News and Notes

Preview

Stetson will begin a six-game road trip Wednesday as they visit UCF at the CFE Arena. Tip-off is scheduled for 7:00 p.m.

The All-Time Series vs. UCF = 60th Meeting

UCF leads the all-time series over Stetson 33-26. However, the two former Atlantic Sun rivals have not met since 2007. Stetson's last win over UCF came in the 2005 A-Sun Championship semifinals, a buzzer-beater victory prior to the Hatters' championship win over Georgia State.

On the Road

Starting Wednesday, Stetson will play six consecutive games on the road. The Hatters will travel to UCF, Indiana State, Baylor (three games), and USF before returning home to face Webber International on Dec. 5.

Seeking 2-0 Start

With a win today, Stetson will be 2-0 for the first time in 14 seasons. The last 2-0 start was in 2000-01.

Return to UCF

Head coach Lynn Bria will be making a return to UCF where she served as a head coach for three seasons (1996-99). She guided the Knights to a conference championship and an NCAA berth in 1999.

A Look Back at the Season Opener

Jama Sharp was a perfect 10-for-10 from the field including 6-for-6 from three-point range, breaking school-records in both categories and finishing with a career-high 26 points, in Stetson's season-opening 91-61 win over Bethune-Cookman Friday night at the Edmunds Center. Sharp had 12 points at halftime, all coming from behind the arc. In the second half, she scored 14 points on 6-of-6 shooting, hitting the record-breaking 10th consecutive field goal and sixth three-pointer with under 20 seconds to play. She also recorded six assists. Amber Porter added 23 points on 9-of-11 shooting, picking up her 500th career point late in the first half. She added 13 rebounds and four blocks. Myeisha Hall scored 15 points.

Sharp Named A-Sun Player of the Week

Following her school-record 10-for-10 shooting performance on Friday night, senior guard Jama Sharp was named the Atlantic Sun Player of the Week on Monday. Her 26 points was a career-high.

Double-Double for Amber Porter

Amber Porter's 23-point, 13-rebound performance Friday marked her 11th career-double-double and her eighth career 20+ point game.

Three-Point Shooting

Stetson shot 40% as a team from behind the arc, hitting 12-of-30 3-point field goal attempts. Jama Sharp hit six 3-pointers, Myeisha Hall hit three, Amber Porter hit two, and Sarah Sagerer made one. Porter's two 3-pointers surpasses her total of one from all of the last season.

Myeisha Time

Senior Myeisha Hall made her first Stetson start on Friday and played a career-high 35 minutes. She scored 15 points, hitting three 3-pointers, one 2-pointer, and four free throws.

Strong Debut

Freshman Sarah Sagerer had a strong debut, garnering nine points and nine rebounds in 22 minutes on the court. Her first half minutes were limited due to foul trouble.

Free Throw Accuracy

Dating back to last season, a span of 20 games overall, Brianti Saunders has hit 56 of her last 61 free throws, good for a .918 free throw pct. She has also hit 19 in a row entering Wednesday. Last season she ranked fifth in the conference with an .824 pct., and ranked tops among players with at least 100 attempts. She is 3-for-3 this season.

- Amber Porter is 15 blocks shy of breaking the Stetson record for most blocks in a career (147 by Sasha Sims 2010-14). She needs five blocks to move into second place.
- Jama Sharp needs six steals for 200. She would be just the ninth player in school history to reach that milestone.

The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At DeLand's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.



Dominant at Home

The Hatters have won 17 of their last 18, 33 of their last 35 and 45 of their last 48 games at the Edmunds Center dating back to Feb., 2011. All three losses during that stretch have come to FGCU:

News and Notes

Charges Drawn

C.J. Coddington led the team last year with five charges drawn. She picked up her first charge in the season opener vs. Bethune-Cookman.

Key Stats

- 26-2 when scoring 70 points or more

- 27-3 when having more free throw attempts than its opponent
- 24-3 when leading at halftime

Home Cooking

The Hatters are currently 33-2 over their last 35 home games and 45-3 over their last 48 home games. All three losses during that span have come to FGCU.

Atlantic Sun Preseason Poll

Stetson was picked to finish second in the 2014-15 Atlantic Sun Conference preseason coaches poll. The Hatters received 58 votes in the poll, trailing only FGCU which received 62 points.

Three Hatters Honored with A-Sun Preseason Accolades

Sophomore **Amber Porter** (Woodbridge, Va.) was tabbed as the Atlantic Sun Preseason Defensive Player of the Year. Seniors **Jama Sharp** (Mooresville, Ind.) and **Cherisse Burris** (Blue Springs, Mo.) joined Porter on the preseason all-conference team.

High-Flying Hatters

As a team, Stetson put up some amazing offensive numbers last season. The Hatters averaged 79.3 points per game, the highest total in the A-Sun and the 19th-highest mark in the NCAA. They topped 80 points 17 times (a school-record), 90 points nine times, and 100 points three times. Stetson scored 91 points in its season-opening win vs. Bethune-Cookman.

In The Record Book

Jama Sharp will have the chance to chase down some school records this season. The Hatter senior currently ranks fifth in school history in three-point field goals made (117), 10th in assists (320), and ninth in steals (194). She also ranks ninth in three-point field goal pct. (.346), 10th in free throw pct. (.729).

Tough Schedule

The Hatters will face a challenging schedule in 2014-15 that features seven of the first nine games on the road, including five games against teams that participated in last year's postseason. Overall, the Hatters will play 12 games against 2014 NCAA, WNIT or WBI postseason participants, including preseason AP No. 8 Baylor.
