The game will broadcast live on CSS, Bright House Sports Networks, ESPN3 and the WatchESPN App for mobile devices, ASun.TV, and WSBB radio.

The All-Time Series - 17th Meeting

FGCU leads the all-time series 13-3 over Stetson, which includes a 7-0 mark at Alico Arena. This will be the ninth meeting in just the past three years, as the two teams have met six times in the regular season and three times now in each of the past three Atlantic Sun Championship games. The Eagles won in 2012, and the Hatters won in 2013, rallying from a 15-point second-half deficit to win 70-64.

Four Hatters Honored with A-Sun Postseason Accolades

Four members of the Stetson women's basketball team were honored by the Atlantic Sun Conference with postseason awards on Monday, including Amber Porter (Woodbridge, Va.) who was named the A-Sun Freshman of the Year, as announced by the league office. For the second straight season, the Hatters placed three student-athletes on the Atlantic Sun all-conference teams, but 2013-14 marks the first time ever that Stetson landed all three individuals on the All-Atlantic Sun First Team. Senior forward Sasha Sims (Fayetteville, Ga.), junior guard Jama Sharp (Mooresville, Ind.), and Porter were three of the six players named to the league's first team. Porter was a unanimous selection to the All-Freshman Team and was joined by guard Brianti Saunders (Hilliard, Fla.).

Sasha Sims Breaks School Points Record

With her 10 points against USC Upstate (March 14), senior Sasha Sims broke the school record for for most career points. She currently has 1572 points, surpassing the previous record held by Michelle Michael (1570, 1985-89).

High-Flying Hatters

As a team, Stetson has put up some amazing offensive numbers this season. The Hatters are averaging 80.6 points per game, the highest total in the A-Sun and the 17th-highest mark in the NCAA. They have topped 80 points 17 times (a school-record), 90 points nine times, and 100 points three times. Prior to this season, the Hatters had not had a 100-point game since 1989.

Season Scoring Averages

At 80.6 points per game, this year's team owns the highest season scoring average in school history. The 1988-89 team (80.3 ppg) owns the next-best scoring total.

The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At DeLand's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in his honor. Stetson University

fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.

Five in Double Figures - "It's Hard to Guard"

After 32 games the Hatters still have five players averaging double figures in scoring - Amber Porter (14.2), Sasha Sims (14.1), Brianti Saunders (13.1), Jama Sharp (11.8), and Cherisse Burris (10.5). Stetson is the only team in the Atlantic Sun with five active players averaging double figures in scoring. All five rank among the top 25 scorers in the Atlantic Sun.

Amber Alert

Freshman post player Amber Porter has had an incredible season to date, especially when it comes to blocking shots. Here are some notes on Porter's blocking statistics:

- Her 3.8 blocks/game average ranks first in the A-Sun and fourth in the NCAA
- Her 120 blocks is the the most of any freshman in the NCAA (fifth-highest freshman total all-time).
- Her 120 blocks is the highest single-season total in school history (surpassing old record of 72)
- Her 120 blocks is the third-highest career total in school history

Amber Porter has scored 454 points this season, the highest total by a Hatter freshman in school history. Brianti Saunders's 418 points is the third highest total by a Hatter freshman in school history. Only Sally Bunyard's 433 points in 1988-89 tops Saunders's total for a Hatter freshman.

Sasha Sims Leading the Team

Assists 16.3

As the lone senior on the team, Sasha Sims has been leading the team both on and off the court. She has led the team in scoring in 12 of the 32 games this season, twice netting a career-high 28 points (Bethune-Cookman, Murray State). She ranks seventh in the A-Sun in scoring (14.1 ppg), and she has scored in double figures in 24 of the 32 games this season.

Jama Sharp With 10 Assists, Four Times

Coach Bria calls her the quarterback of the team, and so far she has delivered. Four times this season, junior Jama Sharp has recorded 10 assists in a game (vs. Stephen F. Austin, North Carolina A&T, Florida A&M, and UNF). As of Friday, she ranked second in the A-Sun and 34th in the nation with a 5.5 assists/game average.

