Preview

Stetson will begin a three-game road trip at 7 p.m. Thursday night at USC Upstate. Live coverage can be seen on ESPN3.

The All-Time Series vs. USC Upstate - 17th Meeting

Stetson leads the all-time series 12-4 over USC Upstate, including a streak of seven wins in a row. The Hatters defeated the Spartans 67-44 in DeLand earlier this season. The all-time series is tied 3-3 in Spartanburg, although the Hatters have won the last two in a row at the Hodge Center.

The Last Meeting

Brianti Saunders led four players in double figures with 16 points as Stetson cruised to a 67-44 win over USC Upstate on Jan. 24 at the Edmunds Center. Stetson held USC Upstate to just 21 second-half points and never allowed the Spartans to make a run after halftime. C.J. Coddington and Myeisha Hall each contributed 12 points, while Jama Sharp added 11 points.

Saunders, Sagerer Earn Atlantic Sun Weekly Awards

Sophomore guard Brianti Saunders was named the Atlantic Sun co-Player of the Week and freshman forward Sarah Sagerer was named the league's Newcomer of the Week this week. Saunders averaged 23.5 points and 6.5 rebounds and shot a blistering 60.7% from the field and 70.0% from behind the arc last week. She scored a career-high 33 points in Stetson's 103-75 win over Lipscomb on Thursday, going 13-for-17 from the floor and 5-for-6 from 3-point range. She added 14 points and seven rebounds vs. NKU on Saturday ... Making her first two starts of the year, Sagerer averaged 19.5 points, 12.0 rebounds, and 4.0 blocks in the two victories last week. She registered 23 points, 18 rebounds, and five blocks, all career-highs, in the win over Lipscomb, then collected 16 points, six rebounds, and three blocks in the Hatters' victory over Northern Kentucky on Saturday.

With starting center Amber Porter out with an injury, freshman Sarah Sagerer stepped up in a huge way Thursday night. Sagerer registered 23 points, 18 rebounds, and five blocks to help lead Stetson past Lipscomb. She was 9-for-15 from the floor and 1-for-1 from 3-point range. The last time a Hatter recorded 18 rebounds in a game was Amber Porter vs. Murray State on Dec. 20, 2013.

For their efforts, Brianti Saunders and Sarah Sagerer were honored with the co-Mid-Major Performance of the Night by the Swish Appeal website.

The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At DeLand's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in

his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.

Everybody on the Glass

The Hatters have six players in the top 15 in rebounding in the Atlantic Sun Conference. All six are averaging 5.0 rebounds per game or better.

Take it Away

Senior Jama Sharp ranks fifth in the NCAA with a 3.4 steals-per-game average. Sharp has collected 274 steals in her career, the fourth-most in school history and the eighth-highest total among active players in the NCAA. She has 20 career steals in three games at the Hodge Center.

Great Starts

Stetson's 18-6 mark is tied for the team's fourth-best 24-game start in school history.

Home Cooking

Stetson is 11-1 at home this year. The Hatters have also won 12 out of 13, 27 of 29, 43 of 46, and 55 of its last 59 games at the Edmunds Center. All four losses during that stretch have come to FGCU.

Defense Paves the Way

Stetson's defense has been a critical componet to the team's 18-6 start. Take a look at some of the team's accomplishments on the defensive side the court.

- · The Hatters have held 19 of their 24 opponents to under 65 points
- The Hatters have held 13 opponents to under 60 points
- Opponents are shooting just 34.9 percent from the floor best mark in the A-Sun and 15th in the nation

A three-time Atlantic Sun Conference champion as a head coach, Lynn Bria is in her seventh season at the helm of Stetson women's basketball program.

Over the past four seasons Bria has turned the Hatters into a formidable force in the Atlantic Sun. She has guided the Hatters to two conference titles, two NCAA Tournament appearances, two WNIT bids, and four consecutive 20+ win seasons. In fact, Stetson is just one of two schools in the state of Florida to post as many as 112 victories since the start of the 2010-11 season.

In 2013-14 and for the third year in a row, the Hatters set a school-record for most victories in a single-season with 27. Stetson also won a school-record 16 conference games and won a schoolrecord 16 consecutive contests during the regular season. The Hatters also earned their second-ever bid to the WNIT and the program's first-ever NCAA postseason victory, a 70-63 win at Miami on Mar. 20. Stetson had three players named First Team All-Conference, including A-Sun Freshman of the Year

The 2012-13 season was one for the history books as the Hatters set numerous team records and captured their second A-Sun title in the past three seasons. Bria helped lead the Hatters to a schoolrecord 24 wins overall, a 12-1 record at home, a school-record 14 wins in A-Sun play, and winning streaks of 11 straight overall and 16 in a row at home. In the A-Sun Championship game, Stetson rallied from a 15-point second-half deficit to defeat top-seeded and previously undefeated FGCU 70-64, and then earned their highest-ever NCAA Tournament seed (14) and an appearance in the Columbus, Ohio regional against UCLA.

In 2011-12, the Hatters won a school-record 23 games and advanced to the postseason for the second year in a row, participating in the WNIT for the first time in school history. Three players earned All-Atlantic Sun honors including A-Sun Player of the Year and All-Tournament Team selection Victoria McGowan, who led the nation with three triple-doubles. Also honored were Second Team All-Alantic Sun forward Sasha Sims and A-Sun All-Freshman Team forward Cherisse Burris.

Bria's 2010-11 Hatters won 20 games for the first time in 10 seasons, captured their third Atlantic Sun Conference tournament championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second time in school history and first time since 2005.

Stetson's turnaround under Bria from 6-24 to 20-13 (+12.5 games) was the second largest improvement in NCAA Division I women's basketball. Honors that came to members of the team included A-Sun Tournament MVP (Victoria McGowan), A-Sun All-Tournament Team (Tierra Brown, Sasha Sims), Second Team All-Atlantic Sun (McGowan), A-Sun All-Freshman Team (Sims), A-Sun Player of the Week (Natasha Graboski) and A-Sun Newcomer of the Week (McGowan twice, Sims). Graboski went on to sign a professional contract with Alexandria of Romania's Division 1 League in the summer of 2011.

In 2009-10 Bria led the Hatters to their seventh consecutive A-Sun tournament appearance. In her first season at Stetson, Bria made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as her 2009-10 incoming class was ranked by Michael T. White's noted scouting service All-Star Girls Report as the best in the Atlantic Sun and in the top third of all NCAA Division I teams.

Bria has coached women's basketball for 20 years with 14 seasons of Division I head coaching experience to her credit at UCF, Ohio University and Stetson. In addition to coaching, she has extensive classroom experience at the university level and is committed to developing young women both athletically and academically.

From 1999-2006, Bria was the head coach at Ohio University in Athens, Ohio. She also led UCF for three seasons from 1996-99. Her final Golden Knights team in 1998-99 was the TAAC (now Atlantic Sun) regular season and tournament champions and appeared in the NCAA Tournament. Her first head coaching position came at Division II Texas Woman's University in Denton, Texas for three seasons from 1993-96.

A standout performer for the Charleston Golden Eagles, the Class of 1990 graduate was inducted into her alma mater's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2003. She scored 1,146 points in her career, averaging 10.3 points per game and was a 75.3 percent free throw shooter over her career.
