News and Notes

Preview

For the second time in 13 days, Stetson and Lipscomb will square-off in an Atlantic Sun Conference game. Tip-off at the Edmunds Center is scheduled for 7 p.m. Thursday night.

The All-Time Series vs. Lipscomb - 24th Meeting

Stetson leads the all-time series 16-7 over Lipscomb, including a streak of eight wins in a row. The Hatters scored a combined 276 points in the past three games vs. Lipscomb. Amber Porter averages 17.7 points, 9.0 rebounds, and 4.3 blocks per game against the Bisons.

The Last Meeting

Jama Sharp led the way with 22 points and Amber Porter added 20 points of her own as visiting Stetson held off Lipscomb 82-77 on Jan. 31 at Allen Arena. Sharp also collected nine rebounds and five steals as the Hatters (16-5, 5-2 Atlantic Sun) bounced back from Thursday's loss at Northern Kentucky to post their 16th win of the season. Saturday's contest was a hard-fought affair as both teams were whistled for a combined 49 fouls. Stetson led by as many as 13 points in the first half and 16 in the second half before withstanding a late Lady Bisons run. Lipscomb (8-13, 3-4) hit 11 3-pointers for the game, including five by Danay Fothergill, who finished with 24 points.

Bounce Back Wins

The Hatters are 5-0 this season following a loss and have won 12 straight games overall when following a loss. Stetson's last back-to-back losses came in 2012-13 (at FGCU, at UNF).

Four in Double Figures - Hard to Guard

The Hatters are the only team in the Atlantic Sun Conference with four players averaging double figures in scoring - Brianti Saunders (13.5), Amber Porter (13.3), Jama Sharp (13.0), and Myeisha Hall (12.7).

400 Assists Club

Senior Jama Sharp became the seventh player in school history to reach 400 assists vs. FGCU. She is also just the second Hatter with over 1000 points, 400 assists, and 250 steals (Donna Johnson, 1363 points, 486 assists, 296 steals).

50 Blocks Club

Sophomore Amber Porter is the first player in school history with back-to-back 50-block seasons. Porter registered 129 blocks last season, and has 52 blocks this season.

Take it Away

Senior Jama Sharp has collected 12 steals in her last three games, bringing her season total to a conference-leading 74 takeaways. Her 3.4 steals-per-game average ranks seventh in the NCAA. Sharp has collected 266 steals in her career, the fourth-most in school history and the ninth-highest total among active players in the NCAA.

A Complete Game

Senior Myeisha Hall played a complete 40-minute game against FGCU on Saturday. She is the first Hatter to play a complete game since Victoria McGowan did so vs. UCLA in the NCAA tournament on March 23, 2013.

Double-Doubles

Amber Porter posted her sixth double-double of the season Saturday with a 13-point, 11-rebound performance vs. FGCU. She now has 16 double-doubles in her career.

Defense Paves the Way

Stetson's defense has been a critical component to the team's 16-6 start. Take a look at some of the team's accomplishments on the defensive side the court.

- The Hatters have held 18 of their 22 opponents to under 65 points
- The Hatters have held 12 opponents to under 60 points
- Opponents are shooting just 34.5 percent from the floor - best mark in the A-Sun and 14th in the nation
- Stetson leads the A-Sun in blocks-per-game (4.6) and steals per game (9.8).
- Stetson held UNF to 38 points, the fewest allowed ever on the road against a Division I opponent
- Stetson has held A-Sun opponents to 57.0 ppg and 34.1 percent shooting

Great Starts

Stetson's 16-6 mark is tied for the team's fourth-best 22-game start in school history.

Home Cooking

Stetson is 9-1 at home this year. The Hatters have also won 10 out of 11, 25 of 27, 41 of 44, and 53 of its last 57 games at the Edmunds Center. All four losses during that stretch have come to FGCU.

The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At DeLand's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.

