# The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At DeLand's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in

his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.

#### **High-Flying Hatters**

As a team, Stetson has put up some amazing offensive numbers this season. The Hatters are averaging 80.1 points per game, the highest total in the A-Sun and the 23rd-highest mark in the NCAA (as of Monday). They have topped 80 points 13 times, 90 points seven times, and 100 points twice. Prior to this season, the Hatters had not had a 100-point game since 1989.

#### Five in Double Figures - "It's Hard to Guard"

After 24 games the Hatters have five players averaging double figures in scoring - Sasha Sims (16.1), Amber Porter (14.1), Brianti Saunders (12.6), Jama Sharp (11.4), and Cherisse Burris (10.8). Stetson is the only team in the Atlantic Sun with five active players averaging double figures in scoring. All five rank among the top 21 scorers in the Atlantic Sun.

#### Jama Sharp Stepping Up

Jama Sharp has been filling the stat sheet of late. At USC Upstate, the Hatter junior registered 19 points, five rebounds, five assists, and seven steals. At ETSU, Sharp collected 16 points, five rebounds, four assists, and six steals. Her 13 steals over those two games has vaulted her into the conference lead (60). She is also averaging 15.2 points over her last six games.

#### Myeisha Hall Also Stepping Up

Myesiha Hall had a great run of late for the Hatters. She averaged 12.3 points, 5.8 rebounds, and 2.0 steals during the recent four-game road swing. At USC Upstate, the Hatter junior scored a season-high 14 points, then topped that mark by scoring 17 points at ETSU. She hit four three-pointers in six attempts against the Buccaneers.

#### Sasha Sims Leading the Team

As the lone senior on the team, Sasha Sims has been leading the team both on and off the court. She has led the team in scoring in 12 of the 24 games this season, twice netting a career-high 28 points (Bethune-Cookman, Murray State). She ranks second in the A-Sun in scoring (16.1 ppg), and she has scored in double figures in 21 of the 24 games this season.

#### Jama Sharp With 10 Assists, Four Times

Coach Bria calls her the quarterback of the team, and so far she has delivered. Four times this season, junior Jama Sharp has recorded 10 assists in a game (vs. Stephen F. Austin, North Carolina A&T, Florida A&M, and UNF). As of Monday, she ranked second in the A-Sun and 23rd in the nation with a 5.9 assists/game average.

#### Three-Year Success Part I (Overall)

The Hatters have experienced quite a bit of success over the past three seasons, including:

- Three 20+ win seasons
- Three postseason appearances (2 NCAA, 1 WNIT)
- Two Atlantic Sun Conference Championships

#### Three-Year Success Part II (State of Florida)

#### Sasha Sims Chasing School Points Record

Senior Sasha Sims is climbing the charts towards the school record for most career points. She currently ranks fourth in Stetson history with 1492 points. She needs 79 points to break the record held by Michelle Michael (1570, 1985-89). At her current season scoring pace she would only need five more games to break the record (Feb. 27 vs. Northern Kentucky).

#### Fall Signees

In the fall signing period, the Hatters welcomed **Keevana Edwards** (Atlanta, Ga./Wesleyan School), **Lashai Geeter** (Detroit, Mich./Martin Luther King Jr. Senior HS), and **Sarah Sagerer** (Vocklabruck, Austria/The Rock School) to the program.

#### **Hatters Add Two Transfers**

Stetson also added 6-3 LaSalle University transfer **Brittany Jenkins-Murray** (Falls Church, Va.) and 5-7 Clemson University transfer **Aisha Turner** (College Park, Ga.) to Grant-in-Aid offers. Both will be eligible following the 2014 fall semester.
