## **News and Notes**

#### **Preview**

The Stetson Hatters will go for their fourth title in league history a trip to the NCAA Tournament when they square off against top-seeded Florida Gulf Coast in the 2013 General Shale Atlantic Sun Conference championship game at 5:30 p.m. Saturday evening on CSS, ESPN3 and ASun.TV. The Hatters advanced to the finals for the third straight year with a hard-fought 67-52 victory over no. 3 seed Mercer Friday afternoon.

#### 1 of 6

The Hatters are one of six teams in conference history to play in three straight championship games, and the first since ETSU played in four straight from 2007-10.

#### **Dynamic Trio**

Stetson's trio of Victoria McGowan, Shanasa Sanders, and Sasha Sims have combined for 101 points in the A-Sun tournament so far. They combined for 53 of the team's 66 points against ETSU on Wednesday and for 48 of the team's 67 points on Friday. Against conference opponents this season (20 games), the trio is averaging a combined 44.3 points per game.

#### Stetson's Recent Atlantic Sun Conference Success

Since the start of the 2010-11 season, Stetson is a combined 46-18 (.719) against Atlantic Sun opposition. That includes a 39-17 (.696) regular season mark and a 7-1 record in A-Sun tournament games. The Hatters have advanced to the A-Sun Championship game in each of the last three seasons, winning the title in 2011.

#### The All-Time Series vs. FGCU / The Last Meetings

FGCU leads the all-time series 11-2 over Mercer, including wins in both meetings earlier this season. FGCU also won last year's championship 67-39 over Stetson.

- Give Stetson its school-record 24th win of the season

# A-Sun Awards

For the first time in school history, the Stetson women's basketball team landed three student-athletes on the Atlantic Sun all-conference first and second teams, the league announced with its annual postseason awards on Tuesday.

Senior guard Victoria McGowan (Inkster, Mich.) earned first-team all-conference honors for the second straight year, while senior Shanasa Sanders (Jacksonville, Fla.) and junior Sasha Sims (Fayetteville, Ga.) were each selected to the all-conference second-team.

A three-time Atlantic Sun Player of the Week, McGowan is averaging 16.1 points and 6.8 rebound per game this season. She ranks third in the league in scoring, assists (4.3), and steals (2.1). The Hatter senior has scored in double figures in 25 of her 28 games, and she is tied for the league-lead with 62 three-point field goals.

McGowan surpassed 20 points seven times, including a career-best 33-point performance in a come-from-behind victory at Kennesaw State on Jan. 2. She posted four double-doubles and the league's only triple-double on Feb. 18 at Lipscomb (19 pts./12 reb./10 ast.). Her .434 three-point field goal pct. ranks second in the A-Sun and seventh in the NCAA.

McGowan joins Michelle Michael and Kristy Brown as the only players in program history to be a two-time, first-team allconference honoree.

Sanders averaged 13.8 points and 6.5 rebounds per game en route to her first all-conference selection. The team's leading scorer in 12 contests this season, Sanders ranks fourth in the league in scoring, 11th in rebounding, and 10th in assists (2.5). She was named A-Sun Player of the Week in back-to-back weeks in early February.

For the season Sanders has started all 29 games and averages a team-high 32.7 minutes per game. She has scored in double figures 20 times, including four 20+point games. The Hatter senior enters the postseason on a roll, having averaged 17.2 points and 7.2 rebounds over the final 10 games of the regular season.

A second-team all-conference selection for the second straight year, Sims is averaging 11.4 points, 3.9 rebounds, and 1.4 blocks per game. She posted the seventh highest scoring average in the league in A-Sun games, averaging 13.5 ppg and shooting 49.7 percent against conference opponents. In fact, Sims scored 20 or more points six times in conference play, including the last three games of the regular season.

A strong defensive post player, Sims has registered 42 blocks this season. She ranks third among A-Sun players in that category and her 111 career blocks ranks third in Stetson history.

# The Wins Streaks

#### 11-Games Overall

Stetson set a school record with an 11-game winning streak from Dec. 15-Jan. 21. That streak ranked as the third-longest active winning streak in the nation on the day it ended, Jan. 26.

#### 16-Games at Home

Stetson set a school record with a 16game home court winning streak from Jan. 26-Feb. 11. That streak ranked as the seventh-longest active home court winning streak in the nation on the day it ended, Feb. 23.

# The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At Deland's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in

his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.

# News and Notes

#### Dynamic Duo

Stetson's senior backcourt duo of Victoria McGowan (16.0) and Shanasa Sanders (14.0) are averaging a combined 30.0 points per game, the most of any duo in the Atlantic Sun. The last Hatter duo to average over 30 points per game was Nefertiti Walker (21.5) and Janene Maclin (8.7) in 2005-06 (30.2 ppg combined).

#### **Best Class Ever**

Stetson's senior class is the winningest four-year class in the history of the women's basketball program. Since the start of the 2009-10 season, the Hatters have won 72 games. Ashley Dennis, Janelle Mills, and Simone Taylor are each in their fourth season with the Hatters. Victoria McGowan also came to Stetson in 2009 as a sophomore transfer but sat out the 2009-10 season.

