### Preview

Winners of 10 games in a row overall and 11 games in a row at home, Stetson begins a two-game homestand Thursday night vs. Kennesaw State. Tip-off is scheduled for 7 p.m. at the Edmunds Center. A sweep this weekend would clinch a home game for Stetson for the Atlantic Sun tournament quarterfinals.

### The All-Time Series vs. KSU / The Last Meeting

Today will mark the 19th all-time meeting between Stetson and Kennesaw State. Stetson leads the all-time series 15-3 and the Hatters have won the last 10 head-to-head meetings, including a 98-75 victory in Kennesaw on Jan. 18. Amber Porter had 28 points and 11 rebounds to lead the Hatters.

### Quick Hitters: Team News and Notes

- Stetson has won 10 straight and 13 of its last 14 games overall
- A win today would tie for the longest winning streak in school history (11, set last year)
- The Hatters are 9-0 at home this season and averaging over 85 points per game (85.7)
- Stetson has won 11 straight, 27 out of 28 and 39 out of 41 at home
- Stetson ranks 23rd in the NCAA in scoring (79.8) and 16th in field goal pct. (.460)

### Winning Streak Notes

During the 10-game winning streak:

- Stetson has never trailed by more than 5 points
- Stetson has only trailed in the second half to one opponent (UNF)
- The Hatters have averaged 82.9 ppg offensively and have outscored their opponents by a 20.0 scoring margin
- The Hatters are shooting 48.4%, while opponents are shooting just 34.2%
- Amber Porter is averaging 17.5 ppg (59.6% FG pct.) and has scored in double figures in all 10 games

## The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At DeLand's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.

### High-Flying Hatters

As a team, Stetson has put up some amazing offensive numbers this season. The Hatters are averaging 79.8 points per game, the highest total in the A-Sun and the 23rd-highest mark in the NCAA (as of Monday). They have topped 80 points 12 times, 90 points seven times, and 100 points twice. Prior to this season, the Hatters had not had a 100-point game since 1989.

### Five in Double Figures - "It's Hard to Guard"

After 23 games the Hatters have five players averaging double figures in scoring - Sasha Sims (16.1), Amber Porter (14.2), Brianti Saunders (12.6), Jama Sharp (11.6), and Cherrisse Burris (10.7). Stetson is the only team in the Atlantic Sun with five active players averaging double figures in scoring. All five rank among the top 21 scorers in the Atlantic Sun.

### Amber Alert

Freshman post player Amber Porter has had an incredible season to date, especially when it comes to blocking shots. Here some notes on Porter's blocking statistics:

- Her 3.4 blocks/game average ranks second in the A-Sun and seventh in the NCAA
- Her 79 blocks is the most of any freshman in the NCAA
- Her 79 blocks is the highest single-season total in school history (surpassing old record of 72)
- Her 79 blocks is the fifth-highest career total in school history
- She has had at least two blocks in 19 of the 23 games
- She has recorded 6+ blocks in five games. Previously, the Hatters have had a player record 6+ blocks in a game only four times total in school history.
- Her eight blocks vs. Palm Beach Atlantic tied the school single-game record

### NCAA Statistical Leaders

In the Feb. 10 release of NCAA national statistics, the Hatters ranked 23rd in the nation scoring (79.8), 16th in field goal pct. (.460), and 29th in blocked shots (4.9). Amber Porter ranked seventh in blocks/game (3.4) and 29th in field goal pct. (.553), while Jama Sharp ranked 21st in assists (5.9) and 32nd in steals (2.6).

### Season Scoring Averages

At 79.8 points per game, Stetson is maintaining its second-highest season scoring average in school history. Only the 1988-89 (80.3 ppg) team had a higher season-long scoring average. Stetson needs 85 points in its next game to be averaging 80.0 ppg for the season.

### Jama Sharp Stepping Up

Jama Sharp has been filling the stat sheet of late. At USC Upstate, the Hatter junior registered 19 points, five rebounds, five assists, and seven steals. At ETSU, Sharp collected 16 points, five rebounds, four assists, and six steals. Her 13 steals over the past two games has vaulted her into the conference lead with 59. She is also averaging 16.6 points over her last five games.

### Myeisha Hall Also Stepping Up

Myeisha Hall had a great run of late for the Hatters. She averaged 12.3 points, 5.8 rebounds, and 2.0 steals during the recent four-game road swing. At USC Upstate, the Hatter junior scored a season-high 14 points, then topped that mark by scoring 17 points at ETSU. She hit four three-pointers in six attempts against the Buccaneers.

## News and Notes

### Sasha Sims Leading the Team

As the lone senior on the team, Sasha Sims has been leading the team both on and off the court. She has led the team in scoring in 11 of the 23 games this season, twice netting a career-high 28 points (Bethune-Cookman, Murray State). She ranks second in the A-Sun in scoring (16.1 ppg), and she has scored in double figures in 20 of the 23 games this season.

### Jama Sharp With 10 Assists, Four Times

Coach Bria calls her the quarterback of the team, and so far she has delivered. Four times this season, junior Jama Sharp has recorded 10 assists in a game (vs. Stephen F. Austin, North Carolina A&T, Florida A&M, and UNF). As of Friday, she ranked second in the A-Sun and 21st in the nation with a 5.9 assists/game average.

### Three-Year Success Part I (Overall)

The Hatters have experienced quite a bit of success over the past three seasons, including:

- Three 20+ win seasons
- Three postseason appearances (2 NCAA, 1 WNIT)
- Two Atlantic Sun Conference Championships
- Three appearances in the Atlantic Sun Championship game

### Three-Year Success Part II (State of Florida)

Since the start of the 2010-11 season, the Hatters have compiled a 85-38 record (.691). Only two other teams in the state of Florida have more wins than Stetson during that stretch:

Over the past three seasons, Stetson is 49-18 (.731) in Atlantic Sun regular season games and 8-1 in A-Sun tournament games. The Hatters have reached the A-Sun Championship game all three years, winning it twice (2011, 2013).

### Sasha Sims Chasing School Points Record

Senior Sasha Sims is climbing the charts towards the school record for most career points. She currently ranks fourth in Stetson history with 1492 points. She needs 79 points to break the record held by Michelle Michael (1570, 1985-89). At her current season scoring pace she would only need five more games to break the record (Feb. 27 vs. Northern Kentucky).

### Fall Signees

In the fall signing period, the Hatters welcomed **Keevana Edwards** (Atlanta, Ga./Wesleyan School), **Lashai Geeter** (Detroit, Mich./Martin Luther King Jr. Senior HS), and **Sarah Sagerer** (Vocklabruck, Austria/The Rock School) to the program.

### Hatters Add Two Transfers

Stetson also added 6-3 LaSalle University transfer **Brittany Jenkins-Murray** (Falls Church, Va.) and 5-7 Clemson University transfer **Aisha Turner** (College Park, Ga.) to Grant-in-Aid offers. Both will be eligible following the 2014 fall semester.
