## News and Notes

### Preview

Stetson continues a six-game road trip this weekend at the Basketball Travelers Classic. The Hatters will face Marist at 6 p.m. ET Friday, Baylor at 1 p.m. ET Saturday, and Utah State at 1 p.m. ET Sunday.

### The All-Time Series vs. Marist = 2nd Meeting

Stetson defeated Marist in the school's only previous meeting, 84-59 in DeLand during the 1985-86 season, a span of 29 years. The Hatters have never met Baylor or Utah State.

### Busy Stretch

The Hatters are beginning a stretch of three games in three days and six games in nine days.

### On the Road

Stetson is playing six consecutive games on the road. The Hatters have defeated UCF on Nov. 19 and Indiana State on Nov. 22. After this weekend's tournament, Stetson will play at USF on Wednesday before returning home to face Webber International on Dec. 5.

### Seeking 4-0 Start

With a win today, Stetson will be 4-0 for the first time in 28 seasons. The last 4-0 start was in 1986-87. The Hatters have never been 5-0 in the modern era.

### A Look Back at the Indiana State Game

Brianti Saunders scored a game-high 18 points and grabbed nine rebounds as visiting Stetson defeated Indiana State 62-52 at the Hulman Center. The Hatters held the Sycamores to just 22 second-half points to improve to 3-0 for the first time since 1995. Indiana State led 30-28 at the half, but Jama Sharp's 3-pointer with 17:49 to go gave Stetson the lead for good. Saunders scored 11 of her 18 points after the break including a 3-pointer with 8:31 to go that gave Stetson a seven-point advantage.

### Brianti Saunders Named A-Sun Player of the Week

Brianti Saunders averaged 19.0 points, 8.0 rebounds, and 2.5 steals en route to A-Sun Player of the Week honors. She scored a team-high 20 points at UCF last Wednesday and a game-high 18 points at Indiana State. She also shot 54% from the floor and averaged 2.5 steals in 33.5 minutes for the week.

### Defense Paves the Way

Stetson's defense has been a big key to the team's 3-0 start. The Hatters allow just 54.0 points per game, which ranks 44th-best in the NCAA. Stetson's opponents are shooting just 32.3%, which ranks 23rd in the NCAA. Here is a game-by-game look at Stetson's defensive numbers:

### Quick Hitters

- Stetson has not trailed by more than four points this season
- Stetson has trailed in the second half twice, yet came back to win each time (UCF, Indiana State)
- C.J. Coddington leads the team with six charges drawn this year
- Stetson is 0-25 all-time against Top 25 teams
- Stetson is 19-1 in its last 20 regular season games, with the one loss coming in overtime
- Stetson has had both A-Sun Players of the Week this season (Jama Sharp, Brianti Saunders)

### More Blocks for Amber Porter

Amber Porter is leading the Atlantic Sun Conference with an average of 3.3 blocks per game. She has recorded 139 blocks in just 38 career games. She needs just eight more blocks to tie and nine blocks to break the school record, held by Sasha Sims (147 blocks, 2010-14).

### Sharp Among NCAA Active Leaders

As of Nov. 24, Jama Sharp ranks 11th in career steals (200) and 26th in career assists (320) among all active players in Division I. She is the active Atlantic Sun leader in both categories.

### Myeisha Time

Senior Myeisha Hall leads the team and ranks second in the A-Sun in minutes played (35.3). Her 13.7 ppg average ranks third on the team and seventh in the conference. She is tied for sixth in the league with seven 3-point field goals made.

### Free Throw Accuracy

Dating back to last season, a span of 22 games overall, Brianti Saunders has hit 66 of her last 74 free throws, good for a .892 free throw pct. Last season she ranked fifth in the conference with an .824 pct., and ranked tops among players with at least 100 attempts. She is 13-for-16 this season (.812).

## The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At DeLand's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.

## Fast Facts

In 2013-14, Stetson ...

- Set the school record for most wins (27), most conference wins (16), and most road wins (13)
- Participated in the A-Sun Championship game and in NCAA postseason play for the fourth straight year (NCAA: 2011, 2013; WNIT: 2012, 2014)
- Earned first-ever NCAA postseason victory, 70-63 at Miami on March 20
- Posted a school-record 16-game win streak Jan. 9-March 1
- Compiled 15-game home-court winning streak from Feb. 28, 2013-March 1, 2014
- Tied the school record for most home wins in a single-season (14)
- Averaged 79.3 points per game and had five players average in double figures
- Set school single-season records for most points (2,774), field goals (965), 3-point field goals (226), free throws (618), rebounds (1,485), blocked shots (178), and games played (35)

## Points in the Paint Matter

The Hatters are 51-4 since the start of the 2012-13 season when outscoring its opponent in the paint. That includes a 3-0 mark this season. All four losses have come to FGCU.

## Key Stats

Last season, Stetson was:

- 26-2 when scoring 70 points or more
- 27-3 when outscoring its opponent in the paint
- 27-3 when having more free throw attempts than its opponent
- 24-3 when leading at halftime
- 22-2 when outrebounding its opponent

## Home Cooking

The Hatters are currently 33-2 over their last 35 home games and 45-3 over their last 48 home games. All three losses during that span have come to FGCU.

## Atlantic Sun Preseason Poll

Stetson was picked to finish second in the 2014-15 Atlantic Sun Conference preseason coaches poll. The Hatters received 58 votes in the poll, trailing only FGCU which received 62 points.

## High-Flying Hatters

As a team, Stetson put up some amazing offensive numbers last season. The Hatters averaged 79.3 points per game, the highest total in the A-Sun and the 19th-highest mark in the NCAA. They topped 80 points 17 times (a school-record), 90 points nine times, and 100 points three times. Stetson scored 91 points in its season-opening win vs. Bethune-Cookman.

## Four-Year Success Part I (Overall)

The Hatters have experienced quite a bit of success over the past four seasons, including:

- Four 20+ win seasons
- Four postseason appearances (2 NCAA, 2 WNIT)
- Two Atlantic Sun Conference Championships
- Four appearances in the Atlantic Sun Championship game

## Four-Year Success Part II (State of Florida)

Since the start of the 2010-11 season, the Hatters have compiled a 97-41 record (.703). Only one other team in the state of Florida has more wins than Stetson during that stretch:

Only Stetson, FGCU, and Florida have won 20+ games in each of the past four seasons.

## In The Record Book

Jama Sharp will have the chance to chase down some school records this season. The Hatter senior currently ranks fifth in school history in three-point field goals made (120), 10th in assists (328), and ninth in steals (200). She also ranks ninth in three-point field goal pct. (.343), 10th in free throw pct. (.733).

## Tough Schedule

The Hatters will face a challenging schedule in 2014-15 that features seven of the first nine games on the road, including five games against teams that participated in last year's postseason. Overall, the Hatters will play 12 games against 2014 NCAA, WNIT or WBI postseason participants, including preseason AP No. 8 Baylor.
