# **News and Notes**

### **Preview**

The Hatters and Bulls meet for the second time this season when they clash in the second round of the WNIT on Sunday in Tampa. Stetson reached the second round after defeating Miami, 70-63, on Thursday while USF nipped North Carolina A& by a 56-50 margin on Friday. In the previous meeting between the Hatters and Bulls on Dec. 8, 2013, Stetson cut an 11-point second half deficit down to three and saw Jama Sharp's potential game-tying 3-pointer hit the front of the rim as USF held on for a 72-68 victory. Brianti Saunders scored 22 points and Sasha Sims added 16.

### Stetson in the WNIT

This is Stetson's second appearance in the WNIT. The Hatters earned a WNIT bid following the 2012 season and lost 75-47 at FIU. Following Thursday's win at Miami, Stetson is 1-1 all-time in WNIT play.

# The All-Time Series - USF leads, 25-11

Today's game is the 37th meeting in a series which dates back to 1978. USF has won eight straight in the series, including a 72-68 win in Tampa on Dec. 8, 2013. The Hatters last win in the series was a 74-63 victory on Nov. 23, 1997 in DeLand.

# Four Hatters Honored with A-Sun Postseason Accolades

Four members of the Stetson women's basketball team were honored by the Atlantic Sun Conference with postseason awards on Monday, including Amber Porter (Woodbridge, Va.) who was named the A-Sun Freshman of the Year, as announced by the league office. For the second straight season, the Hatters placed three student-athletes on the Atlantic Sun all-conference teams, but 2013-14 marks the first time ever that Stetson landed all three individuals on the All-Atlantic Sun First Team. Senior forward Sasha Sims (Fayetteville, Ga.), junior guard Jama Sharp (Mooresville, Ind.), and Porter were three of the six players named to the league's first team. Porter was a unanimous selection to the All-Freshman Team and was joined by guard Brianti Saunders (Hilliard, Fla.).

# Sasha Sims Breaks School Points Record

With her 10 points against USC Upstate (March 14), senior Sasha Sims broke the school record for most career points. She currently has 1606 points, surpassing the previous record held by Michelle Michael (1570, 1985-89).

# **High-Flying Hatters**

As a team, Stetson has put up some amazing offensive numbers this season. The Hatters are averaging 80.2 points per game, the highest total in the A-Sun and the 17th-highest mark in the NCAA. They have topped 80 points 17 times (a school-record), 90 points nine times, and 100 points three times. Prior to this season, the Hatters had not had a 100-point game since 1989.

# The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At DeLand's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in

his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.

# Five in Double Figures - "It's Hard to Guard"

After 33 games the Hatters still have five players averaging double figures in scoring - Sasha Sims (14.2), Amber Porter (14.0), Brianti Saunders (12.7), Jama Sharp (11.8), and Cherisse Burris (10.4). Stetson is the only team in the Atlantic Sun with five active players averaging double figures in scoring. All five rank among the top 25 scorers in the Atlantic Sun.

# **Amber Alert**

Freshman post player Amber Porter has had an incredible season to date, especially when it comes to blocking shots. Here are some notes on Porter's blocking statistics:

- Her 3.8 blocks/game average ranks first in the A-Sun and fourth in the NCAA
