News and Notes

Preview

Stetson opens a season-long four-game road trip at Northern Kentucky Thursday night. Tip-off is scheduled for 7:00 p.m. at the Bank of Kentucky Center.

The All-Time Series vs. Northern Kentucky

Last year marked the first-ever meetings between Stetson and Northern Kentucky, with each team winning on its home court. The Hatters defeated the Norse 62-39 in DeLand on Jan. 21, while NKU defeated Stetson 73-68 in Highland Heights, Ky. on Feb. 16.

Quick Hitters: Team News and Notes

- Stetson has won six straight and nine of its last 10 games overall
- Stetson leads the A-Sun in scoring (79.2), field goal pct. (.459), three point field goal pct. (.369), rebounding (43.6), and assists (15.6) and ranks second in blocked shots (4.9)
- Stetson ranks 30th in the NCAA in scoring (79.2) and 18th in field goal pct. (.459)
- Amber Porter ranks sixth in the NCAA in blocks (3.5), first among freshmen
- Jama Sharp ranks 20th in the NCAA in assists (6.2)
- Sasha Sims needs 10 points to move into fourth place on Stetson's all-time scoring list
- Stetson has had five or more players score in double figures 10 times this season

Six Wins in a Row

Stetson's six-game winning streak ranks as the 18th longest active winning streak in the nation, as of Monday. During the Hatters win streak:

- Stetson has never trailed by more than five points
- The Hatters average 83.0 ppg offensively and have allowed 65.8 ppg defensively
- The Hatters are shooting nearly 50% as a team (.497)
- The Hatters shot 56.7% vs. ETSU and 56.9% at Kennesaw State
- Amber Porter is averaging 18.2 ppg (62.9% FG pct.) and Cherisse Burris is shooting 57.1%

Key Stats

This season, Stetson is:

- 14-0 when scoring 70 points or more (W 29 straight games overall)
- 14-1 when outscoring its opponent in the paint
- 14-1 when having more free throw attempts than its opponent
- 12-1 when leading at halftime
- 12-1 when outrebounding its opponent

Home Cooking

The Hatters are red hot at home this year, going 9-0 and averaging over 85 points per game. Stetson has won 11 straight at home dating back to last season, which ranks as the 14th-longest home court winning streak in the nation.

Second Half Shutdown

Three times in the last six games, Stetson has made some critical adjustments at halftime to lower their opponent's field goal pct. On Jan. 9, USC Upstate shot 44% in the first half but just 23% in the second half. On Jan. 16, Mercer shot 49% in the first half and 34% in the second half. On Thursday, UNF shot 55% in the first half and 26% in the second half.

Amber Alert

Freshman post player Amber Porter has had an incredible season to date, especially when it comes to blocking shots. Here some notes on Porter's blocking statistics:

- Her 3.5 blocks/game average ranks second in the A-Sun and sixth in the NCAA (tops among all freshmen in the country)
- Her 67 blocks is the second highest single-season total in school history
- Her 67 blocks is the seventh-highest career total in school history
- She has had at least two blocks in 16 of the 19 games
- She has recorded 6+ blocks in five games. Previously, the Hatters have had a player record 6+ blocks in a game only four times total in school history.
- Her eight blocks vs. Palm Beach Atlantic tied the school single-game record

High-Flying Hatters

As a team, Stetson has put up some amazing offensive numbers this season. The Hatters are averaging 79.2 points per game, the highest total in the A-Sun and the 30th-highest mark in the NCAA (as of Monday). They have topped 80 points nine times, 90 points six times, and 100 points twice. Prior to this season, the Hatters had not had a 100-point game since 1989.

Streaking

- Stetson has not played an overtime contest in its last 68 games (Jan. 7, 2012 vs. Jacksonville)
- Stetson has won 24 straight games when opponents score 55 points or less

- Stetson has won 17 straight non-conference home games
- Stetson has won 11 straight home games

Individual Streaks

- Sasha Sims has not missed a game in her career (119 games)
- Cherisse Burris and Jama Sharp have not missed a game in their careers (86 games)
- Cherisse Burris has recorded at least one rebound in 86 straight games
- Jama Sharp has recorded at least one assist in 29 straight games
- Amber Porter has scored in double figures in six straight games
- Cherisse Burris has scored in double figures in five straight games

- Sasha Sims is 123 points shy of breaking the school record for most points in a career
- Cherisse Burris needs 30 rebounds for 500 in her career
- Amber Porter needs six blocks to break the single-season blocks record
- Jama Sharp needs nine three-pointers for 100
- Sasha Sims needs one game played to move into second all-time in school history in games played.

