Winners of 14 straight games, Stetson will begin a three-game regular season homestand Thursday night vs. Northern Kentucky. Tip-off is scheduled for 7:00 p.m. at the Edmunds Center.

The All-Time Series vs. NKU - Fourth Meeting

Stetson leads the all-time series 2-1 over Northern Kentucky, including a 90-66 win earlier this season in Highland Heights, Ky. (Jan. 30). The Hatters also won in DeLand last year, 62-39.

For the Season, Stetson has ...

- Posted its sixth 20-win season in school history
- Posted its fourth consecutive 20-win season
- Reached the 22-win mark for just the fourth time in school history.
- Achieved its best 25-game start in school history (20-5, currently 22-5)
- Registered a school-record 14-game winning streak
- Registered a school-record 14-game A-Sun winning streak
- Registered a school-record eight-game road winning streak
- Clinched a home game for the Atlantic Sun tournament quarterfinals.

- Only 17 teams in the NCAA have more wins than Stetson (22)

Longest in School History

Stetson's 14-game winning streak is the longest winning streak in school history, surpassing last year's record mark of 11.

Winning Streak Notes

During the 14-game winning streak:

- Stetson has never trailed by more than 5 points
- Stetson has only trailed in the second half to one opponent (UNF)
- The Hatters have averaged 81.9 ppg offensively and have outscored their opponents by a +20.9 scoring margin
- The Hatters are shooting 48.3%, while opponents are shooting just 33.8%
- Seven Hatters are averaging 8.7 ppg or better
- Five Hatters are averaging double figures
- Amber Porter is averaging 16.2 ppg (55.9% FG pct.) and has scored in double figures in 13 of the 14 games

- Stetson has shot 47.4% and held opponents to 34.8% shooting

The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At DeLand's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.

High-Flying Hatters

As a team, Stetson has put up some amazing offensive numbers this season. The Hatters are averaging 79.9 points per game, the highest total in the A-Sun and the 20th-highest mark in the NCAA. They have topped 80 points 15 times, 90 points seven times, and 100 points twice. Prior to this season, the Hatters had not had a 100-point game since 1989.

Five in Double Figures - "It's Hard to Guard"

After 27 games the Hatters have five players averaging double figures in scoring - Sasha Sims (14.6), Amber Porter (14.0), Brianti Saunders (13.1), Jama Sharp (11.6), and Cherisse Burris (10.9). Stetson is the only team in the Atlantic Sun with five active players averaging double figures in scoring. All five rank among the top 22 scorers in the Atlantic Sun.

Amber Alert

Freshman post player Amber Porter has had an incredible season to date, especially when it comes to blocking shots. Here some notes on Porter's blocking statistics:

- Her 3.5 blocks/game average ranks second in the A-Sun and seventh in the NCAA
- Her 94 blocks is the the most of any freshman in the NCAA
- Her 94 blocks is the highest single-season total in school history (surpassing old record of 72)
- Her 94 blocks is the fourth-highest career total in school history
- She has had at least two blocks in 22 of the 27 games
- She has recorded 6+ blocks in six times. Previously, the Hatters have had a player record 6+ blocks in a game only four times total in school history.

In the Feb. 24 release of NCAA national statistics, the Hatters ranked 20th in the nation scoring (79.9), 15th in field goal pct. (.463), 18th in field goal pct. defense (.355), and 28th in blocked shots (4.9). Amber Porter ranked seventh in blocks/game (3.5) and 38th in field goal pct. (.537), while Jama Sharp ranked 31st in assists (5.6) and 33rd in assist/turnover ratio (2.3).
