News and Notes

Preview

After posting an 8-4 mark in non-conference play, the Stetson University women's basketball team will begin Atlantic Sun Conference play on Saturday night at Florida Gulf Coast. Tip-off is scheduled for 7:03 p.m. in a game broadcast live on ESPN3.

The All-Time Series

FGCU leads the all-time series 11-3 over Stetson, which includes a 6-0 mark at Alico Arena. The two teams have met six times in the past two years, four times in the regular season and in each of the past two Atlantic Sun Championship games. The Eagles won in 2012, and the Hatters won in 2013, rallying from a 15-point second-half deficit to win 70-64. Sasha Sims averages 11.1 points, 6.2 rebounds, and 1.9 blocks in eight games vs. FGCU.

Quick Hitters: Team News and Notes

- Stetson has won three straight, five of six, and seven of its last nine games
- Stetson leads the A-Sun in scoring (79.2), field goal pct. (.449), rebounding (43.4), assists (15.7), and blocked shots (5.8), and ranks second in three point field goal pct. (.349).
- Sasha Sims (135 blocks) needs three blocks to break the school record of 137.
- Sasha Sims and Brianti Saunders are the top scoring duo in the Atlantic Sun (34.0 ppg).

Oh What a December

After going 3-3 in November, the Hatters went 5-1 in December, and in the process:

- Averaged 87.0 points scored and 67.3 points allowed per game (+19.7 scoring margin)
- Shot 48.0% from the floor and 39.3% from three-point range
- Averaged 47.3 rebounds and 17.0 assists per game
- Brianti Saunders averaged a team-high 18.7 points and shot 51.4%.
- Sasha Sims averaged 16.5 points and was 13-for-27 from behind the arc.
- Amber Porter had four double-doubles & averaged 14.2 points, 12.3 boards, and 5.6 blocks
- Cherisse Burris averaged 12.5 points, 9.8 rebounds, and shot 60.0% (27-for-45)
- Jama Sharp averaged 12.8 points, 6.2 assists, and was 12-for-23 from three-point range.
- C.J. Coddington shot 57% (4-7) from behind the arc and 100% (7-7) from the line
- The team had eight double-doubles (Porter-4, Burris-3, Sharp-1)

Block Party

Freshman post player Amber Porter has had an incredible season to date, especially when it comes to blocking shots. Here some notes on Porter's blocking statistics:

- Her 47 blocks ranked second in the nation (as of Monday); currently second in A-Sun
- Her 47 blocks is the fourth highest single-season total in school history
- Her 47 blocks is tied for the 13th-highest career total in school history
- She is on pace for the fifth-highest blocks total for a freshman in NCAA history
- She has had at least one block in every game
- She has recorded 6+ blocks in four games. Previously, the Hatters have had a player record 6+ blocks in a game only four times total in school history.
- Her eight blocks vs. Palm Beach Atlantic tied the school single-game record
- She had 34 blocks in December (5.6/game), including 12 in the last two games

Hatters Among A-Sun Players of the Week

In the first eight weeks of the season, the Hatters have had three A-Sun Players of the Week and four A-Sun Newcomers of the Week. In the 2013 calendar year, Stetson had a Player of the Week eight times (out of 18 weeks).

The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At DeLand's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.

News and Notes

High-Flying Hatters

As a team, Stetson has put up some amazing offensive numbers this season. The Hatters are averaging 79.2 points per game, the highest total in the A-Sun and the 35th-highest mark in the NCAA (as of Monday). They have topped 80 points six times, 90 points four times, and 100 points twice. Prior to this season, the Hatters hadn't had a 100-point game since 1989.

Five in Double Figures

After 12 games the Hatters "starting five" are all averaging double figures in scoring - Sasha Sims (18.6), Brianti Saunders (15.4), Amber Porter (12.1), Jama Sharp (11.4), and Cherisse Burris (11.4). Stetson is the only team in the Atlantic Sun with five active players averaging double figures in scoring.

Sasha Sims Leading the Team

As the lone senior on the team, Sasha Sims has been leading the team both on and off the court. She has led the team in scoring in eight of the 12 games this season, twice netting a career-high 28 points vs. Bethune-Cookman and Murray State. She leads the A-Sun in scoring (18.6 ppg), and she has scored in double figures in 19 straight games dating back to last year.

Jama Sharp With 10 Assists, Three Times

Coach Bria calls her the quarterback of the team, and so far she has delivered. Three times this season, junior Jama Sharp has recorded 10 assists in a game (vs. Stephen F. Austin, North Carolina A&T, and Florida A&M). Entering the week, she ranks second in the A-Sun and 22nd in the nation with a 6.2 assists/game average.

Three-Year Success Part I (Overall)

The Hatters have experienced quite a bit of success over the past three seasons, including:

- Three 20+ win seasons
- Three postseason appearances (2 NCAA, 1 WNIT)
- Two Atlantic Sun Conference Championships
- Three appearances in the Atlantic Sun Championship game

Three-Year Success Part II (State of Florida)

Since the start of the 2010-11 season, the Hatters have compiled a 75-37 record (.670). Only two other teams in the state of Florida have more wins than Stetson during that stretch: Florida Gulf Coast (90) and Miami (84). Only Stetson, FGCU, Miami, and Florida have won 20+ games in each of the past three seasons.

Three-Year Success Part III (Atlantic Sun)

Over the past three seasons, Stetson is 39-17 (.696) in Atlantic Sun regular season games and 8-1 in A-Sun tournament games. The Hatters have reached the A-Sun Championship game all three years, winning it twice (2011, 2013).

Sasha Sims Chasing School Points Record

Senior Sasha Sims is climbing the charts towards the school record for most career points. She currently ranks ninth in Stetson history with 1345 points. She needs 226 points to break the record held by Michelle Michael (1570, 1985-89). At her current season scoring pace she would only need 13 more games to break the record.

