats history to sign a recruit that would become Mid-American Conference Freshman of the Year.

Prior to taking the position at Ohio, Bria led UCF for three seasons from 1996-99. Her final Golden Knights team in 1998-99 was the TAAC (now Atlantic Sun) regular season and tournament champions and appeared in the NCAA Tournament. For her efforts, Bria was named the 1998-99 TAAC Coach of the Year. In just three seasons, she ranked second in career wins at UCF.

Bria's first head coaching position came at Division II Texas Woman's University in Denton, Texas for three seasons from 1993-96. At the age of 24, Bria was the fourth-youngest head coach in the country when she was hired. She coached the team, coordinated fundraising and taught in the Kinesiology department in addition to serving on the NCAA Division II Tournament regional selection committee. Her Pioneer squads won more games each year of her tenure than the one previously.

Her first three years out of college at the University of Charleston (W. Va.) were spent on the coaching staffs at Marshall (where she obtained her Master's degree in 1992) and Radford, where she helped lead the Highlanders to the Big South regular season and tournament titles in 1992-93.

A standout performer for the Charleston Golden Eagles, the Class of 1990 graduate was inducted into her alma mater's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2003. She scored 1,146 points in her career, averaging 10.3 points per game and was a 75.3 percent free throw shooter over her career.

The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At Deland's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.
