### Preview

Stetson will look for its 20th win of the season at 2 p.m. Saturday afternoon at Kennesaw State. Live coverage can be seen on ESPN3.

### The All-Time Series vs. Kennesaw State - 21st Meeting

Stetson leads the all-time series 18-3 over Kennesaw State. The Hatters have won the last 13 head-to-head meetings, including a 75-64 win in DeLand earlier this season. Stetson also leads the series 8-1 in Kennesaw. Amber Porter averages 16.0 points, 9.0 rebounds, and 5.0 blocks per game vs. the Owls.

### The Last Meeting

Brianti Saunders scored a team-high 19 points on 8-for-9 shooting as Stetson won its third game in a row, 75-64 over Kennesaw State on Jan. 22 at the Edmunds Center. Jama Sharp added 16 points and five assists, C.J. Coddington scored 12 points and Myeisha Hall chipped in 10.

### With a Win Today...

- win their 20th game of the year for the fifth year in a row and for the seventh time in school history
- win for the 14th consecutive time against USC Upstate

### Sarah Sagerer Seizes Her Opportunity

With starting center Amber Porter out with an injury, freshman Sarah Sagerer stepped up in a huge way on Feb. 12 vs. Lipscomb, registering 23 points, 18 rebounds, and five blocks. Since then she has started all three games and has performed extremely well, averaging 17.7 points, 11.7 rebounds, and 3.3 blocks. She was named the league's freshman of the week on February 16:

### Four in Double Figures - Hard to Guard

The Hatters are the only team in the Atlantic Sun Conference with four players averaging double figures in scoring - Brianti Saunders (14.1), Jama Sharp (13.6), Amber Porter (13.2), and Myeisha Hall (13.1). In fact, the Hatters are the only team in the NCAA with four players averaging 13.0 points per game or better.

### Everybody on the Glass

The Hatters have six players in the top 15 in rebounding in the Atlantic Sun Conference. All six are averaging 4.9 rebounds per game or better.

### Take it Away

Senior Jama Sharp ranks fifth in the NCAA with a 3.4 steals-per-game average. Sharp has collected 275 steals in her career, the fourth-most in school history and the eighth-highest total among active players in the NCAA.

### Great Starts

Stetson's 19-6 mark is tied for the team's second-best 25-game start in school history. The Hatters were 20-5 after 25 games last season.

### Home Cooking

Stetson is 11-1 at home this year. The Hatters have also won 12 out of 13, 27 of 29, 43 of 46, and 55 of its last 59 games at the Edmunds Center. All four losses during that stretch have come to FGCU.

## The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At DeLand's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.

### Defense Paves the Way

Stetson's defense has been a critical component to the team's 19-6 start. Take a look at some of the team's accomplishments on the defensive side of the court.

- The Hatters have held 19 of their 25 opponents to under 65 points

- Opponents are shooting just 35.3 percent from the floor - best mark in the A-Sun and 15th in the nation
- Stetson leads the A-Sun in blocks-per-game (4.9) and steals per game (9.9).
- Stetson held UNF to 38 points, the fewest allowed ever on the road against a Division I opponent

### Jama Sharp Named CLASS Award Candidate

Stetson University senior guard Jama Sharp (Mooresville, Ind.) has been selected as one of just 30 national candidates for the prestigious 2015 Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible for the award, a student-athlete must have notable achievements in four areas of excellence – community, classroom, character and competition. Sharp's on-court accolades include an Atlantic Sun first team all-conference and all-tournament team selection in 2013-14 and two Atlantic Sun Player of the Week honors this season.

### Five-Year Success in the State of Florida

### Saunders, Sagerer Earn Atlantic Sun Weekly Awards

Sophomore guard Brianti Saunders was named the Atlantic Sun co-Player of the Week and freshman forward Sarah Sagerer was named the league's Newcomer of the Week this week. Saunders averaged 23.5 points and 6.5 rebounds and shot a blistering 60.7% from the field and 70.0% from behind the arc last week. She scored a career-high 33 points in Stetson's 103-75 win over Lipscomb on Thursday, going 13-for-17 from the floor and 5-for-6 from 3-point range. She added 14 points and seven rebounds vs. NKU on Saturday ... Making her first two starts of the year, Sagerer averaged 19.5 points, 12.0 rebounds, and 4.0 blocks in the two victories last week. She registered 23 points, 18 rebounds, and five blocks, all career-highs, in the win over Lipscomb, then collected 16 points, six rebounds, and three blocks in the Hatters' victory over Northern Kentucky on Saturday.

