Preview

Stetson will square off against Atlantic Sun leader Florida Gulf Coast at 1 p.m. Saturday. The game will be broadcast live on ESPN3 and on WSBB myam1230.com.

The All-Time Series vs. FGCU - 19th Meeting

FGCU leads the all-time series 15-3 over Stetson. The Eagles have won the last four head-to-head meetings. The two teams represent the last four Atlantic Sun tournament champions (Stetson 2011, 2013; FGCU 2012, 2014). The two teams have met for the conference championship in each of the last three years.

Inside the Series

The team leading at halftime has lost each of the past five meetings (the last four meetings Stetson has led at halftime but FGCU came back to win) ... The last three meetings have been decided by two points or less (five points total) ... Two of the last three meetings have gone to overtime ... Stetson has won 53 straight home games against teams other than FGCU, but the Hatters are 0-3 during that same stretch vs. the Eagles ... The Hatters have either equaled or had more field goals made than FGCU in each of the past five meetings.

Four in Double Figures - Hard to Guard

The Hatters are the only team in the Atlantic Sun Conference with four players averaging double figures in scoring - Brianti Saunders (13.8), Amber Porter (13.3), Jama Sharp (13.3), and Myeisha Hall (12.9). Stetson and DePaul are the only two teams in the nation that have four players averaging 12.9 points per game or better.

400 Assists Club

Senior Jama Sharp is one assist shy of 400 assists in her career. She is looking to become the seventh player in school history to reach that milestone. She would also become just the second Hatter with over 1000 points, 400 assists, and 250 steals (Donna Johnson, 1363 points, 486 assists, 296 steals).

50 Blocks Club

Sophomore Amber Porter needs one block to become the first player in school history with back-to-back 50-block seasons. Porter registered 129 blocks last season.

Take it Away

Senior Jama Sharp has collected 10 steals in her last two games, bringing her season total to a conference-leading 72 takeaways. Her 3.4 steals-per-game average ranks sixth in the NCAA. Sharp has collected 264 steals in her career, the fourth-most in school history and the ninth-highest total among active players in the NCAA.

Heating Up Part I

Sophomore Brianti Saunders has scored in double figures in six straight games. Over that stretch she has averaged 17.2 ppg and is shooting 56.5 percent from the floor.

Heating Up Part II

Also over the last six games, senior Jama Sharp is averaging 15.2 points, 6.2 rebounds, 3.7 assists, and 4.5 steals per game. She, too, has scored in double figures in all six games.

Defense Paves the Way

Stetson's defense has been a critical component to the team's 16-5 start. Take a look at some of the team's accomplishments on the defensive side the court.

- The Hatters have held 17 of their 21 opponents to under 65 points
- The Hatters have held 12 opponents to under 60 points
- Opponents are shooting just 34.4 percent from the floor - best mark in the A-Sun and 12th in the nation
- Opponents are shooting just 27.9 percent from 3 - best mark in the A-Sun and 38th in the nation
- Stetson leads the A-Sun in blocks-per-game (4.6) and steals per game (10.0).
- Stetson held UNF to 38 points, the fewest allowed ever on the road against a Division I opponent
- Stetson has held A-Sun opponents to 56.4 ppg and 33.7 percent shooting

Great Starts

Stetson's 16-5 mark is tied for the team's second-best 21-game start in school history. The Hatters were 17-4 in 2000-01, and 16-5 in both 2011-12 and 2013-14. With a win today, Stetson would tie for the best 22-game start in school history.

Home Cooking

Stetson has won 10 straight home games (9-0 this year), 25 of its last 26, 41 of its last 43, and 53 of its last 56 games at the Edmunds Center. Stetson has not trailed by more than five points at any time at home this season.

The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At DeLand's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.

Stetson University senior guard Jama Sharp (Mooresville, Ind.) has been selected as one of just 30 national candidates for the prestigious 2015 Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must have notable achievements in four areas of excellence – community, classroom, character and competition. Sharp's on-court accolades include an Atlantic Sun first team all-conference and all-tournament team selection in 2013-14 and two Atlantic Sun Player of the Week honors this season.

