News and Notes

Preview

The Stetson women's basketball team looks for its 20th win of the season tonight as the Hatters host the Kennesaw State Owls at the Edmunds Center. Tip-off is scheduled for 5:00 p.m. in the first game of a women's and men's doubleheader.

The All-Time Series vs. KSU / The Last Meeting

Today will mark the 17th all-time meeting between Stetson and Kennesaw State. Stetson leads the all-time series 13-3 and the Hatters have won the last eight head-to-head meetings. Stetson owns a 5-2 advantage over KSU in DeLand.

The Last Meeting With KSU

Victoria McGowan scored a career-high 33 points and Stetson rallied from a 12-point second-half deficit to defeat Kennesaw State 57-52 on Jan. 2 in Kennesaw. Stetson was uncharacteristically cold from the floor, shooting just 30% in the opening 20 minutes including a 1-for-10 mark from behind the arc. The Owls led 30-25 at halftime and extended the lead to 48-36 on a three from Danielle Jackson with 10:49 remaining. McGowan answered with a three of her own, just the second three-pointer of the game for Stetson, and the Hatters started what would be a game-winning 15-0 run. Defensively the Hatters went into a zone defense, which forced Kennesaw into several turnovers and kept the Owls completely off the scoreboard for the next nine minutes. "I thought Victoria McGowan put the team on her back," coach Lynn Bria said. "It's what she does. She'll take over a game. I don't know so much that Victoria just loves winning as she just hates losing. I can always tell when she gets that look, that she is about to take over the game." McGowan went 8-for-16 from the floor and 15-of-17 from the line to become the first Hatter since Nefertiti Walker in 2006 to score 30 or more points in a game. She added 10 rebounds for her 11th career double-double. Shanasa Sanders led the Hatters with 12 rebounds.

A Hatters Win Today Would...

- Give Stetson its fifth 20-win season in school history
- Give Stetson its third consecutive 20-win season (would be the first time in school history)
- Break the school-record for most wins in a four-year span (currently 68)
- Tie the school record for most conference wins in a season (13, 2000-01 and 2010-11)

Triple-Doubles

After recording an NCAA-best three triple-doubles a year ago, Victoria McGowan picked up her fourth career triple-double against Lipscomb on Feb. 18. McGowan joined Baylor's Brittney Griner as the only two active players in Division I with four career triple-doubles. Stetson's eight triple-double performances all-time is tied with Kansas State and Stanford for the most in NCAA Women's Basketball history.

Stetson's Recent Atlantic Sun Conference Success

Since the start of the 2010-11 season, Stetson is 37-17 (.685) in Atlantic Sun regular season games, 5-1 in A-Sun tournament games, and both years reached the A-Sun Tournament Finals. The Hatters won the A-Sun Championship in 2011.

Quick Hitters: Team News and Notes

- Since starting the year 1-3, Stetson is 18-5 in its last 23 games
- The Hatters are 28-2 in their last 30 home games (both losses to FGCU)
- Stetson leads the A-Sun in field goal pct. (.440) and three-point field goal pct. (.344)

Dynamic Duo

Stetson's senior backcourt duo of Victoria McGowan and Shanasa Sanders are averaging a combined 30.2 points per game and 13.0 rebounds per game. McGowan and Sanders are tied with Mercer's Precious Bridges/Kendra Grant who also have a 30.2 combined scoring average. The last Hatter duo to average over 30 points per game was Nefertiti Walker (21.5) and Janene Maclin (8.7) in 2005-06.

The Wins Streaks

11-Games Overall

Stetson set a school record with an 11-game winning streak from Dec. 15-Jan. 21. That streak ranked as the third-longest active winning streak in the nation on the day it ended, Jan. 26.

16-Games at Home

Stetson set a school record with a 16-game home court winning streak from Jan. 26-Feb. 11. That streak ranked as the seventh-longest active home court winning streak in the nation on the day it ended, Feb. 23.

The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At DeLand's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.

Preseason Accolades

The Stetson women's basketball team was picked to finish first in the Atlantic Sun Conference preseason coaches poll, and the league's head coaches also predicted the Hatters to win the conference tournament. For the second straight year, senior guard Victoria McGowan was selected as the Atlantic Sun Preseason Player of the Year. McGowan earned Player of the Year honors last season after leading the league in points, assists, steals, field goals made and free throws made. Joining McGowan on the preseason all-conference team were senior guard Shanasa Sanders and junior forward Sasha Sims.

News and Notes

Best Class Ever?

Stetson's senior class has the opportunity to be winningest four-year class in the history of the women's basketball program. Since the start of the 2009-10 season, the Hatters have won 68 games. The 1988-89 senior class also won 68 games over four seasons, so the Hatters need one more win this season to set a new high-water mark. Ashley Dennis, Janelle Mills, and Simone Taylor are each in their fourth season with the Hatters. Victoria McGowan also came to Stetson in 2009 as a sophomore transfer but sat out the 2009-10 season.

