Today will mark the 34th all-time meeting between Stetson and Jacksonville, with Stetson leading the series 19-14. The Hatters have won eighth straight over the Dolphins, including a 84-67 victory in DeLand on Jan. 25.

- Achieved its best 25-game start in school history (20-5, currently 21-5)

Longest in School History

Stetson's 13-game winning streak is the longest winning streak in school history, surpassing last year's record mark of 11.

Winning Streak Notes

During the 13-game winning streak:

- Stetson has never trailed by more than 5 points
- Stetson has only trailed in the second half to one opponent (UNF)
- The Hatters have averaged 81.9 ppg offensively and have outscored their opponents by a +20.8 scoring margin
- The Hatters are shooting 48.6%, while opponents are shooting just 33.6%
- Seven Hatters are averaging 8.4 ppg or better
- Five Hatters are averaging double figures
- Amber Porter is averaging 15.8 ppg (55.6% FG pct.) and has scored in double figures in 12 of the 13 games

The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At DeLand's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.

High-Flying Hatters

As a team, Stetson has put up some amazing offensive numbers this season. The Hatters are averaging 79.7 points per game, the highest total in the A-Sun and the 23rd-highest mark in the NCAA. They have topped 80 points 14 times, 90 points seven times, and 100 points twice. Prior to this season, the Hatters had not had a 100-point game since 1989.

Five in Double Figures - "It's Hard to Guard"

After 26 games the Hatters have five players averaging double figures in scoring - Sasha Sims (15.2), Amber Porter (13.7), Brianti Saunders (12.9), Jama Sharp (11.6), and Cherisse Burris (10.7). Stetson is the only team in the Atlantic Sun with five active players averaging double figures in scoring. All five rank among the top 23 scorers in the Atlantic Sun.

Amber Alert

Freshman post player Amber Porter has had an incredible season to date, especially when it comes to blocking shots. Here some notes on Porter's blocking statistics:

- Her 3.5 blocks/game average ranks second in the A-Sun and seventh in the NCAA
- Her 91 blocks is the most of any freshman in the NCAA
- Her 91 blocks is the highest single-season total in school history (surpassing old record of 72)
- Her 91 blocks is the fourth-highest career total in school history
- She has had at least two blocks in 21 of the 26 games
- She has recorded 6+ blocks in six times. Previously, the Hatters have had a player record 6+ blocks in a game only four times total in school history.
- Her eight blocks vs. Palm Beach Atlantic tied the school single-game record

NCAA Statistical Leaders

In the Feb. 21 release of NCAA national statistics, the Hatters ranked 21st in the nation scoring (79.7), 15th in field goal pct. (.463), 19th in field goal pct. defense (.354), and 29th in blocked shots (4.9). Amber Porter ranked seventh in blocks/game (3.5) and 42nd in field goal pct. (.535), while Jama Sharp ranked 26th in assists (5.7) and 31st in assist/turnover ratio (2.3).

Season Scoring Averages

At 79.7 points per game, Stetson is maintaining its second-highest season scoring average in school history. Only the 1988-89 (80.3 ppg) team had a higher season-long scoring average.

Jama Sharp Stepping Up

Jama Sharp has been filling the stat sheet of late. At USC Upstate, the Hatter junior registered 19 points, five rebounds, five assists, and seven steals. At ETSU, Sharp collected 16 points, five rebounds, four assists, and six steals. Her 13 steals over those two games has vaulted her into the conference lead (62). She is also averaging 14.9 points over her last eight games.

Myeisha Hall Also Stepping Up

Myeisha Hall had a great run of late for the Hatters. She averaged 12.3 points, 5.8 rebounds, and 2.0 steals during the four-game road swing earlier this month. At USC Upstate, the Hatter junior scored a season-high 14 points, then topped that mark by scoring 17 points at ETSU. She hit four three-pointers in six attempts against the Buccaneers.

Sasha Sims Leading the Team

As the lone senior on the team, Sasha Sims has been leading the team both on and off the court. She has led the team in scoring in 12 of the 26 games this season, twice netting a career-high 28 points (Bethune-Cookman, Murray State). She ranks sixth in the A-Sun in scoring (15.2 ppg), and she has scored in double figures in 21 of the 26 games this season.

Jama Sharp With 10 Assists, Four Times

Coach Bria calls her the quarterback of the team, and so far she has delivered. Four times this season, junior Jama Sharp has recorded 10 assists in a game (vs. Stephen F. Austin, North Carolina A&T, Florida A&M, and UNF). As of Friday, she ranked second in the A-Sun and 26th in the nation with a 5.7 assists/game average.

Senior Sasha Sims is climbing the charts towards the school record for most career points. She currently ranks fourth in Stetson history with 1516 points. She needs 55 points to break the record held by Michelle Michael (1570, 1985-89). At her current season scoring pace she would only need four more games to break the record (Mar. 8 vs. Florida Gulf Coast).
