#### **Preview**

Stetson's journey to a second straight Atlantic Sun Conference championship begins Tuesday night in the A-Sun Quarterfinals. The number two seed Hatters host seventh seeded Kennesaw State at 7:00 p.m. at the Edmunds Center with live coverage on ASun.TV.

#### The All-Time Series - 20th Meeting

Today will mark the 20th all-time meeting between Stetson and Kennesaw State. Stetson leads the all-time series 16-3 and the Hatters have won the last 11 head-to-head meetings, including a 98-75 victory in Kennesaw on Jan. 18 and an 87-57 win in DeLand on Feb. 13. Stetson is 1-0 all-time vs. Kennesaw State in the postseason (W 65-47 in 2011).

#### The Season Series

Stetson and Kennesaw State met twice during the 2013-14 regular season as the Hatters came away with a 23-point triumph on the road and a 30-point victory at home. Amber Porter led Stetson with 28 points on 11-of-19 shooting, and grabbed 11 rebounds in Stetson's 98-75 win in Kennesaw back on Jan. 18, while the Owls' Kristina Wells netted 32 points and hauled in nine boards. On Feb. 13 in DeLand it was a balanced attack led by 16 from Sasha Sims that led the Hatters to victory.

#### Four Hatters Honored with A-Sun Postseason Accolades

Four members of the Stetson women's basketball team were honored by the Atlantic Sun Conference with postseason awards on Monday, including Amber Porter (Woodbridge, Va.) who was named the A-Sun Freshman of the Year, as announced by the league office. For the second straight season, the Hatters placed three student-athletes on the Atlantic Sun all-conference teams, but 2013-14 marks the first time ever that Stetson landed all three individuals on the All-Atlantic Sun First Team. Senior forward Sasha Sims (Fayetteville, Ga.), junior guard Jama Sharp (Mooresville, Ind.), and Porter were three of the six players named to the league's first team. Porter, who also earned Freshman of the Year accolades, was a unanimous selection to the All-Freshman Team. She was joined by point guard Brianti Saunders (Hilliard, Fla.).

#### Sasha Sims Chasing School Points Record

Senior Sasha Sims is climbing the charts towards the school record for most career points. She currently ranks second in Stetson history with 1555 points. She needs just 16 points to break the record held by Michelle Michael (1570, 1985-89).

### The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At DeLand's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in his honor. Stetson University

fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.

#### **News and Notes**

#### **High-Flying Hatters**

As a team, Stetson has put up some amazing offensive numbers this season. The Hatters are averaging 80.5 points per game, the highest total in the A-Sun and the 17th-highest mark in the NCAA. They have topped 80 points 16 times (a school-record), 90 points eight times, and 100 points three times. Prior to this season, the Hatters had not had a 100-point game since 1989.

#### **Season Scoring Averages**

At 80.5 points per game, Stetson is maintaining its highest season scoring average in school history. The 1988-89 team (80.3 ppg) owns the record for season-high scoring average.

#### Five in Double Figures - "It's Hard to Guard"

After 30 games the Hatters still have five players averaging double figures in scoring - Sasha Sims (14.4), Amber Porter (14.2), Brianti Saunders (13.0), Jama Sharp (11.8), and Cherisse Burris (10.7). Stetson is the only team in the Atlantic Sun with five active players averaging double figures in scoring. All five rank among the top 23 scorers in the Atlantic Sun.

#### **Amber Alert**

Freshman post player Amber Porter has had an incredible season to date, especially when it comes to blocking shots. Here are some notes on Porter's blocking statistics:

- Her 3.7 blocks/game average ranks first in the A-Sun and fifth in the NCAA
- Her 110 blocks is the the most of any freshman in the NCAA
- · Her 110 blocks is the highest single-season total in school history (surpassing old record of 72)
- Her 110 blocks is the fourth-highest career total in school history
- Her 110 blocks is the third-highest single-season total in A-Sun history
- She has had at least two blocks in 25 of the 30 games
- She has recorded 6+ blocks eight times. Previously, the Hatters have had a player record 6+ blocks in a game only four times total in school history.

#### **Freshman Scoring**

Amber Porter has scored 425 points this season, the second-highest total by a Hatter freshman in school history. Brianti Saunders's 391 points is the third highest total by a Hatter freshman in school history. Only Sally Bunyard's 433 points in 1988-89 tops Porter's and Saunders's totals for a Hatter freshman.

#### Sasha Sims Leading the Team

As the lone senior on the team, Sasha Sims has been leading the team both on and off the court. She has led the team in scoring in 12 of the 30 games this season, twice netting a career-high 28 points (Bethune-Cookman, Murray State). She ranks sixth in the A-Sun in scoring (14.4 ppg), and she has scored in double figures in 23 of the 30 games this season.

#### Jama Sharp With 10 Assists, Four Times

Coach Bria calls her the quarterback of the team, and so far she has delivered. Four times this season, junior Jama Sharp has recorded 10 assists in a game (vs. Stephen F.