#### Atlantic Sun Statistical Leaders

The Hatters currently rank among the top three Atlantic Sun statistical leaders in nearly every category except rebounding. The Hatters lead the league in field goal percentage (.440), and three-point field goal percentage (.332), they rank second in scoring offense, scoring margin, blocks, and fewest turnovers, and they rank third in scoring defense, assists and steals. Individually, Victoria McGowan leads the league in three-point field goals (66) and she ranks second in three-point FG pct. (.423).

#### **NCAA Statistical Leaders**

In the Mar. 8 release of NCAA national statistics, the Hatters ranked 15th in the nation in fewest turnovers per game, 22nd in field goal pct., 44th in three-point field goal pct., and 44th in scoring. Victoria McGowan ranked seventh in the nation three-point field goal pct. (.423).

#### **McGowan Chasing School Points Record**

Senior Victoria McGowan has been climbing the charts towards the school record for most career points. She currently ranks third in Stetson history and 24th in A-Sun history with 1504 points. The school record holder for points scored is Michelle Michael with 1570. Kristy Brown ranks second with 1522 points.

#### **Triple-Doubles**

After recording an NCAA-best three triple-doubles a year ago, Victoria McGowan picked up her fourth career triple-double against Lipscomb on Feb. 18. McGowan joined Baylor's Brittney Griner as the only two active players in Division I with four career triple-doubles. Stetson's eight triple-double performances all-time is tied with Kansas State and Stanford for the most in NCAA Women's Basketball history.

# The Head Coach



# Lynn Bria HEAD COACH Charleston (WV), 1990 5th Season at Stetson

Lynn Bria is in her fifth season at the helm of Stetson women's basketball in 2012-13 after a second straight excellent campaign in 2011-12. Under Bria, the Hatters won a school record 23 games and advanced to the postseason for the second year in a row, participating in the WNIT for the first time in school history. Three players earned All-Atlantic Sun honors including A-Sun Player of the Year and All-Tournament Team selection Victoria McGowan, who led the nation with three triple-doubles. Also honored were Second Team All-Alantic Sun forward Sasha Sims and A-Sun All-Freshman Team forward Cherisse Burris.

Bria's 2010-11 Hatters won 20 games for the first time in 10 seasons, captured their third Atlantic Sun Conference tournament championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second time in school history and first time since 2005.

Stetson's turnaround under Bria from 6-24 to 20-13 (+12.5 games) was the second largest improvement in NCAA Division I women's basketball. Honors that came to members of the team included A-Sun Tournament MVP (Victoria McGowan), A-Sun All-Tournament Team (Tierra Brown, Sasha Sims), Second Team All-Atlantic Sun (McGowan), A-Sun All-Freshman Team (Sims), A-Sun Player of the Week (Natasha Graboski) and A-Sun Newcomer of the Week (McGowan twice, Sims). Graboski went on to sign a professional contract with Alexandria of Romania's Division 1 League in the summer of 2011.

In 2009-10 Bria led the Hatters to their seventh consecutive A-Sun tournament appearance. In her first season at Stetson, Bria made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as her 2009-10 incoming class was ranked by Michael T. White's noted scouting service All-Star Girls Report as the best in the Atlantic Sun and in the top third of all NCAA Division I teams.

Bria has coached women's basketball for 20 years with 14 seasons of Division I head coaching experience to her credit at UCF, Ohio University and Stetson. In addition to coaching, she has extensive classroom experience at the university level and is committed to developing young women both athletically and academically.

Prior to joining the Hatters, Bria spent the previous two seasons as an assistant coach at top-level programs West Virginia (2006-07) and most recently the University of Miami. Her excellent recruiting skills led to the Hurricanes signing a Top 25 incoming class according to recruiting experts at www.HoopGurlz.com. With WVU, Bria served as recruiting coordinator in addition to her on-court coaching duties. Her leadership helped the Mountaineers achieve one of their best seasons in school history, which featured an at-large bid to and second round appearance in the NCAA Tournament as well as the second-largest turnaround in W-L record in Big East Conference history (15-16 to 21-11 overall and from 4-12 to 11-5 in Big East games).

From 1999-2006, Bria was the head coach at Ohio University in Athens, Ohio. She is second all-time in career wins at Ohio and was the first coach in Bobcats history to sign a recruit that would become Mid-American Conference Freshman of the Year.

Prior to taking the position at Ohio, Bria led UCF for three seasons from 1996-99. Her final Golden Knights team in 1998-99 was the TAAC (now Atlantic Sun) regular season and tournament champions and appeared in the NCAA Tournament. For her efforts, Bria was named the 1998-99 TAAC Coach of the Year. In just three seasons, she ranked second in career wins at UCF.

Bria's first head coaching position came at Division II Texas Woman's University in Denton, Texas for three seasons from 1993-96. At the age of 24, Bria was the fourth-youngest head coach in the country when she was hired. She coached the team, coordinated fundraising and taught in the Kinesiology department in addition to serving on the NCAA Division II Tournament regional selection committee. Her Pioneer squads won more games each year of her tenure than the one previously.