A three-time Atlantic Sun Conference champion as a head coach, Lynn Bria is in her seventh season at the helm of Stetson women's basketball program.

Over the past four seasons Bria has turned the Hatters into a formidable force in the Atlantic Sun. She has guided the Hatters to two conference titles, two NCAA Tournament appearances, two WNIT bids, and four consecutive 20+ win seasons. In fact, Stetson is just one of two schools in the state of Florida to post as many as 113 victories since the start of the 2010-11 season.

In 2013-14 and for the third year in a row, the Hatters set a school-record for most victories in a single-season with 27. Stetson also won a school-record 16 conference games and won a school-record 16 consecutive contests during the regular season. The Hatters also earned their second-ever bid to the WNIT and the program's first-ever NCAA postseason victory, a 70-63 win at Miami on Mar. 20. Stetson had three players named First Team All-Conference, including A-Sun Freshman of the Year Amber Porter.

The 2012-13 season was one for the history books as the Hatters set numerous team records and captured their second A-Sun title in the past three seasons. Bria helped lead the Hatters to a school-record 24 wins overall, a 12-1 record at home, a school-record 14 wins in A-Sun play, and winning streaks of 11 straight overall and 16 in a row at home. In the A-Sun Championship game, Stetson rallied from a 15-point second-half deficit to defeat top-seeded and previously undefeated FGCU 70-64, and then earned their highest-ever NCAA Tournament seed (14) and an appearance in the Columbus, Ohio regional against UCLA.

In 2011-12, the Hatters won a school-record 23 games and advanced to the postseason for the second year in a row, participating in the WNIT for the first time in school history. Three players earned All-Atlantic Sun honors including A-Sun Player of the Year and All-Tournament Team selection Victoria McGowan, who led the nation with three triple-doubles. Also honored were Second Team All-Atlantic Sun forward Sasha Sims and A-Sun All-Freshman Team forward Cherrisse Burris.

Bria's 2010-11 Hatters won 20 games for the first time in 10 seasons, captured their third Atlantic Sun Conference tournament championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second time in school history and first time since 2005.

Stetson's turnaround under Bria from 6-24 to 20-13 (+12.5 games) was the second largest improvement in NCAA Division I women's basketball. Honors that came to members of the team included A-Sun Tournament MVP (Victoria McGowan), A-Sun All-Tournament Team (Tierra Brown, Sasha Sims), Second Team All-Atlantic Sun (McGowan), A-Sun All-Freshman Team (Sims), A-Sun Player of the Week (Natasha Graboski) and A-Sun Newcomer of the Week (McGowan twice, Sims). Graboski went on to sign a professional contract with Alexandria of Romania's Division 1 League in the summer of 2011.

In 2009-10 Bria led the Hatters to their seventh consecutive A-Sun tournament appearance. In her first season at Stetson, Bria made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as her 2009-10 incoming class was ranked by Michael T. White's noted scouting service All-Star Girls Report as the best in the Atlantic Sun and in the top third of all NCAA Division I teams.

Bria has coached women's basketball for 20 years with 14 seasons of Division I head coaching experience to her credit at UCF, Ohio University and Stetson. In addition to coaching, she has extensive classroom experience at the university level and is committed to developing young women both athletically and academically.

From 1999-2006, Bria was the head coach at Ohio University in Athens, Ohio. She also led UCF for three seasons from 1996-99. Her final Golden Knights team in 1998-99 was the TAAC (now Atlantic Sun) regular season and tournament champions and appeared in the NCAA Tournament. Her first head coaching position came at Division II Texas Woman's University in Denton, Texas for three seasons from 1993-96.

A standout performer for the Charleston Golden Eagles, the Class of 1990 graduate was inducted into her alma mater's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2003. She scored 1,146 points in her career, averaging 10.3 points per game and was a 75.3 percent free throw shooter over her career.
