Winners of three straight and seven out of eight, Stetson hosts the USC Upstate Spartans Saturday afternoon at the Edmunds Center. Tip-off is scheduled for 1 p.m. with live coverage on ESPN3.

Sharp Named A-Sun Player of the Week

Following her 16-point, 10-rebound, 8-steal, 6-assist performance against UNF on Saturday, senior Jama Sharp earned Atlantic Sun Player of the Week honors for the second time this season.

The All-Time Series vs. USC Upstate - 16th Meeting

Stetson leads the all-time series 11-4 over USC Upstate. The Hatters have won the last six head-to-head meetings including a 90-60 win in the A-Sun semifinals last year. Stetson also leads the series 6-1 in DeLand.

With a Win Today...

With a win today, the Hatters would ...

- improve to 15-4 overall and 4-1 in A-Sun play
- win for the 23rd consecutive time in regular season A-Sun games vs. teams other than FGCU
- win for the seventh consecutive time against USC Upstate
- win for the 10th straight time at home (and improve to 9-0 at home this season)

Four in Double Figures - Hard to Guard

The Hatters are the only team in the Atlantic Sun Conference with four players averaging double figures in scoring. As of Friday, they are also the only team in the nation with four players averaging 13.0 ppg or better - Brianti Saunders (13.3), Amber Porter (13.2), Jama Sharp (13.1), and Myeisha Hall (13.0).

Defense Paves the Way

Stetson's defense has been a critical component to the team's 14-4 start. Take a look at some of the team's accomplishments on the defensive side the court.

- The Hatters have held 16 of their 18 opponents to under 65 points
- The Hatters have held eight opponents to under 56 points
- Opponents are averaging just 56.6 ppg - best mark in the Atlantic Sun and 34th in the nation
- Opponents are shooting just 34.1 percent from the floor - best mark in the A-Sun and 12th in the nation
- Opponents are shooting just 26.3 percent from 3 - best mark in the A-Sun and 25th in the nation
- Stetson leads the A-Sun in blocks-per-game (4.7) and steals per game (10.2).
- Stetson held UNF to 38 points, the fewest allowed ever on the road against a Division I opponent
- Stetson has held 11 straight opponents to under 40% field goal shooting

Tighter Defense of Late

The Hatters have really tightened the screws defensively over the past seven games. Stetson opponents have scored just 54.3 points per game and are shooting just 31.7 percent from the floor. By comparison, the NCAA leader in field goal pct. defense for the season is UConn at 30.7 percent.

Home Cooking

Stetson has won nine straight home games (8-0 this year), 24 of its last 25, 40 of its last 42, and 52 of its last 55 games at the Edmunds Center.

Home Team Production

The Hatters have been outstanding at home this season, averaging 82.6 points per game and outscoring their opponents by an average of 32 points. Stetson is also shooting nearly 50% from the floor and averaging over 17 assists per game at home:

The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At DeLand's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.

Success in the A-Sun

Since the start of the 2010-11 season, Stetson is 57-20 (.740) in Atlantic Sun regular season games and 10-2 in A-Sun tournament games. The Hatters have reached the A-Sun Championship game all four years, winning it twice (2011, 2013). Stetson was 16-2 in the Atlantic Sun regular season last year.

Fall Signees

On Nov. 17, head coach Lynn Bria announced the signing of **McKenna Beach** (Cape Coral, Fla./Cape Coral HS) and **Myka Johnson-Matthews** (Upper Marlboro, Md./Bishop McNamara HS) to National Letters-of-Intent. Beach, a 5-6 point guard, was named second team All-State, first team all-area and first team all-conference. Johnson-Matthews, a 5-8 guard, earned first team all-conference honors and was named honorable mention all-area.

On Jan. 8, Bria announced the signing of two-time JUCO All-American **Abigail Asoro** to a Grant-in-Aid offer. Asoro hails from Stockholm, Sweden, and was MVP of Sweden's U-18 team.

