#### News and Notes

#### **Preview**

Winners of seven straight and 10 out of 11, Stetson continues a season-long four-game road trip at Lipscomb Saturday afternoon. Tip-off is scheduled for 5 p.m. ET at Allen Arena.

#### The All-Time Series vs. Lipscomb

Stetson leads the all-time series 13-7 over Lipscomb including a 7-4 record in Nashville. The Hatters have won the last five head-to-head meetings in the series, including a 68-54 victory on Feb. 18 last season in Nashville. Victoria McGowan recorded a triple-double in that game.

#### **Quick Hitters: Team News and Notes**

- Stetson has won seven straight and 10 of its last 11 games overall
- Stetson leads the A-Sun in scoring (79.7), field goal pct. (.460), three point field goal pct. (.338), rebounding (43.5), and assists (15.6) and ranks second in blocked shots (4.8)
- Stetson ranks 30th in the NCAA in scoring (79.7) and 18th in field goal pct. (.460)
- Amber Porter ranks sixth in the NCAA in blocks (3.4), first among freshmen
- Jama Sharp ranks 20th in the NCAA in assists (6.1)
- Stetson has had five or more players score in double figures 10 times this season
- Lynn Bria needs one win for 250 in her career (249-297, 19th season)
- Stetson is tied with UF and FSU for most wins in the state of Florida (15).

#### Seven Wins in a Row

Stetson's seven-game winning streak is tied for the 17th longest active winning streak in the nation, as of Friday. During the Hatters win streak:

- Stetson has never trailed by more than five points
- The Hatters average 84.0 ppg offensively and have allowed 65.9 ppg defensively (+18.1)
- The Hatters are shooting nearly 50% as a team (.495)
- The Hatters shot 56.7% vs. ETSU and 56.9% at Kennesaw State
- Amber Porter is averaging 18.0 ppg (63.6% FG pct.) and Cherisse Burris is shooting 54.2%

The seven-game streak also ties for the third-longest win streak in school history. Only the 10 game streak in 2011-12 and the school-record 11-game streak in 2012-13 were longer.

#### **Key Stats**

This season, Stetson is:

- 15-0 when scoring 70 points or more (W 30 straight games overall)
- 15-1 when outscoring its opponent in the paint (36-2 over past two seasons)
- 15-1 when having more free throw attempts than its opponent
- 13-1 when leading at halftime
- 13-1 when outrebounding its opponent

#### **High-Flying Hatters**

As a team, Stetson has put up some amazing offensive numbers this season. The Hatters are averaging 79.7 points per game, the highest total in the A-Sun and the 30th-highest mark in the NCAA (as of Monday). They have topped 80 points 10 times, 90 points seven times, and 100 points twice. Prior to this season, the Hatters had not had a 100-point game since 1989.

#### Five in Double Figures - "It's Hard to Guard"

After 20 games the Hatters have five players averaging double figures in scoring - Sasha Sims (17.2), Amber Porter (13.9), Brianti Saunders (13.5), Jama Sharp (11.2), and Cherisse Burris. Stetson is the only team in the Atlantic Sun with five active players averaging double figures in scoring. All five rank among the top 21 scorers in the Atlantic Sun.

#### **Second Half Shutdown**

Four times in the last seven games, the Hatters have made some critical adjustments at halftime to lower their opponent's field goal pct:

#### **Amber Alert**

Freshman post player Amber Porter has had an incredible season to date, especially when it comes to blocking shots. Here some notes on Porter's blocking statistics:

- Her 3.4 blocks/game average ranks second in the A-Sun and sixth in the NCAA (tops among all freshmen in the country)
- Her 68 blocks is the second highest single-season total in school history
- Her 68 blocks is the seventh-highest career total in school history
- She has had at least two blocks in 16 of the 20 games
- She has recorded 6+ blocks in five games. Previously, the Hatters have had a player record 6+ blocks in a game only four times total in school history.
- Her eight blocks vs. Palm Beach Atlantic tied the school single-game record

## The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At DeLand's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in

his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.

### Dominant at Home

#### News and Notes

#### **Home Cooking**

The Hatters are red hot at home this year, going 9-0 and averaging over 85 points per game. Stetson has won 11 straight at home dating back to last season, which ranks as the 13th-longest home court winning streak in the nation.