A three-time Atlantic Sun Conference champion as a head coach, Lynn Bria is in her seventh season at the helm of Stetson women's basketball program.

Over the past four seasons Bria has turned the Hatters into a formidable force in the Atlantic Sun. She has guided the Hatters to two conference titles, two NCAA Tournament appearances, two WNIT bids, and four consecutive 20+ win seasons. In fact, Stetson is just one of two schools in the state of Florida to post as many as 110 victories since the start of the 2010-11 season.

In 2013-14 and for the third year in a row, the Hatters set a school-record for most victories in a single-season with 27. Stetson also won a school-record 16 conference games and won a school-record 16 consecutive contests during the regular season. The Hatters also earned their second-ever bid to the WNIT and the program's first-ever NCAA postseason victory, a 70-63 win at Miami on Mar. 20. Stetson had three players named First Team All-Conference, including A-Sun Freshman of the Year Amber Porter.

The 2012-13 season was one for the history books as the Hatters set numerous team records and captured their second A-Sun title in the past three seasons. Bria helped lead the Hatters to a school-record 24 wins overall, a 12-1 record at home, a school-record 14 wins in A-Sun play, and winning streaks of 11 straight overall and 16 in a row at home. In the A-Sun Championship game, Stetson rallied from a 15-point second-half deficit to defeat top-seeded and previously undefeated FGCU 70-64, and then earned their highest-ever NCAA Tournament seed (14) and an appearance in the Columbus, Ohio regional against UCLA.

In 2011-12, the Hatters won a school-record 23 games and advanced to the postseason for the second year in a row, participating in the WNIT for the first time in school history. Three players earned All-Atlantic Sun honors including A-Sun Player of the Year and All-Tournament Team selection Victoria McGowan, who led the nation with three triple-doubles. Also honored were Second Team All-Atlantic Sun forward Sasha Sims and A-Sun All-Freshman Team forward Cherrisse Burris.

Bria's 2010-11 Hatters won 20 games for the first time in 10 seasons, captured their third Atlantic Sun Conference tournament championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second time in school history and first time since 2005.

Stetson's turnaround under Bria from 6-24 to 20-13 (+12.5 games) was the second largest improvement in NCAA Division I women's basketball. Honors that came to members of the team included A-Sun Tournament MVP (Victoria McGowan), A-Sun All-Tournament Team (Tierra Brown, Sasha Sims), Second Team All-Atlantic Sun (McGowan), A-Sun All-Freshman Team (Sims), A-Sun Player of the Week (Natasha Graboski) and A-Sun Newcomer of the Week (McGowan twice, Sims). Graboski went on to sign a professional contract with Alexandria of Romania's Division 1 League in the summer of 2011.

In 2009-10 Bria led the Hatters to their seventh consecutive A-Sun tournament appearance. In her first season at Stetson, Bria made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as her 2009-10 incoming class was ranked by Michael T. White's noted scouting service All-Star Girls Report as the best in the Atlantic Sun and in the top third of all NCAA Division I teams.

Bria has coached women's basketball for 20 years with 14 seasons of Division I head coaching experience to her credit at UCF, Ohio University and Stetson. In addition to coaching, she has extensive classroom experience at the university level and is committed to developing young women both athletically and academically.

From 1999-2006, Bria was the head coach at Ohio University in Athens, Ohio. She also led UCF for three seasons from 1996-99. Her final Golden Knights team in 1998-99 was the TAAC (now Atlantic Sun) regular season and tournament champions and appeared in the NCAA Tournament. Her first head coaching position came at Division II Texas Woman's University in Denton, Texas for three seasons from 1993-96.

A standout performer for the Charleston Golden Eagles, the Class of 1990 graduate was inducted into her alma mater's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2003. She scored 1,146 points in her career, averaging 10.3 points per game and was a 75.3 percent free throw shooter over her career.