A three-time Atlantic Sun Conference champion as a head coach, Lynn Bria is in her seventh season at the helm of Stetson women's basketball program.

Over the past four seasons Bria has turned the Hatters into a formidable force in the Atlantic Sun. She has guided the Hatters to two conference titles, two NCAA Tournament appearances, two WNIT bids, and four consecutive 20+ win seasons. In fact, Stetson is just one of two schools in the state of Florida to post as many as 106 victories since the start of the 2010-11 season.

In 2013-14 and for the third year in a row, the Hatters set a school-record for most victories in a single-season with 27. Stetson also won a school-record 16 conference games and won a school-record 16 consecutive contests during the regular season. The Hatters also earned their second-ever bid to the WNIT and the program's first-ever NCAA postseason victory, a 70-63 win at Miami on Mar. 20. Stetson had three players named First Team All-Conference, including A-Sun Freshman of the Year Amber Porter.

The 2012-13 season was one for the history books as the Hatters set numerous team records and captured their second A-Sun title in the past three seasons. Bria helped lead the Hatters to a school-record 24 wins overall, a 12-1 record at home, a school-record 14 wins in A-Sun play, and winning streaks of 11 straight overall and 16 in a row at home. In the A-Sun Championship game, Stetson rallied from a 15-point second-half deficit to defeat top-seeded and previously undefeated FGCU 70-64, and then earned their highest-ever NCAA Tournament seed (14) and an appearance in the Columbus, Ohio regional against UCLA.

In 2011-12, the Hatters won a school-record 23 games and advanced to the postseason for the second year in a row, participating in the WNIT for the first time in school history. Three players earned All-Atlantic Sun honors including A-Sun Player of the Year and All-Tournament Team selection Victoria McGowan, who led the nation with three triple-doubles. Also honored were Second Team All-Atlantic Sun forward Sasha Sims and A-Sun All-Freshman Team forward Cherrisse Burris.

Bria's 2010-11 Hatters won 20 games for the first time in 10 seasons, captured their third Atlantic Sun Conference tournament championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second time in school history and first time since 2005.

Stetson's turnaround under Bria from 6-24 to 20-13 (+12.5 games) was the second largest improvement in NCAA Division I women's basketball. Honors that came to members of the team included A-Sun Tournament MVP (Victoria McGowan), A-Sun All-Tournament Team (Tierra Brown, Sasha Sims), Second Team All-Atlantic Sun (McGowan), A-Sun All-Freshman Team (Sims), A-Sun Player of the Week (Natasha Graboski) and A-Sun Newcomer of the Week (McGowan twice, Sims). Graboski went on to sign a professional contract with Alexandria of Romania's Division 1 League in the summer of 2011.

In 2009-10 Bria led the Hatters to their seventh consecutive A-Sun tournament appearance. In her first season at Stetson, Bria made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as her 2009-10 incoming class was ranked by Michael T. White's noted scouting service All-Star Girls Report as the best in the Atlantic Sun and in the top third of all NCAA Division I teams.

Bria has coached women's basketball for 20 years with 14 seasons of Division I head coaching experience to her credit at UCF, Ohio University and Stetson. In addition to coaching, she has extensive classroom experience at the university level and is committed to developing young women both athletically and academically.

From 1999-2006, Bria was the head coach at Ohio University in Athens, Ohio. She also led UCF for three seasons from 1996-99. Her final Golden Knights team in 1998-99 was the TAAC (now Atlantic Sun) regular season and tournament champions and appeared in the NCAA Tournament. Her first head coaching position came at Division II Texas Woman's University in Denton, Texas for three seasons from 1993-96.

A standout performer for the Charleston Golden Eagles, the Class of 1990 graduate was inducted into her alma mater's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2003. She scored 1,146 points in her career, averaging 10.3 points per game and was a 75.3 percent free throw shooter over her career.
