News and Notes

Preview

For the fourth straight year, Stetson will be competing in the Atlantic Sun Championship semifinals, as the second-seeded Hatters face the third-seeded USC Upstate Spartans 3:30 p.m. Saturday at Alico Arena. The game will broadcast live on ESPN3 and the WatchESPN App for mobile devices.

The All-Time Series - 15th Meeting

Stetson leads the all-time series 10-4 over USC Upstate. The Hatters have won five straight in the series, including a 78-64 win in DeLand on Jan. 9 and a 79-66 win at USC Upstate on Feb. 6. Stetson is 1-0 all-time vs. USC Upstate in the postseason (W 72-59 in 2012).

For the Season, Stetson has ...

- Won 25 games for the first time in school history (old record: 24 wins set last year)
- Posted its sixth 20-win season in school history (fourth in a row)
- Broken school records for most A-Sun wins (16), most road wins (11), and longest winning streak (16).
- Advanced to the A-Sun semifinals for the fourth straight year

With a Win Today, Stetson Will ...

- Set a new school-record for victories in a season with 26
- Reach the Atlantic Sun Championship for the fourth straight season
- Improve to 11-1 in its last 12 A-Sun tournament games

Road Warriors

Stetson went 8-1 on the road in conference play and has won a school-record 11 road games overall this season. The Hatters have won eight straight on the road, tying for the sixth longest active road winning streak in the nation.

Four Hatters Honored with A-Sun Postseason Accolades

Four members of the Stetson women's basketball team were honored by the Atlantic Sun Conference with postseason awards on Monday, including Amber Porter (Woodbridge, Va.) who was named the A-Sun Freshman of the Year, as announced by the league office. For the second straight season, the Hatters placed three student-athletes on the Atlantic Sun all-conference teams, but 2013-14 marks the first time ever that Stetson landed all three individuals on the All-Atlantic Sun First Team. Senior forward Sasha Sims (Fayetteville, Ga.), junior guard Jama Sharp (Mooreville, Ind.), and Porter were three of the six players named to the league's first team. Porter was a unanimous selection to the All-Freshman Team and was joined by guard Brianti Saunders (Hilliard, Fla.).

Sasha Sims Chasing School Points Record

Senior Sasha Sims is climbing the charts towards the school record for most career points. She currently ranks second in Stetson history with 1562 points. She needs just nine points to break the record held by Michelle Michael (1570, 1985-89).

High-Flying Hatters

As a team, Stetson has put up some amazing offensive numbers this season. The Hatters are averaging 80.3 points per game, the highest total in the A-Sun and the 17th-highest mark in the NCAA. They have topped 80 points 16 times (a school-record), 90 points eight times, and 100 points three times. Prior to this season, the Hatters had not had a 100-point game since 1989.

Season Scoring Averages

At 80.3 points per game, Stetson is tied for its highest season scoring average in school history. The 1988-89 team (80.3 ppg) currently owns the record.

Five in Double Figures - "It's Hard to Guard"

After 31 games the Hatters still have five players averaging double figures in scoring - Sasha Sims (14.2), Amber Porter (14.2), Brianti Saunders (13.1), Jama Sharp (11.6), and Cherrisse Burris (10.5). Stetson is the only team in the Atlantic Sun with five active players averaging double figures in scoring. All five rank among the top 25 scorers in the Atlantic Sun.

The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At DeLand's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.

Stetson Rallies Past Kennesaw State in A-Sun Quarterfinals

The Stetson women's basketball team found itself in the rare position of facing a halftime deficit in the Atlantic Sun Tournament quarterfinals Tuesday night. The Hatters scored just 26 points in the opening 20 minutes, and none came from the league's Freshman of the Year Amber Porter.

"I thought (Amber) struggled in the first half and therefore our team struggled in the first half," Stetson head coach Lynn Bria said. "I sent her some encouraging words (at halftime), and she really responded in the second half."

Porter scored all 15 points of her points after the break, adding 12 rebounds and eight blocks to lead Stetson (25-6) to a 73-56 victory over Kennesaw State (6-24) at the Edmunds Center.

With their school-record 25th victory of the season, the second-seeded Hatters advance to play third-seeded USC Upstate in the A-Sun semifinals Saturday afternoon at 3:30 p.m. in Fort Myers, Fla. The winner will play for the A-Sun Championship Sunday at 3 p.m.

What were Bria's words of encouragement to Porter?

"We won't share that," the Hatters coach responded to a reporter in the postgame news conference. "We like you but we are not going to share that."

The Hatters had only trailed once at halftime in their previous 18 games, but after shooting just 27 percent in the first half, Kennesaw State jumped to a 31-26 advantage at the break.

"I wasn't surprised that (Kennesaw State was) playing so well, but I just felt that our energy defensively wasn't very good," Bria said. "We were letting them do whatever they wanted to do. Once we started to turn them over and get easy baskets, then we started to flow better. We picked it up, we played harder, and we played more aggressively."

Stetson opened the second half on a 10-0 run, highlighted by fastbreak baskets from C.J. Coddington and Brianti Sanders.

"Coach told us we had to push the ball in order to get our energy up, so as soon as Jama (Sharp) got the ball, I just sprinted to the lane," Saunders said. Kennesaw State was able to push back and regain a 44-43 lead following a basket from Gratia Brooks, but the Hatters outscored the Owls 18-2 over the next five minutes to break the game open.

Porter was 7-for-11 from the field in the final 20 minutes and recorded six of her school-record tying eight blocks after the break. She now ranks second all-time in A-Sun history with 118 blocks on the season.
