Preview

Off to their best start in 14 years, the Stetson Hatters make the short trip over to Gainesville, Fla. to take on the Florida Gators. Tip-off is scheduled for 1 p.m. at the O'Connell Center.

The All-Time Series vs. Florida - 27th Meeting

Florida leads the all-time series 23-3 over Stetson, having win the last 13 head-to-head meetings. The teams last met three seasons ago in a game UF won 71-57 at the O'Connell Center. Stetson's last win in the series came in 1988 (26 seasons ago).

Lighter Stretch

After completing a stretch of six games in nine days, today is Stetson's lone game in a span of 12 days.

Great Starts

Stetson's 7-2 mark is the team's best nine-game start since 2001, when the Hatters were 8-1 at the same point in the season. Including 1986-87, this is only the third time in school history Stetson has been 7-2 after nine games. Even more impressive, six of the nine games so far have been on the road.

Quality Wins

Stetson's win over Indiana State is the only blemish on the Sycamores schedule so far. Indiana State (7-1) has wins over Butler, Saint Louis, ETSU, South Alabama, Indiana, IUPUI, and Indianapolis. The Hatters are also the only team to beat UCF in Orlando this year (4-1 at home).

The Last 12 Months

Over the last 12-plus months, from the start of December, 2013 through the present, Stetson has compiled a record of 31-7 (.816). The Hatters have lost to only three teams during that stretch: Florida Gulf Coast (3x), USF (3x), and #13 Baylor.

Decisive Wins

Stetson's 63-point and 61-point wins over Webber International and Warner represent the fourth and fifth largest margins of victory in school history. It is also the first time the Hatters have posted back-to-back wins of 40 points or more. Stetson had not had a 60-point win for 30 seasons.

Stingy Defense

The 27 points allowed vs. Webber International represent the third-lowest single-game total by a Hatter opponent in school history.

Accurate Shooting

Stetson's .618 field goal pct. vs. Warner marks the sixth-best single-game total in school history.

Porter Picking it Up

Amber Porter has scored in double figures in three straight games. She is averaging 15.3 points per game during that stretch.

Defense Paves the Way

Stetson's defense has been a big key to the team's 7-2 start. In the seven victories this season, the Hatters have allowed just 49.0 points per game, and opponents have shot just 30.5%. Here is a gameby-game defensive look at the seven victories:

The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At DeLand's request. Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in

his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.

News and Notes

Home Cooking

Stetson is 19-1 in its last 20 home games, 35-2 in its last 37 homes, and 47-3 in its last 50 home games. The Hatters went 14-1 at home last year and presided over a 15-game home court winning streak. Stetson has won 21 straight home games against non-conference opponents.

Points in the Paint Matter

The Hatters are 53-5 since the start of the 2012-13 season when outscoring its opponent in the paint. That includes a 7-1 mark this season, with the one loss coming at USF on Dec. 3.

One Close Game

Not many of Stetson's games this season have been decided in the final few minutes. In eight of the first nine games, the leading team's margin has been greater than 10 points with under three minutes to play. The only close game was against Marist, which trailed by nine points at the 3:00 mark and later cut it to four with 1:32 to play, but Stetson held on for a seven-point win. The latest point of a game that had a lead change was at the 7:06 mark of the second half at UCF.

Taking Charge

Senior C.J. Coddington has taken a team-best 14 charges this season. She took three in one game vs. Webber International on Dec. 5.

Sophomore Comparison

Sophomores Amber Porter and Brianti Saunders have both had phenomenal careers to date for the Hatters. While the 6-foot-3 Porter stands nearly a foot taller than the 5-foot-4 Saunders, the duo are neck-and-neck in career scoring. Here is a look at how they compare with some career stats:

A three-time Atlantic Sun Conference champion as a head coach, Lynn Bria is in her seventh season at the helm of Stetson women's basketball program.

Over the past four seasons Bria has turned the Hatters into a formidable force in the Atlantic Sun. She has guided the Hatters to two conference titles, two NCAA Tournament appearances, two WNIT bids, and four consecutive 20+ win seasons. In fact, Stetson is just one of two schools in the state of Florida to post as many as 99 victories since the start of the 2010-11 season.

In 2013-14 and for the third year in a row, the Hatters set a school-record for most victories in a single-season with 27. Stetson also won a school-record 16 conference games and won a schoolrecord 16 consecutive contests during the regular season. The Hatters also earned their second-ever bid to the WNIT and the program's first-ever NCAA postseason victory, a 70-63 win at Miami on Mar. 20. Stetson had three players named First Team All-Conference, including A-Sun Freshman of the Year

The 2012-13 season was one for the history books as the Hatters set numerous team records and captured their second A-Sun title in the past three seasons. Bria helped lead the Hatters to a schoolrecord 24 wins overall, a 12-1 record at home, a school-record 14 wins in A-Sun play, and winning streaks of 11 straight overall and 16 in a row at home. In the A-Sun Championship game, Stetson rallied from a 15-point second-half deficit to defeat top-seeded and previously undefeated FGCU 70-64, and then earned their highest-ever NCAA Tournament seed (14) and an appearance in the Columbus, Ohio regional against UCLA.

In 2011-12, the Hatters won a school-record 23 games and advanced to the postseason for the second year in a row, participating in the WNIT for the first time in school history. Three players earned All-Atlantic Sun honors including A-Sun Player of the Year and All-Tournament Team selection Victoria McGowan, who led the nation with three triple-doubles. Also honored were Second Team All-Alantic Sun forward Sasha Sims and A-Sun All-Freshman Team forward Cherisse Burris.

Bria's 2010-11 Hatters won 20 games for the first time in 10 seasons, captured their third Atlantic Sun Conference tournament championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second time in school history and first time since 2005.

Stetson's turnaround under Bria from 6-24 to 20-13 (+12.5 games) was the second largest improvement in NCAA Division I women's basketball. Honors that came to members of the team included A-Sun Tournament MVP (Victoria McGowan), A-Sun All-Tournament Team (Tierra Brown, Sasha Sims), Second Team All-Atlantic Sun (McGowan), A-Sun All-Freshman Team (Sims), A-Sun Player of the Week (Natasha Graboski) and A-Sun Newcomer of the Week (McGowan twice, Sims). Graboski went on to sign a professional contract with Alexandria of Romania's Division 1 League in the summer of 2011.

In 2009-10 Bria led the Hatters to their seventh consecutive A-Sun tournament appearance. In her first season at Stetson, Bria made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as her 2009-10 incoming class was ranked by Michael T. White's noted scouting service All-Star Girls Report as the best in the Atlantic Sun and in the top third of all NCAA Division I teams.

Bria has coached women's basketball for 20 years with 14 seasons of Division I head coaching experience to her credit at UCF, Ohio University and Stetson. In addition to coaching, she has extensive classroom experience at the university level and is committed to developing young women both athletically and academically.

From 1999-2006, Bria was the head coach at Ohio University in Athens, Ohio. She also led UCF for three seasons from 1996-99. Her final Golden Knights team in 1998-99 was the TAAC (now Atlantic Sun) regular season and tournament champions and appeared in the NCAA Tournament. Her first head coaching position came at Division II Texas Woman's University in Denton, Texas for three seasons from 1993-96.

A standout performer for the Charleston Golden Eagles, the Class of 1990 graduate was inducted into her alma mater's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2003. She scored 1,146 points in her career, averaging 10.3 points per game and was a 75.3 percent free throw shooter over her career.
