News and Notes

Preview

The start of the 2012-13 Atlantic Sun Conference season begins today as the Stetson Hatters visit the Mercer Bears. Stetson went 7-4 in non-conference play, including a 6-0 mark at home. After starting the season 1-3, the Hatters have won six of their last seven games, including their last three in a row.

Stetson's Recent Atlantic Sun Conference Success

Over the last two seasons, Stetson is 25-13 in Atlantic Sun regular season games, 5-1 in A-Sun tournament games, and both years reached the A-Sun Tournament Finals. The Hatters won the A-Sun Championship in 2011.

The All-Time Series vs. Mercer

Today will mark the 63rd all-time meeting between Stetson and Mercer. Stetson leads the all-time series 33-29 and have won the last four head-to-head meetings. Last year the Hatters won 89-84 at Mercer and 68-46 in DeLand.

Quick Hatters: News and Notes

- The Hatters have won three straight and six of their last seven games
- Stetson is 10-2 in the month of December over the last two seasons (6-1 last yr, 4-1 this yr)
- Stetson is 19-12 in the 2012 calendar year and going for its 20th win today
- Stetson's seven non-conference wins is tied for the A-Sun lead
- Stetson is 30-14 (.682) over the last two seasons in Atlantic Sun regular season and post season games combined
- Victoria McGowan is 10 points shy of 1200 in her career
- The top three individual field goal pct. leaders in the A-Sun are all Hatters - Jama Sharp (.523), Victoria McGowan (.513), and Cherrisse Burris (.500)

A-Sun Statistical Leaders

The Hatters currently lead the A-Sun in the top four team offensive categories - scoring (69.0 ppg), field goal percentage (.436), three-point field goal percentage (.366), and free throw percentage (.762). Individually, Jama Sharp leads the A-Sun in field goal percentage (.436) and Victoria McGowan leads the league in three-point field goal pct. (.457).

McGowan Named Hatter Classic MVP

Senior Victoria McGowan was named Hatter Classic MVP after averaging 16.0 points, 6.5 rebounds, and 6.0 assists in the Hatter victories over Georgia Southern and UNC Asheville. It was her third straight appearance on the Hatter Classic all-tournament team and her third tournament MVP award (Atlantic Sun-2011, Winthrop Invitational-2011). Sophomore Cherrisse Burris joined McGowan on the all-tournament team after scoring a career-high 18 points in the win over UNC Asheville.

Home Cooking

The Hatters have won 10 straight home games (6-0 this season), tying for the 16th-longest active streak in the nation and the second longest in the state of Florida (UF). The Hatters have also won 22 of their last 23 and 25 of their last 27 games at the Edmunds Center.

Second Half Lead Changes

In Stetson's season-opener against Hofstra, the lead changed hands six times in the final 10 minutes. In the Hatters' 10 games since, the lead has not changed hands at all in the final 10 minutes of any game. In addition, each of the last 10 games have all been decided by eight points or more. The Hofstra game was decided by just two points.

30-Point Win

Stetson's 70-39 victory over Georgia Southern was just the teams' second 30-point victory since 1989, and the first over a Division I opponent. The Hatters defeated Saint Leo 73-37 on Nov. 13, 2010, and prior to that was a 90-60 victory over UCF on Feb. 4, 1989.

Three-Point Team Record

The Hatters set a new single-game school record by hitting 14 three-pointers in their win over Ball State on Nov. 25.

Sharing the Ball

The Hatters picked up 24 assists in their win over Ball State on Nov. 25. The last time Stetson had 24 or more assists in a game was on Jan. 3, 1998, in a 102-99 double overtime loss to UCF. The Hatters had 26 assists in that game. Lynn Bria was the head coach of UCF.

The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At DeLand's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.



2012-13 Hatter Awards

McGowan = A-Sun Player of the Week

For the first time this season and for the fifth time in her career, Victoria McGowan was named the Atlantic Sun Conference Player of the Week on Nov. 27. McGowan averaged 21.5 points, 6.0 rebounds, and 5.5 assists while leading the Hatters to a pair of victories. Against B-CU, she scored a season-high 27 points, including 13 in a row during a key second half-run, while adding eight rebounds and five steals. Against Ball State, McGowan tied with teammate Shanasa Sanders with a game-high 16 points. She hit four of the Hatters' school-record 14 three-pointers while dishing out seven assists. For the week McGowan shot 54 percent (13-for-24) from the field and 75 percent (9-for-12) from behind the arc. The Sports Management major currently ranks third in the league in scoring (17.0 ppg), seventh in rebounding (6.8 rpg), and second in assists (5.0 apg). McGowan is the only player in school history and one of 11 in Atlantic Sun history to earn the league's Player of the Week award five times.

News and Notes

How are They Doing Now?

Three of the Hatters' four losses this year came to teams with a current combined record of 29-5. Big East opponent USF is now 10-2, ACC opponent Florida State is 11-1, and Atlantic 10 opponent Charlotte is 8-2.

Preseason Accolades

The Stetson women's basketball team was picked to finish first in the Atlantic Sun Conference preseason coaches poll, and the league's head coaches also predicted the Hatters to win the conference tournament. For the second straight year, senior guard Victoria McGowan was selected as the Atlantic Sun Preseason Player of the Year. McGowan earned Player of the Year honors last season after leading the league in points, assists, steals, field goals made and free throws made. Joining McGowan on the preseason all-conference team were senior guard Shanasa Sanders and junior forward Sasha Sims.