#### **NCAA Statistical Leaders**

In the Jan. 27 release of NCAA national statistics, the Hatters ranked 30th in the nation scoring (79.7), 18th in field goal pct. (.460), and 27th in blocked shots (4.8). Amber Porter ranked sixth in blocks/game (3.4) and Jama Sharp ranked 20th in assists (6.1).

#### Season Scoring Averages

At 79.7 points per game, Stetson is maintaining its second-highest season scoring average in school history. Only the 1988-89 (80.3 ppg) team had a higher season-long scoring average.

#### Sasha Sims Leading the Team

As the lone senior on the team, Sasha Sims has been leading the team both on and off the court. She has led the team in scoring in 11 of the 20 games this season, twice netting a career-high 28 points (Bethune-Cookman, Murray State). She is also second in the A-Sun in scoring (17.2 ppg), and she has scored in double figures in 19 of the 20 games this season.

#### Jama Sharp With 10 Assists, Four Times

Coach Bria calls her the quarterback of the team, and so far she has delivered. Four times this season, junior Jama Sharp has recorded 10 assists in a game (vs. Stephen F. Austin, North Carolina A&T, Florida A&M, and UNF). As of Monday, she ranks second in the A-Sun and 20th in the nation with a 6.1 assists/game average.

#### Three-Year Success Part I (Overall)

The Hatters have experienced quite a bit of success over the past three seasons, including:

- Three 20+ win seasons
- Three postseason appearances (2 NCAA, 1 WNIT)
- Two Atlantic Sun Conference Championships
- · Three appearances in the Atlantic Sun Championship game

#### Three-Year Success Part II (State of Florida)

Since the start of the 2010-11 season, the Hatters have compiled a 82-38 record (.683). Only two other teams in the state of Florida have more wins than Stetson during that stretch:

Only Stetson, FGCU, Miami, and UF have won 20+ games in each of the past three seasons.

#### Three-Year Success Part III (Atlantic Sun)

Over the past three seasons, Stetson is 46-18 (.719) in Atlantic Sun regular season games and 8-1 in A-Sun tournament games. The Hatters have reached the A-Sun Championship game all three years, winning it twice (2011, 2013).

#### Sasha Sims Chasing School Points Record

Senior Sasha Sims is climbing the charts towards the school record for most career points. She currently ranks fourth in Stetson history with 1465 points. She needs 106 points to break the record held by Michelle Michael (1570, 1985-89). At her current season scoring pace she would only need seven more games to break the record (Feb. 22 at Jacksonville).

#### Atlantic Sun Players of the Week

In 12 weeks of competition, the Hatters have had four Atlantic Sun Players of the Week and six Newcomers of the Week. Sasha Sims has been named Player of the Week three times and Brianti Saunders once. Amber Porter has been named Newcomer of the Week four times and Saunders twice.

#### Fall Signees

In the fall signing period, the Hatters welcomed **Keevana Edwards** (Atlanta, Ga./Wesleyan School), **Lashai Geeter** (Detroit, Mich./Martin Luther King Jr. Senior HS), and **Sarah Sagerer** (Vocklabruck, Austria/The Rock School) to the program.

#### **Hatters Add Two Transfers**

Stetson also added 6-3 LaSalle University transfer **Brittany Jenkins-Murray** (Falls Church, Va.) and 5-7 Clemson University transfer **Aisha Turner** (College Park, Ga.) to Grant-in-Aid offers. Both will be eligible following the 2014 fall semester.

#### **Preseason Accolades**

The Stetson University women's basketball team was picked to finish second in the 2013-14 Atlantic Sun Conference preseason coaches poll. Senior Sasha Sims was tabbed as the Atlantic Sun Preseason Defensive Player of the Year, and she was also selected to the preseason all-conference team. Last season, Sims averaged 12.0 points, 4.1 rebounds, and 1.6 blocks per game and earned secondteam all-conference honors. Sims averaged better than 17 points per game during the Atlantic Sun Championship and was named to the all-tournament team. She has already surpassed 1000 points for her career and is just 16 blocks shy of breaking the schoolrecord in that category.