NCAA Statistical Leaders

In the Dec. 29 release of NCAA national statistics, the Hatters ranked 35th in the nation scoring (79.2), 36th in field goal pct. (.449), and 12th in blocked shots (5.8). Amber Porter ranked fourth in blocks/game (3.9) and Jama Sharp ranked 22nd in assists (6.2).

Fall Signees

In the fall signing period, the Hatters welcomed **Keevana Edwards** (Atlanta, Ga./Wesleyan School), **Lashai Geeter** (Detroit, Mich./Martin Luther King Jr. Senior HS), and **Sarah Sagerer** (Vocklabruck, Austria/The Rock School) to the program.

Hatters Add Two Transfers

Stetson also added 6-3 LaSalle University transfer **Brittany Jenkins-Murray** (Falls Church, Va.) and 5-7 Clemson University transfer **Aisha Turner** (College Park, Ga.) to Grant-in-Aid offers. Both will be eligible following the 2014 fall semester.

A-Sun Preseason Polls

Preseason Accolades

The Stetson University women's basketball team was picked to finish second in the 2013-14 Atlantic Sun Conference preseason coaches poll. Senior **Sasha Sims** was tabbed as the Atlantic Sun Preseason Defensive Player of the Year, and she was also selected to the preseason all-conference team. Last season, Sims averaged 12.0 points, 4.1 rebounds, and 1.6 blocks per game and earned second-team all-conference honors. Sims averaged better than 17 points per game during the Atlantic Sun Championship and was named to the all-tournament team. She has already surpassed 1000 points for her career and is just 16 blocks shy of breaking the school-record in that category.

Sixth Season at Stetson (84-81)

19th Career Season (237-294)

A three-time Atlantic Sun Conference champion as a head coach, Lynn Bria is in her sixth season at the helm of Stetson women's basketball program.

In just the last three seasons Bria has turned the Hatters into a formidable force in the Atlantic Sun. She has guided the Hatters to two conference titles, two NCAA Tournament appearances, a WNIT bid, and three 20+ win seasons. In fact, Stetson is just one of three schools in the state of Florida to post over 65 victories since the start of the 2010-11 season.

The 2012-13 season was one for the history books as the Hatters set numerous team records and captured their second A-Sun title in the past three seasons. Bria helped lead the Hatters to a school-record 24 wins overall, a 12-1 record at home, a school-record 14 wins in A-Sun play, and winning streaks of 11 straight overall and 16 in a row at home. In the A-Sun Championship game, Stetson rallied from a 15-point second-half deficit to defeat top-seeded and previously undefeated FGCU 70-64, and then earned their highest-ever NCAA Tournament seed (14) and an appearance in the Columbus, Ohio regional against UCLA.

In 2011-12, the Hatters won a school-record 23 games and advanced to the postseason for the second year in a row, participating in the WNIT for the first time in school history. Three players earned All-Atlantic Sun honors including A-Sun Player of the Year and All-Tournament Team selection Victoria McGowan, who led the nation with three triple-doubles. Also honored were Second Team All-Atlantic Sun forward Sasha Sims and A-Sun All-Freshman Team forward Cherisse Burris.

Bria's 2010-11 Hatters won 20 games for the first time in 10 seasons, captured their third Atlantic Sun Conference tournament championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second time in school history and first time since 2005.

Stetson's turnaround under Bria from 6-24 to 20-13 (+12.5 games) was the second largest improvement in NCAA Division I women's basketball. Honors that came to members of the team included A-Sun Tournament MVP (Victoria McGowan), A-Sun All-Tournament Team (Tierra Brown, Sasha Sims), Second Team All-Atlantic Sun (McGowan), A-Sun All-Freshman Team (Sims), A-Sun Player of the Week (Natasha Graboski) and A-Sun Newcomer of the Week (McGowan twice, Sims). Graboski went on to sign a professional contract with Alexandria of Romania's Division 1 League in the summer of 2011.

In 2009-10 Bria led the Hatters to their seventh consecutive A-Sun tournament appearance. In her first season at Stetson, Bria made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as her 2009-10 incoming class was ranked by Michael T. White's noted scouting service All-Star Girls Report as the best in the Atlantic Sun and in the top third of all NCAA Division I teams.

Bria has coached women's basketball for 20 years with 14 seasons of Division I head coaching experience to her credit at UCF, Ohio University and Stetson. In addition to coaching, she has extensive classroom experience at the university level and is committed to developing young women both athletically and academically.

Prior to joining the Hatters, Bria spent the previous two seasons as an assistant coach at top-level programs West Virginia (2006-07) and most recently the University of Miami. Her excellent recruiting skills led to the Hurricanes signing a Top 25 incoming class according to recruiting experts at www.HoopGurlz.com. With WVU, Bria served as recruiting coordinator in addition to her on-court coaching duties. Her leadership helped the Mountaineers achieve one of their best seasons in school history, which featured an at-large bid to and second round appearance in the NCAA Tournament as well as the second-largest turnaround in W-L record in Big East Conference history (15-16 to 21-11 overall and from 4-12 to 11-5 in Big East games).

From 1999-2006, Bria was the head coach at Ohio University in Athens, Ohio. She also led UCF for three seasons from 1996-99. Her final Golden Knights team in 1998-99 was the TAAC (now Atlantic Sun) regular season and tournament champions and appeared in the NCAA Tournament. Her first head coaching position came at Division II Texas Woman's University in Denton, Texas for three seasons from 1993-96.

A standout performer for the Charleston Golden Eagles, the Class of 1990 graduate was inducted into her alma mater's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2003. She scored 1,146 points in her career, averaging 10.3 points per game and was a 75.3 percent free throw shooter over her career.