Best Class Ever?

Stetson's senior class has the opportunity to be winningest four-year class in the history of the women's basketball program. Since the start of the 2009-10 season, the Hatters have won 56 games. The 1988-89 senior class won 68 games over four seasons, so the Hatters need 13 more wins this season to set a new high-water mark. Here is a list of the top winningest four-year classes in Stetson women's basketball history:

Senior CLASS Award

Senior guard Victoria McGowan has been selected as one of just 30 NCAA Division I women's basketball student-athletes as a candidate for the 2012 Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must be classified as an NCAA Division I senior and have notable achievements in four areas of excellence – community, classroom, character and competition. Each of the 30 candidates will be narrowed to 10 finalists in Feb. 2013.

Stetson University women's basketball head coach Lynn Bria proudly announced the signing of five student-athletes to National Letters-of-Intent on Nov. 15. Woodson HS), **Amber Porter** (Woodbridge, Va./Potomac HS), and **Brianti Saunders** (Hilliard, Fla./Hilliard Middle-Senior HS).

5th Season at Stetson

Lynn Bria is in her fifth season at the helm of Stetson women's basketball in 2012-13 after a second straight excellent campaign in 2011-12. Under Bria, the Hatters won a school record 23 games and advanced to the postseason for the second year in a row, participating in the WNIT for the first time in school history. Three players earned All-Atlantic Sun honors including A-Sun Player of the Year and All-Tournament Team selection Victoria McGowan, who led the nation with three triple-doubles. Also honored were Second Team All-Atlantic Sun forward Sasha Sims and A-Sun All-Freshman Team forward Cherisse Burris.

Bria's 2010-11 Hatters won 20 games for the first time in 10 seasons, captured their third Atlantic Sun Conference tournament championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second time in school history and first time since 2005.

Stetson's turnaround under Bria from 6-24 to 20-13 (+12.5 games) was the second largest improvement in NCAA Division I women's basketball. Honors that came to members of the team included A-Sun Tournament MVP (Victoria McGowan), A-Sun All-Tournament Team (Tierra Brown, Sasha Sims), Second Team All-Atlantic Sun (McGowan), A-Sun All-Freshman Team (Sims), A-Sun Player of the Week (Natasha Graboski) and A-Sun Newcomer of the Week (McGowan twice, Sims). Graboski went on to sign a professional contract with Alexandria of Romania's Division 1 League in the summer of 2011.

In 2009-10 Bria led the Hatters to their seventh consecutive A-Sun tournament appearance. In her first season at Stetson, Bria made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as her 2009-10 incoming class was ranked by Michael T. White's noted scouting service All-Star Girls Report as the best in the Atlantic Sun and in the top third of all NCAA Division I teams.

Bria has coached women's basketball for 20 years with 14 seasons of Division I head coaching experience to her credit at UCF, Ohio University and Stetson. In addition to coaching, she has extensive classroom experience at the university level and is committed to developing young women both athletically and academically.

Prior to joining the Hatters, Bria spent the previous two seasons as an assistant coach at top-level programs West Virginia (2006-07) and most recently the University of Miami. Her excellent recruiting skills led to the Hurricanes signing a Top 25 incoming class according to recruiting experts at www.HoopGurlz.com. With WVU, Bria served as recruiting coordinator in addition to her on-court coaching duties. Her leadership helped the Mountaineers achieve one of their best seasons in school history, which featured an at-large bid to and second round appearance in the NCAA Tournament as well as the second-largest turnaround in W-L record in Big East Conference history (15-16 to 21-11 overall and from 4-12 to 11-5 in Big East games).

From 1999-2006, Bria was the head coach at Ohio University in Athens, Ohio. She is second all-time in career wins at Ohio and was the first coach in Bobcats history to sign a recruit that would become Mid-American Conference Freshman of the Year.

Prior to taking the position at Ohio, Bria led UCF for three seasons from 1996-99. Her final Golden Knights team in 1998-99 was the TAAC (now Atlantic Sun) regular season and tournament champions and appeared in the NCAA Tournament. For her efforts, Bria was named the 1998-99 TAAC Coach of the Year. In just three seasons, she ranked second in career wins at UCF.

Bria's first head coaching position came at Division II Texas Woman's University in Denton, Texas for three seasons from 1993-96. At the age of 24, Bria was the fourth-youngest head coach in the country when she was hired. She coached the team, coordinated fundraising and taught in the Kinesiology department in addition to serving on the NCAA Division II Tournament regional selection committee. Her Pioneer squads won more games each year of her tenure than the one previously.

Her first three years out of college at the University of Charleston (W. Va.) were spent on the coaching staffs at Marshall (where she obtained her Master's degree in 1992) and Radford, where she helped lead the Highlanders to the Big South regular season and tournament titles in 1992-93.

A standout performer for the Charleston Golden Eagles, the Class of 1990 graduate was inducted into her alma mater's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2003. She scored 1,146 points in her career, averaging 10.3 points per game and was a 75.3 percent free throw shooter over her career.