Jama Sharp Named CLASS Award Candidate

Stetson University senior guard Jama Sharp (Mooresville, Ind.) has been selected as one of just 30 national candidates for the prestigious 2015 Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must have notable achievements in four areas of excellence – community, classroom, character and competition. Sharp's on-court accolades include an Atlantic Sun first team all-conference and all-tournament team selection in 2013-14 and two Atlantic Sun Player of the Week honors this season.

A three-time Atlantic Sun Conference champion as a head coach, Lynn Bria is in her seventh season at the helm of Stetson women's basketball program.

Over the past four seasons Bria has turned the Hatters into a formidable force in the Atlantic Sun. She has guided the Hatters to two conference titles, two NCAA Tournament appearances, two WNIT bids, and four consecutive 20+ win seasons. In fact, Stetson is just one of two schools in the state of Florida to post as many as 110 victories since the start of the 2010-11 season.

In 2013-14 and for the third year in a row, the Hatters set a school-record for most victories in a single-season with 27. Stetson also won a school-record 16 conference games and won a school-record 16 consecutive contests during the regular season. The Hatters also earned their second-ever bid to the WNIT and the program's first-ever NCAA postseason victory, a 70-63 win at Miami on Mar. 20. Stetson had three players named First Team All-Conference, including A-Sun Freshman of the Year Amber Porter.

The 2012-13 season was one for the history books as the Hatters set numerous team records and captured their second A-Sun title in the past three seasons. Bria helped lead the Hatters to a school-record 24 wins overall, a 12-1 record at home, a school-record 14 wins in A-Sun play, and winning streaks of 11 straight overall and 16 in a row at home. In the A-Sun Championship game, Stetson rallied from a 15-point second-half deficit to defeat top-seeded and previously undefeated FGCU 70-64, and then earned their highest-ever NCAA Tournament seed (14) and an appearance in the Columbus, Ohio regional against UCLA.

In 2011-12, the Hatters won a school-record 23 games and advanced to the postseason for the second year in a row, participating in the WNIT for the first time in school history. Three players earned All-Atlantic Sun honors including A-Sun Player of the Year and All-Tournament Team selection Victoria McGowan, who led the nation with three triple-doubles. Also honored were Second Team All-Atlantic Sun forward Sasha Sims and A-Sun All-Freshman Team forward Cherrisse Burris.

Bria's 2010-11 Hatters won 20 games for the first time in 10 seasons, captured their third Atlantic Sun Conference tournament championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second time in school history and first time since 2005.

Stetson's turnaround under Bria from 6-24 to 20-13 (+12.5 games) was the second largest improvement in NCAA Division I women's basketball. Honors that came to members of the team included A-Sun Tournament MVP (Victoria McGowan), A-Sun All-Tournament Team (Tierra Brown, Sasha Sims), Second Team All-Atlantic Sun (McGowan), A-Sun All-Freshman Team (Sims), A-Sun Player of the Week (Natasha Graboski) and A-Sun Newcomer of the Week (McGowan twice, Sims). Graboski went on to sign a professional contract with Alexandria of Romania's Division 1 League in the summer of 2011.

In 2009-10 Bria led the Hatters to their seventh consecutive A-Sun tournament appearance. In her first season at Stetson, Bria made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as her 2009-10 incoming class was ranked by Michael T. White's noted scouting service All-Star Girls Report as the best in the Atlantic Sun and in the top third of all NCAA Division I teams.

Bria has coached women's basketball for 20 years with 14 seasons of Division I head coaching experience to her credit at UCF, Ohio University and Stetson. In addition to coaching, she has extensive classroom experience at the university level and is committed to developing young women both athletically and academically.

From 1999-2006, Bria was the head coach at Ohio University in Athens, Ohio. She also led UCF for three seasons from 1996-99. Her final Golden Knights team in 1998-99 was the TAAC (now Atlantic Sun) regular season and tournament champions and appeared in the NCAA Tournament. Her first head coaching position came at Division II Texas Woman's University in Denton, Texas for three seasons from 1993-96.

A standout performer for the Charleston Golden Eagles, the Class of 1990 graduate was inducted into her alma mater's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2003. She scored 1,146 points in her career, averaging 10.3 points per game and was a 75.3 percent free throw shooter over her career.
