News and Notes

Preview

After a season-long 11-day layoff, the Stetson Hatters return to the court to face the UNCW Seahawks on New Year's Eve. Tip-off is scheduled for 1 p.m. at the Edmunds Center.

The All-Time Series vs. UNC Wilmington - 1st Meeting

Stetson and UNC Wilmington will be meeting for the first-ever time.

Home Cooking

Stetson has won six straight home games (5-0 this year), 21 of its last 22, 37 of its last 39, and 49 of its last 52 games at the Edmunds Center. The Hatters have won 23 straight home games against non-conference opponents.

Home vs. Road

The Hatters have been outstanding at home this season, averaging 86.6 points per game and outscoring their opponents by an average of 37 points. Stetson is also shooting better than 50% from the floor and averaging over 18 assists per game at home. Here is a look at the team's home/road comparison:

Great Starts

Stetson's 9-3 mark is the team's best 12-game start since 2011, when the Hatters were 9-3 at the same point in the season. This is only the fifth time in school history Stetson has been 9-3 or better after 12 games. The Hatters were 10-2 in 2000-01, 9-3 in 1995-96, and 10-2 in 1986-87.

Reaching 10 Wins

If the Hatters reach 10 wins today, it will be just the second time the team has done so by the end of December. The Hatters were 11-3 at the end of December in 2011-12.

The 2014 Calendar Year

Today marks the final game of the 2014 calendar year for the Hatters. What a year it has been as Stetson has posted a 28-7 record over the past 12 months.

Quality Wins

Stetson's win over Indiana State is still the only blemish on the Sycamores schedule so far. Indiana State (10-1) has wins over Butler, Saint Louis (twice), ETSU, South Alabama, Indiana, IUPUI, Indianapolis, SMU, and No. 25 St. John's. Also, Marist is 6-1 since Stetson defeated the Red Foxes on Nov. 28. The one loss came to Baylor on Nov. 30.

Streaking

Jama Sharp has scored in double figures in seven straight games (14.6 ppg) ... Amber Porter is averaging 16.8 ppg over the past four games ... C.J. Coddington is averaging 10.8 ppg over the past five games ... Brianti Saunders has made 11 consecutive free throws ... The Hatters have 36 assists in the past two games.

Sharp Approaching 1000 Points

Jama Sharp is just five points shy of the 1000-point mark for her career. She would become the 21st player in school history to reach that milestone.

Defense Paves the Way

Stetson's defense has been a big key to the team's 9-3 start. In the nine victories this season, the Hatters have allowed just 51.4 points per game, and opponents have shot just 31.4%. Including all 12 games, the Hatters lead the Atlantic Sun in fewest points allowed per game (58.0), lowest opponent field goal pct. (.350), and most blocks-per-game (4.6).

Four in Double Figures

The Hatters are the only team in the Atlantic Sun Conference with four players averaging double figures in scoring. They are Amber Porter (13.5), Jama Sharp (13.4), Brianti Saunders (13.1), and Myeisha Hall (12.4).

The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At DeLand's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.



Dominant at Home

The Hatters have won six straight, 21 of their last 22, 37 of their last 39 and 49 of their last 52 games at the Edmunds Center dating back to Feb., 2011. All three losses during that stretch have come to FGCU:

News and Notes**The Past 13 Months**

Over the past 13 months, from the start of December, 2013 through the present, Stetson has compiled a record of 33-8 (.805). The Hatters have lost to only four teams during that stretch: Florida Gulf Coast (3x), USF (3x), Florida, and #13 Baylor.

Two Close Games

Not many of Stetson's games this season have been decided in the final few minutes. In 10 of the first 12 games, the leading team's margin has been greater than 10 points with under three minutes to play. The only two close games were against Marist, which trailed by nine points at the 3:00 mark and later cut it to four with 1:32 to play, and Florida, where Stetson trailed by four at the 3:00 mark and later cut it to three with 2:10 to play. Overall, the latest point of a game that saw a lead change was at the 7:06 mark of the second half at UCF.

Taking Charge

Senior C.J. Coddington has taken a team-best 15 charges this season. She took three in one game vs. Webber International on Dec. 5.

Points in the Paint Matter

The Hatters are 55-5 since the start of the 2012-13 season when outscoring its opponent in the paint. That includes a 9-1 mark this season, with the one loss coming at USF on Dec. 3.