Atlantic Sun Statistical Leaders

The Hatters currently rank among the top three Atlantic Sun statistical leaders in nearly every category except rebounding. The Hatters lead the league in field goal percentage (.440), and three-point field goal percentage (.344). Individually, Victoria McGowan leads the league in three-point FG made (61) and ranks second in three-point FG pct. (.449).

NCAA Statistical Leaders

In the Feb. 25 release of NCAA national statistics, the Hatters ranked 21st in the nation in field goal pct., 37th in three-point field goal pct., and 50th in scoring. Victoria McGowan ranked seventh in the nation three-point field goal pct.

McGowan Chasing School Points Record

Senior Victoria McGowan has been climbing the charts towards the school record for most career points. She currently ranks fourth in Stetson history with 1455 points, and needs three more points to move into third place. The school record holder for points scored is Michelle Michael with 1570. At her current season scoring pace, McGowan would have to play seven more games to break the record.

Stetson is approaching the school record for most wins in a season (23, set last year). The 19 wins this year ties for the fifth-highest single-season win total in school history:

5th Season at Stetson

Lynn Bria is in her fifth season at the helm of Stetson women's basketball in 2012-13 after a second straight excellent campaign in 2011-12. Under Bria, the Hatters won a school record 23 games and advanced to the postseason for the second year in a row, participating in the WNIT for the first time in school history. Three players earned All-Atlantic Sun honors including A-Sun Player of the Year and All-Tournament Team selection Victoria McGowan, who led the nation with three triple-doubles. Also honored were Second Team All-Atlantic Sun forward Sasha Sims and A-Sun All-Freshman Team forward Cherisse Burris.

Bria's 2010-11 Hatters won 20 games for the first time in 10 seasons, captured their third Atlantic Sun Conference tournament championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second time in school history and first time since 2005.

Stetson's turnaround under Bria from 6-24 to 20-13 (+12.5 games) was the second largest improvement in NCAA Division I women's basketball. Honors that came to members of the team included A-Sun Tournament MVP (Victoria McGowan), A-Sun All-Tournament Team (Tierra Brown, Sasha Sims), Second Team All-Atlantic Sun (McGowan), A-Sun All-Freshman Team (Sims), A-Sun Player of the Week (Natasha Graboski) and A-Sun Newcomer of the Week (McGowan twice, Sims). Graboski went on to sign a professional contract with Alexandria of Romania's Division 1 League in the summer of 2011.

In 2009-10 Bria led the Hatters to their seventh consecutive A-Sun tournament appearance. In her first season at Stetson, Bria made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as her 2009-10 incoming class was ranked by Michael T. White's noted scouting service All-Star Girls Report as the best in the Atlantic Sun and in the top third of all NCAA Division I teams.

Bria has coached women's basketball for 20 years with 14 seasons of Division I head coaching experience to her credit at UCF, Ohio University and Stetson. In addition to coaching, she has extensive classroom experience at the university level and is committed to developing young women both athletically and academically.

Prior to joining the Hatters, Bria spent the previous two seasons as an assistant coach at top-level programs West Virginia (2006-07) and most recently the University of Miami. Her excellent recruiting skills led to the Hurricanes signing a Top 25 incoming class according to recruiting experts at www.HoopGurlz.com. With WVU, Bria served as recruiting coordinator in addition to her on-court coaching duties. Her leadership helped the Mountaineers achieve one of their best seasons in school history, which featured an at-large bid to and second round appearance in the NCAA Tournament as well as the second-largest turnaround in W-L record in Big East Conference history (15-16 to 21-11 overall and from 4-12 to 11-5 in Big East games).

From 1999-2006, Bria was the head coach at Ohio University in Athens, Ohio. She is second all-time in career wins at Ohio and was the first coach in Bobcats history to sign a recruit that would become Mid-American Conference Freshman of the Year.

Prior to taking the position at Ohio, Bria led UCF for three seasons from 1996-99. Her final Golden Knights team in 1998-99 was the TAAC (now Atlantic Sun) regular season and tournament champions and appeared in the NCAA Tournament. For her efforts, Bria was named the 1998-99 TAAC Coach of the Year. In just three seasons, she ranked second in career wins at UCF.

Bria's first head coaching position came at Division II Texas Woman's University in Denton, Texas for three seasons from 1993-96. At the age of 24, Bria was the fourth-youngest head coach in the country when she was hired. She coached the team, coordinated fundraising and taught in the Kinesiology department in addition to serving on the NCAA Division II Tournament regional selection committee. Her Pioneer squads won more games each year of her tenure than the one previously.

Her first three years out of college at the University of Charleston (W. Va.) were spent on the coaching staffs at Marshall (where she obtained her Master's degree in 1992) and Radford, where she helped lead the Highlanders to the Big South regular season and tournament titles in 1992-93.

A standout performer for the Charleston Golden Eagles, the Class of 1990 graduate was inducted into her alma mater's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2003. She scored 1,146 points in her career, averaging 10.3 points per game and was a 75.3 percent free throw shooter over her career.
