Preview

The Atlantic Sun Conference regular season champion, the number one seed and home court advantage throughout the A-Sun tournament will be decided this afternoon as Stetson hosts Florida Gulf Coast at the Edmunds Center. Tip-off is scheduled for 1:00 p.m. with live coverage on ASun.TV.

The All-Time Series - 16th Meeting

FGCU leads the all-time series 12-3 over Stetson, which includes a 4-2 mark in DeLand. This will be the eighth meeting in just the past three years, as the two teams have met five times in the regular season and twice in each of the past two Atlantic Sun Championship games. The Eagles won in 2012, and the Hatters won in 2013, rallying from a 15-point second-half deficit to win 70-64.

For the Season, Stetson has ...

- Tied a school-record with 24 wins
- Posted its sixth 20-win season in school history (fourth in a row)
- Broken school records for most A-Sun wins (16), most road wins (11), and longest winning streak (16).
- Clinched a home game for the Atlantic Sun tournament quarterfinals.

Streaking

- Stetson has won 16 straight games overall, marking the fourth-longest active streak in the NCAA.
- Stetson has won 16 straight conference games, marking the fifth-longest active streak in the NCAA.
- Stetson has won 15 straight home games, marking the ninth-longest active streak in the NCAA.
- Stetson has won eight straight road games, tying for the sixth-longest active streak in the NCAA.

With a Win Today, Stetson Will ...

- Set a new school-record for victories in a season with 25
- Tie a school-record for longest home court winning streak in school history (16).
- Win its first regular season A-Sun title and clinch the no. 1 seed and home court advantage throughout the A-Sun tournament.

Home Cooking

Stetson is a perfect 13-0 at home this year and currently own a 15-game home court winning streak. The Hatters are also 31-1 over their last 32 home games and 43-2 over their last 45 home games. Both losses during that span have come to Florida Gulf Coast.

- Stetson is one of 22 teams (as of Monday) with 24 or more wins on the season.
- Stetson leads all schools in the state of Florida with 24 victories.
- Stetson ranks 18th in the NCAA in scoring (80.0) and 10th in field goal pct. (.468)
- Amber Porter ranks seventh in the NCAA in blocks (3.6) and 28th in field goal pct. (.555)
- Sasha Sims will tie the school record with her 130th game today (she has not missed one in four years)

Sasha Sims Chasing School Points Record

Senior Sasha Sims is climbing the charts towards the school record for most career points. She currently ranks second in Stetson history with 1547 points. She needs just 24 points to break the record held by Michelle Michael (1570, 1985-89).

High-Flying Hatters

As a team, Stetson has put up some amazing offensive numbers this season. The Hatters are averaging 80.0 points per game, the highest total in the A-Sun and the 18th-highest mark in the NCAA. They have topped 80 points 16 times (a school-record), 90 points eight times, and 100 points three times. Prior to this season, the Hatters had not had a 100-point game since 1989.

Season Scoring Averages

At 80.8 points per game, Stetson is maintaining its highest season scoring average in school history. The 1988-89 team (80.3 ppg) owns the record for season-high scoring average.

Five in Double Figures - "It's Hard to Guard"

After 29 games the Hatters still have five players averaging double figures in scoring - Sasha Sims (14.7), Amber Porter (14.3), Brianti Saunders (13.0), Jama Sharp (11.6), and Cherisse Burris (10.8). Stetson is the only team in the Atlantic Sun with five active players averaging double figures in scoring. All five rank among the top 22 scorers in the Atlantic Sun.

Longest in School History

Stetson's 16-game winning streak is the longest winning streak in school history, surpassing last year's record mark of 11.

During the 16-game winning streak:

- Stetson has only trailed in the second half to one opponent (UNF)
- The Hatters have averaged 83.5 ppg offensively and have outscored their opponents by a +20.9 scoring margin
- The Hatters are shooting 49.0%, while opponents are shooting just 34.7%
- Seven Hatters are averaging 8.5 ppg or better
- Five Hatters are averaging double figures
- Amber Porter is averaging 16.6 ppg (58.5% FG pct.) and has scored in double figures in 15 of the 16 games

Amber Alert

Freshman post player Amber Porter has had an incredible season to date, especially when it comes to blocking shots. Here some notes on Porter's blocking statistics:

- Her 3.6 blocks/game average ranks second in the A-Sun and seventh in the NCAA
- Her 104 blocks is the the most of any freshman in the NCAA
- Her 104 blocks is the highest single-season total in school history (surpassing old record of 72)
- Her 104 blocks is the fourth-highest career total in school history
- Her 104 blocks is the fourth-highest single-season total in A-Sun history
- She has had at least two blocks in 24 of the 29 games
- She has recorded 6+ blocks in seven times. Previously, the Hatters have had a player record 6+ blocks in a game only four times total in school history.
- Her eight blocks vs. Palm Beach Atlantic tied the school single-game record

Freshman Scoring

Amber Porter has scored 416 points this season, the second-highest total by a Hatter freshman in school history. Brianti Saunders's 378 points is the third highest total by a Hatter freshman in school history. Only Sally Bunyard's 433 points in 1988-89 tops Porter's and Saunders's totals for a Hatter freshman.

She ranks sixth in the A-Sun in scoring (14.7 ppg), and she has scored in double figures in 23 of the 29 games this season.

The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At DeLand's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.



News and Notes

Jama Sharp With 10 Assists, Four Times

Coach Bria calls her the quarterback of the team, and so far she has delivered. Four times this season, junior Jama Sharp has recorded 10 assists in a game (vs. Stephen F. Austin, North Carolina A&T, Florida A&M, and UNF). As of Monday, she ranked second in the A-Sun and 33rd in the nation with a 5.6 assists/game average.