The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At DeLand's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.

News and Notes

Five in Double Figures

After 19 games the Hatters have five players averaging double figures in scoring - Sasha Sims (17.2), Brianti Saunders (13.7), Amber Porter (13.7), Cherisse Burris (10.9), and Jama Sharp (10.9). Stetson is the only team in the Atlantic Sun with five active players averaging double figures in scoring. All five rank among the top 20 scorers in the Atlantic Sun.

NCAA Statistical Leaders

In the Jan. 27 release of NCAA national statistics, the Hatters ranked 30th in the nation scoring (79.2), 18th in field goal pct. (.459), and 27th in blocked shots (4.9). Amber Porter ranked sixth in blocks/game (3.5) and Jama Sharp ranked 20th in assists (6.1).

Season Scoring Averages

At 79.2 points per game, Stetson is maintaining its third-highest season scoring average in school history. Only the 1986-87 (also 79.2 ppg) and 1988-89 (80.3 ppg) teams had higher season-long scoring averages.

Sasha Sims Leading the Team

As the lone senior on the team, Sasha Sims has been leading the team both on and off the court. She has led the team in scoring in 10 of the 19 games this season, twice netting a career-high 28 points (Bethune-Cookman, Murray State). She is also second in the A-Sun in scoring (17.2 ppg), and she has scored in double figures in 18 of the 19 games this season.

Jama Sharp With 10 Assists, Four Times

Coach Bria calls her the quarterback of the team, and so far she has delivered. Four times this season, junior Jama Sharp has recorded 10 assists in a game (vs. Stephen F. Austin, North Carolina A&T, Florida A&M, and UNF). As of Monday, she ranks second in the A-Sun and 20th in the nation with a 6.3 assists/game average.

Three-Year Success Part I (Overall)

The Hatters have experienced quite a bit of success over the past three seasons, including:

- Three 20+ win seasons
- Three postseason appearances (2 NCAA, 1 WNIT)
- Two Atlantic Sun Conference Championships
- Three appearances in the Atlantic Sun Championship game

Three-Year Success Part II (State of Florida)

Since the start of the 2010-11 season, the Hatters have compiled a 81-38 record (.681). Only two other teams in the state of Florida have more wins than Stetson during that stretch:

Only Stetson, FGCU, Miami, and UF have won 20+ games in each of the past three seasons.

Three-Year Success Part III (Atlantic Sun)

Over the past three seasons, Stetson is 45-18 (.714) in Atlantic Sun regular season games and 8-1 in A-Sun tournament games. The Hatters have reached the A-Sun Championship game all three years, winning it twice (2011, 2013).

Sasha Sims Chasing School Points Record

Senior Sasha Sims is climbing the charts towards the school record for most career points. She currently ranks fifth in Stetson history with 1448 points. She needs 123 points to break the record held by Michelle Michael (1570, 1985-89). At her current season scoring pace she would only need eight more games to break the record (Feb. 22 at Jacksonville).

Fall Signees

In the fall signing period, the Hatters welcomed **Keevana Edwards** (Atlanta, Ga./Wesleyan School), **Lashai Geeter** (Detroit, Mich./Martin Luther King Jr. Senior HS), and **Sarah Sagerer** (Vocklabruck, Austria/The Rock School) to the program.

A-Sun Preseason Polls

Preseason Accolades

The Stetson University women's basketball team was picked to finish second in the 2013-14 Atlantic Sun Conference preseason coaches poll. Senior **Sasha Sims** was tabbed as the Atlantic Sun Preseason Defensive Player of the Year, and she was also selected to the preseason all-conference team. Last season, Sims averaged 12.0 points, 4.1 rebounds, and 1.6 blocks per game and earned second-team all-conference honors. Sims averaged better than 17 points per game during the Atlantic Sun Championship and was named to the all-tournament team. She has already surpassed 1000 points for her career and is just 16 blocks shy of breaking the school-record in that category.