# Lynn Bria

# HEAD COACH Charleston (WV), 1990 Sixth Season at Stetson 19th Career Season

A three-time Atlantic Sun Conference champion as a head coach, Lynn Bria is in her sixth season at the helm of Stetson women's basketball program.

In just the last three seasons Bria has turned the Hatters into a formidable force in the Atlantic Sun. She has guided the Hatters to two conference titles, two NCAA Tournament appearances, a WNIT bid, and three 20+ win seasons. In fact, Stetson is just one of three schools in the state of Florida to post over 65 victories since the start of the 2010-11 season.

The 2012-13 season was one for the history books as the Hatters set numerous team records and captured their second A-Sun title in the past three seasons. Bria helped lead the Hatters to a school-record 24 wins overall, a 12-1 record at home, a school-record 14 wins in A-Sun play, and winning streaks of 11 straight overall and 16 in a row at home. In the A-Sun Championship game, Stetson rallied from a 15-point second-half deficit to defeat top-seeded and previously undefeated FGCU 70-64, and then earned their highest-ever NCAA Tournament seed (14) and an appearance in the Columbus, Ohio regional against UCLA.

In 2011-12, the Hatters won a school-record 23 games and advanced to the postseason for the second year in a row, participating in the WNIT for the first time in school history. Three players earned All-Atlantic Sun honors including A-Sun Player of the Year and All-Tournament Team selection Victoria McGowan, who led the nation with three triple-doubles. Also honored were Second Team All-Alantic Sun forward Sasha Sims and A-Sun All-Freshman Team forward Cherisse Burris.

Bria's 2010-11 Hatters won 20 games for the first time in 10 seasons, captured their third Atlantic Sun Conference tournament championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second time in school history and first time since 2005.

Stetson's turnaround under Bria from 6-24 to 20-13 (+12.5 games) was the second largest improvement in NCAA Division I women's basketball. Honors that came to members of the team included A-Sun Tournament MVP (Victoria McGowan), A-Sun All-Tournament Team (Tierra Brown, Sasha Sims), Second Team All-Atlantic Sun (McGowan), A-Sun All-Freshman Team (Sims), A-Sun Player of the Week (Natasha Graboski) and A-Sun Newcomer of the Week (McGowan twice, Sims). Graboski went on to sign a professional contract with Alexandria of Romania's Division 1 League in the summer of 2011.

In 2009-10 Bria led the Hatters to their seventh consecutive A-Sun tournament appearance. In her first season at Stetson, Bria made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as her 2009-10 incoming class was ranked by Michael T. White's noted scouting service All-Star Girls Report as the best in the Atlantic Sun and in the top third of all NCAA Division I teams.

Bria has coached women's basketball for 20 years with 14 seasons of Division I head coaching experience to her credit at UCF, Ohio University and Stetson. In addition to coaching, she has extensive classroom experience at the university level and is committed to developing young women both athletically and academically.

Prior to joining the Hatters, Bria spent the previous two seasons as an assistant coach at top-level programs West Virginia (2006-07) and most recently the University of Miami. Her excellent recruiting skills led to the Hurricanes signing a Top 25 incoming class according to recruiting experts at www.HoopGurlz.com. With WVU, Bria served as recruiting coordinator in addition to her on-court coaching duties. Her leadership helped the Mountaineers achieve one of their best seasons in school history, which featured an at-large bid to and second round appearance in the NCAA Tournament as well as the second-largest turnaround in W-L record in Big East Conference history (15-16 to 21-11 overall and from 4-12 to 11-5 in Big East games).

From 1999-2006, Bria was the head coach at Ohio University in Athens, Ohio. She also led UCF for three seasons from 1996-99. Her final Golden Knights team in 1998-99 was the TAAC (now Atlantic Sun) regular season and tournament champions and appeared in the NCAA Tournament. Her first head coaching position came at Division II Texas Woman's University in Denton, Texas for three seasons from 1993-96.

A standout performer for the Charleston Golden Eagles, the Class of 1990 graduate was inducted into her alma mater's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2003. She scored 1,146 points in her career, averaging 10.3 points per game and was a 75.3 percent free throw shooter over her career.