Stetson Rallies Past Kennesaw State in A-Sun Quarterfinals

The Stetson women's basketball team found itself in the rare position of facing a halftime deficit in the Atlantic Sun Tournament quarterfinals Tuesday night. The Hatters scored just 26 points in the opening 20 minutes, and none came from the league's Freshman of the Year Amber Porter.

"I thought (Amber) struggled in the first half and therefore our team struggled in the first half," Stetson head coach Lynn Bria said. "I sent her some encouraging words (at halftime), and she really responded in the second half."

Porter scored all 15 points of her points after the break, adding 12 rebounds and eight blocks to lead Stetson (25-6) to a 73-56 victory over Kennesaw State (6-24) at the Edmunds Center.

With their school-record 25th victory of the season, the second-seeded Hatters advance to play third-seeded USC Upstate in the A-Sun semifinals Saturday afternoon at 3:30 p.m. in Fort Myers, Fla. The winner will play for the A-Sun Championship Sunday at 3 p.m.

What were Bria's words of encouragement to Porter?

"We won't share that," the Hatters coach responded to a reporter in the postgame news conference. "We like you but we are not going to share that."


The Hatters had only trailed once at halftime in their previous 18 games, but after shooting just 27 percent in the first half, Kennesaw State jumped to a 31-26 advantage at the break.

"I wasn't surprised that (Kennesaw State was) playing so well, but I just felt that our energy defensively wasn't very good," Bria said. "We were letting them do whatever they wanted to do. Once we started to turn them over and get easy baskets, then we started to flow better. We picked it up, we played harder, and we played more aggressively."

Stetson opened the second half on a 10-0 run, highlighted by fastbreak baskets from C.J. Coddington and Brianti Sanders.

"Coach told us we had to push the ball in order to get our energy up, so as soon as Jama (Sharp) got the ball, I just sprinted to the lane," Saunders said. Kennesaw State was able to push back and regain a 44-43 lead following a basket from Gratia Brooks, but the Hatters outscored the Owls 18-2 over the next five minutes to break the game open.

Porter was 7-for-11 from the field in the final 20 minutes and recorded six of her school-record tying eight blocks after the break. She now ranks second all-time in A-Sun history with 118 blocks on the season.



Stetson Advances to A-Sun Final in Convincing Fashion

Led by seven players in double figures, the Stetson women's basketball team advanced to its fourth straight Atlantic Sun Conference Championship final with a 90-60 victory over USC Upstate in the semifinals on Saturday.

Senior Sasha Sims was one of the seven scoring in double figures, totaling 10 for the game. With her final bucket, she became Stetson's all-time scoring leader with 1,572 points in her four seasons with the Hatters.

"It's unbelievable," said Stetson head coach Lynn Bria of Sims' accomplishment. "She's done such a great job and it's amazing what she's done. She's a good kid. She's a good kid to coach, and she's a great team player. She probably could have gotten [the record] a long time ago if she were more selfish."

"It's definitely a great feeling," Sims said following the game. "I'm humbled. Our main goal, though, is to win a championship. Unless we do that the other accomplishments don't mean anything. I just want to get my third ring and be able to credit it to my teammates and our coaching staff."

After Stetson (26-6) started hot with a 13-4 run, the Spartans (17-14) countered with 12 straight points to take a 16-13 lead over the Hatters just over seven and a half minutes into the contest. Unlike in the quarterfinal match-up with Kennesaw State, however, Stetson didn't let USC Upstate hang around any longer than that.

The Hatters used a 14-0 run over the next 3:14 to regain the advantage at 27-16, and then extended it to 42-20 with a 29-4 stretch that ultimately put the game out of reach at 42-20 with 3:45 remaining in the first half.

"Overall I thought we played a pretty good game," Bria said. "In the first half there we turned them over and got a bit of separation. We're fortunate to get a win and I'm just glad that we're in this position."

Junior Jama Sharp led the balanced attack for the Hatters, scoring 17 on 7-of-12 shooting from the field. She added four assists and four of Stetson's season-best 18 steals in the victory.

Freshman Amber Porter scored 14, while Burris finished with 13 points and eight rebounds. Junior C.J. Coddington and freshman Brianti Saunders scored 11 points each with the former adding another four steals for the Hatters.