Sixth Season at Stetson

19th Career Season

A three-time Atlantic Sun Conference champion as a head coach, Lynn Bria is in her sixth season at the helm of Stetson women's basketball program.

In just the last three seasons Bria has turned the Hatters into a formidable force in the Atlantic Sun. She has guided the Hatters to two conference titles, two NCAA Tournament appearances, a WNIT bid, and three 20+ win seasons. In fact, Stetson is just one of three schools in the state of Florida to post over 65 victories since the start of the 2010-11 season.

The 2012-13 season was one for the history books as the Hatters set numerous team records and captured their second A-Sun title in the past three seasons. Bria helped lead the Hatters to a school-record 24 wins overall, a 12-1 record at home, a school-record 14 wins in A-Sun play, and winning streaks of 11 straight overall and 16 in a row at home. In the A-Sun Championship game, Stetson rallied from a 15-point second-half deficit to defeat top-seeded and previously undefeated FGCU 70-64, and then earned their highest-ever NCAA Tournament seed (14) and an appearance in the Columbus, Ohio regional against UCLA.

In 2011-12, the Hatters won a school-record 23 games and advanced to the postseason for the second year in a row, participating in the WNIT for the first time in school history. Three players earned All-Atlantic Sun honors including A-Sun Player of the Year and All-Tournament Team selection Victoria McGowan, who led the nation with three triple-doubles. Also honored were Second Team All-Atlantic Sun forward Sasha Sims and A-Sun All-Freshman Team forward Cherisse Burris.

Bria's 2010-11 Hatters won 20 games for the first time in 10 seasons, captured their third Atlantic Sun Conference tournament championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second time in school history and first time since 2005.

Stetson's turnaround under Bria from 6-24 to 20-13 (+12.5 games) was the second largest improvement in NCAA Division I women's basketball. Honors that came to members of the team included A-Sun Tournament MVP (Victoria McGowan), A-Sun All-Tournament Team (Tierra Brown, Sasha Sims), Second Team All-Atlantic Sun (McGowan), A-Sun All-Freshman Team (Sims), A-Sun Player of the Week (Natasha Graboski) and A-Sun Newcomer of the Week (McGowan twice, Sims). Graboski went on to sign a professional contract with Alexandria of Romania's Division 1 League in the summer of 2011.

In 2009-10 Bria led the Hatters to their seventh consecutive A-Sun tournament appearance. In her first season at Stetson, Bria made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as her 2009-10 incoming class was ranked by Michael T. White's noted scouting service All-Star Girls Report as the best in the Atlantic Sun and in the top third of all NCAA Division I teams.

Bria has coached women's basketball for 20 years with 14 seasons of Division I head coaching experience to her credit at UCF, Ohio University and Stetson. In addition to coaching, she has extensive classroom experience at the university level and is committed to developing young women both athletically and academically.

Prior to joining the Hatters, Bria spent the previous two seasons as an assistant coach at top-level programs West Virginia (2006-07) and most recently the University of Miami. Her excellent recruiting skills led to the Hurricanes signing a Top 25 incoming class according to recruiting experts at www.HoopGurlz.com. With WVU, Bria served as recruiting coordinator in addition to her on-court coaching duties. Her leadership helped the Mountaineers achieve one of their best seasons in school history, which featured an at-large bid to and second round appearance in the NCAA Tournament as well as the second-largest turnaround in W-L record in Big East Conference history (15-16 to 21-11 overall and from 4-12 to 11-5 in Big East games).

From 1999-2006, Bria was the head coach at Ohio University in Athens, Ohio. She also led UCF for three seasons from 1996-99. Her final Golden Knights team in 1998-99 was the TAAC (now Atlantic Sun) regular season and tournament champions and appeared in the NCAA Tournament. Her first head coaching position came at Division II Texas Woman's University in Denton, Texas for three seasons from 1993-96.

A standout performer for the Charleston Golden Eagles, the Class of 1990 graduate was inducted into her alma mater's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2003. She scored 1,146 points in her career, averaging 10.3 points per game and was a 75.3 percent free throw shooter over her career.