Her first three years out of college at the University of Charleston (W. Va.) were spent on the coaching staffs at Marshall (where she obtained her Master's degree in 1992) and Radford, where she helped lead the Highlanders to the Big South regular season and tournament titles in 1992-93.

A standout performer for the Charleston Golden Eagles, the Class of 1990 graduate was inducted into her alma mater's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2003. She scored 1,146 points in her career, averaging 10.3 points pergame and was a 75.3 percentfree throw shooter over her career.



## vs. FGCU This Season



The Stetson women's basketball team had its school-record 11-game winning streak halted by Florida Gulf Coast 74-55 Saturday night at Alico Arena.

Victoria McGowan and Shanasa Sanders each scored 16 points as the Hatters (15-5, 8-1 A-Sun) suffered just their first conference loss of the year.

Stetson's 11-game win streak had ranked as the third-longest active streak in the NCAA, trailing only Baylor's 16-game streak and Notre Dame's 13 consecutive wins.

In a match-up between two undefeated teams in A-Sun play, the Eagles (16-5, 9-0 A-Sun) owned a significant advantage on the boards, outrebounding Stetson 43-29. FGCU converted 16 offensive rebounds into 15 second chance points.

"I thought the game would come down to rebounding and it did," Stetson head coach Lynn Bria said. "I thought they got some critical rebounds when we needed stops. They are not a team that you can keep giving possessions, and if you do you are in trouble. It is something we can learn from."


The Eagles hit seven three-pointers in the first half and jumped out to a 37-24 halftime lead.

Stetson bit into the lead in the second half as Sasha Sims drained a threepointer with 12 minutes left to cut the lead to eight. Jama Sharp and Sanders later converted a two-on-one fastbreak at the 7:38 mark to pull Stetson within six, 53-47, but the Hatters would get no closer.

"I thought our second half was much more aggressive," Bria said. "I thought we were much more aggressive defensively and our offense was better. Overall I thought our game plan was good, our effort was pretty good, but the rebounding hurt us."

Sims scored nine points and collected two blocks in the game and became just the third player in school history to record 100 career blocks. McGowan also surpassed the 200 career steals mark and now ranks seventh in school history in that category.

Notes: Janelle Mills played in her 117th career game, tied for third-most in school history. She recorded two blocks ... McGowan moved up to seventh all-time in school history in points scored (1348) ... Jama Sharp has 21 steals in her last five games (three on Saturday) ... Sanders scored the final 10 points for Stetson and added a team-high eight rebounds.



Junior Sasha Sims scored 20 points including the 1000th point of her career, but visiting Florida Gulf Coast defeated Stetson 72-55 Saturday afternoon in an Atlantic Sun Conference game at the Edmunds Center.

The loss snapped Stetson's 16-game home court winning streak, and the Hatters (19-8, 12-4 A-Sun) suffered just their first home loss of the year. The Eagles (23-5, 16-0) remained undefeated in A-Sun play.

Victoria McGowan added 10 points, five rebounds, and three steals for Stetson.

Unlike when the same teams met in Fort Myers last month and rebounding proved to be the difference in the game, the key statistic in Saturday's matchup was inside points. The Eagles generated several lay-up opportunites throughout the contest and finished with a 40-22 advantage in points in the paint.

"I've talked all year about how heavily we rely on points in the paint, and so do they," Stetson head coach Lynn Bria said, referring to FGCU. "I don't deny that they shoot the three well, but at the end of the day they want a lay-up.

"I thought we did a very good job rebounding, I thought our effort was good, but I didn't think our execution was very good, and that is my job and it is my fault," Bria added. "It is correctable, but I think the points in the paint was the key stat. (FGCU) executed very well."

Sims was 7-for-11 from the floor while adding five rebounds, a block and two steals to her 20-point performance. Her 1000th point came on a lay-up midway through the second half, bringing a roar from the 1345 in attendance.

"That might be the best game I ever saw Sasha play on both ends of the floor," Bria said. "She gave everything she had, she played great and she just did everything for us both offensively and defensively. She executed on a real high level and I was really proud of her."

The Eagles jumped out to an early 12-3 lead, but the Hatters answered back on a 17-3 run to take a 20-16 lead at the 7:53 mark. FGCU regained the lead with a 12-0 run of its own, but Jama Sharp's three-pointer with 2:41 to go in the first half tied the score at 28.

"I thought Jama was great as well, I really liked her tempo," Bria said. "(Sharp and Sims) were our two most aggressive players."

The Eagles led by five at halftime and outscored Stetson 37-25 in the second half. Sarah Hansen led FGCU with 27 points.

"I know we have to beat Kennesaw on Thursday, that's our most important game now," Bria said when asked if she was hoping for a third meeting with FGCU in the postseason. "We have to play well on Thursday and we have to finish up well at home. The next two games are real important to us and hopefully we can build some momentum going into the conference tournament."