Conference Leaders

Senior Jama Sharp leads the Atlantic Sun in assists-per-game (4.7) and steals-per-game (2.6). Amber Porter leads the league in blocks-per-game (2.1). As a team, the Hatters lead the A-Sun in scoring defense (58.0), opponent's field goal pct. (.350), blocks (4.6) and assists (15.2).

NCAA Active Leaders

As of Dec. 23, Amber Porter ranks third among NCAA Division I active leaders in blocks-per-game (3.28). Jama Sharp, meanwhile, ranks 10th in career steals (223) and 24th in career assists (370). She is the active Atlantic Sun leader in both categories.

A three-time Atlantic Sun Conference champion as a head coach, Lynn Bria is in her seventh season at the helm of Stetson women's basketball program.

Over the past four seasons Bria has turned the Hatters into a formidable force in the Atlantic Sun. She has guided the Hatters to two conference titles, two NCAA Tournament appearances, two WNIT bids, and four consecutive 20+ win seasons. In fact, Stetson is just one of two schools in the state of Florida to post as many as 99 victories since the start of the 2010-11 season.

In 2013-14 and for the third year in a row, the Hatters set a school-record for most victories in a single-season with 27. Stetson also won a school-record 16 conference games and won a school-record 16 consecutive contests during the regular season. The Hatters also earned their second-ever bid to the WNIT and the program's first-ever NCAA postseason victory, a 70-63 win at Miami on Mar. 20. Stetson had three players named First Team All-Conference, including A-Sun Freshman of the Year Amber Porter.

The 2012-13 season was one for the history books as the Hatters set numerous team records and captured their second A-Sun title in the past three seasons. Bria helped lead the Hatters to a school-record 24 wins overall, a 12-1 record at home, a school-record 14 wins in A-Sun play, and winning streaks of 11 straight overall and 16 in a row at home. In the A-Sun Championship game, Stetson rallied from a 15-point second-half deficit to defeat top-seeded and previously undefeated FGCU 70-64, and then earned their highest-ever NCAA Tournament seed (14) and an appearance in the Columbus, Ohio regional against UCLA.

In 2011-12, the Hatters won a school-record 23 games and advanced to the postseason for the second year in a row, participating in the WNIT for the first time in school history. Three players earned All-Atlantic Sun honors including A-Sun Player of the Year and All-Tournament Team selection Victoria McGowan, who led the nation with three triple-doubles. Also honored were Second Team All-Atlantic Sun forward Sasha Sims and A-Sun All-Freshman Team forward Cherrisse Burris.

Bria's 2010-11 Hatters won 20 games for the first time in 10 seasons, captured their third Atlantic Sun Conference tournament championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second time in school history and first time since 2005.

Stetson's turnaround under Bria from 6-24 to 20-13 (+12.5 games) was the second largest improvement in NCAA Division I women's basketball. Honors that came to members of the team included A-Sun Tournament MVP (Victoria McGowan), A-Sun All-Tournament Team (Tierra Brown, Sasha Sims), Second Team All-Atlantic Sun (McGowan), A-Sun All-Freshman Team (Sims), A-Sun Player of the Week (Natasha Graboski) and A-Sun Newcomer of the Week (McGowan twice, Sims). Graboski went on to sign a professional contract with Alexandria of Romania's Division 1 League in the summer of 2011.

In 2009-10 Bria led the Hatters to their seventh consecutive A-Sun tournament appearance. In her first season at Stetson, Bria made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as her 2009-10 incoming class was ranked by Michael T. White's noted scouting service All-Star Girls Report as the best in the Atlantic Sun and in the top third of all NCAA Division I teams.

Bria has coached women's basketball for 20 years with 14 seasons of Division I head coaching experience to her credit at UCF, Ohio University and Stetson. In addition to coaching, she has extensive classroom experience at the university level and is committed to developing young women both athletically and academically.

From 1999-2006, Bria was the head coach at Ohio University in Athens, Ohio. She also led UCF for three seasons from 1996-99. Her final Golden Knights team in 1998-99 was the TAAC (now Atlantic Sun) regular season and tournament champions and appeared in the NCAA Tournament. Her first head coaching position came at Division II Texas Woman's University in Denton, Texas for three seasons from 1993-96.

A standout performer for the Charleston Golden Eagles, the Class of 1990 graduate was inducted into her alma mater's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2003. She scored 1,146 points in her career, averaging 10.3 points per game and was a 75.3 percent free throw shooter over her career.
