#### **Preview**

Stetson will go for its fifth win a row at 7 p.m. Wednesday night at Jacksonville. Live coverage can be seen on ESPN3. The Hatters have already clinched the No. 2 seed for the A-Sun Championship.

## The All-Time Series vs. Jacksonville - 36th Meeting

Stetson leads the all-time series 22-13 over Jacksonville. The Hatters have won the last 10 head-tohead meetings, including a 73-47 win in DeLand earlier this season. Stetson also leads the series 8-7 in Jacksonville.

## The Last Meeting

Brianti Saunders scored a game-high 22 points to help lift Stetson to its first Atlantic Sun Conference victory of the season, 73-47 over visiting Jacksonville on Jan. 14 at the Edmunds Center. Jama Sharp added 14 points and five steals. Stetson put forth another strong defensive effort, holding JU to just 32 percent shooting from the floor and 20 percent from behind the arc. The Dolphins scored just 19 firsthalf points as Stetson led by 15 at the break. Myeisha Hall (12 points) and Amber Porter (11 points) also tallied double figures for the Hatters. Sarah Sagerer grabbed 11 rebounds and blocked three shots in 28 minutes of action.

## With a Win Today...

With a win today, the Hatters would ...

- win their 21st game of the year (school record is 27, set last year)
- extend their winning streak to five, which would be a season-high
- win for the 11th consecutive time against Jacksonville
- win their 10th conference game of the year

### 20 Wins Again

For the fifth year in a row and for the seventh time in school history, the Hatters have won 20 games in a season. The Hatters are just one of two teams in the state of Florida (FGCU) with five consecutive 20-win seasons.

## Sarah Sagerer Seizes Her Opportunity

With starting center Amber Porter out with an injury, freshman Sarah Sagerer stepped up in a huge way on Feb. 12 vs. Lipscomb, registering 23 points, 18 rebounds, and five blocks. Since then she has started all four games and has performed extremely well, averaging 14.3 points, 9.5 rebounds, and 2.8 blocks. She was named the league's freshman of the week on February 16:

## Four in Double Figures - Hard to Guard

The Hatters are the only team in the Atlantic Sun Conference with four players averaging double figures in scoring - Brianti Saunders (14.0), Jama Sharp (13.6), Amber Porter (13.5), and Myeisha Hall (13.1). In fact, the Hatters are the only team in the NCAA with four players averaging 13.0 points per game or better.

## **Everybody on the Glass**

The Hatters have six players in the top 20 in rebounding in the Atlantic Sun Conference. All six are averaging 4.8 rebounds per game or better.

## The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At DeLand's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in

his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.

## Take it Away

Senior Jama Sharp ranks ninth in the NCAA with a 3.3 steals-per-game average. Sharp has collected 277 steals in her career, the fourth-most in school history and the ninth-highest total among active players in the NCAA.

## **Great Records**

Stetson's 20-6 mark is tied for the team's second-best 26-game start in school history. The Hatters were 21-5 after 26 games last season.

## This 'N' That

Stetson has won three games this year when trailing during the second half ... The Hatters have won six games this year where they led wire-to-wire.

### **Home Cooking**

Stetson is 11-1 at home this year. The Hatters have also won 12 out of 13, 27 of 29, 43 of 46, and 55 of its last 59 games at the Edmunds Center. All four losses during that stretch have come to FGCU.

A three-time Atlantic Sun Conference champion as a head coach, Lynn Bria is in her seventh season at the helm of Stetson women's basketball program.

Over the past four seasons Bria has turned the Hatters into a formidable force in the Atlantic Sun. She has guided the Hatters to two conference titles, two NCAA Tournament appearances, two WNIT bids, and now five consecutive 20+ win seasons. In fact, Stetson is just one of two schools in the state of Florida to post as many as 114 victories since the start of the 2010-11 season.

In 2013-14 and for the third year in a row, the Hatters set a school-record for most victories in a single-season with 27. Stetson also won a school-record 16 conference games and won a schoolrecord 16 consecutive contests during the regular season. The Hatters also earned their second-ever bid to the WNIT and the program's first-ever NCAA postseason victory, a 70-63 win at Miami on Mar. 20. Stetson had three players named First Team All-Conference, including A-Sun Freshman of the Year

The 2012-13 season was one for the history books as the Hatters set numerous team records and captured their second A-Sun title in the past three seasons. Bria helped lead the Hatters to a schoolrecord 24 wins overall, a 12-1 record at home, a school-record 14 wins in A-Sun play, and winning streaks of 11 straight overall and 16 in a row at home. In the A-Sun Championship game, Stetson rallied from a 15-point second-half deficit to defeat top-seeded and previously undefeated FGCU 70-64, and then earned their highest-ever NCAA Tournament seed (14) and an appearance in the Columbus, Ohio regional against UCLA.

In 2011-12, the Hatters won a school-record 23 games and advanced to the postseason for the second year in a row, participating in the WNIT for the first time in school history. Three players earned All-Atlantic Sun honors including A-Sun Player of the Year and All-Tournament Team selection Victoria McGowan, who led the nation with three triple-doubles. Also honored were Second Team All-Alantic Sun forward Sasha Sims and A-Sun All-Freshman Team forward Cherisse Burris.

Bria's 2010-11 Hatters won 20 games for the first time in 10 seasons, captured their third Atlantic Sun Conference tournament championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second time in school history and first time since 2005.

Stetson's turnaround under Bria from 6-24 to 20-13 (+12.5 games) was the second largest improvement in NCAA Division I women's basketball. Honors that came to members of the team included A-Sun Tournament MVP (Victoria McGowan), A-Sun All-Tournament Team (Tierra Brown, Sasha Sims), Second Team All-Atlantic Sun (McGowan), A-Sun All-Freshman Team (Sims), A-Sun Player of the Week (Natasha Graboski) and A-Sun Newcomer of the Week (McGowan twice, Sims). Graboski went on to sign a professional contract with Alexandria of Romania's Division 1 League in the summer of 2011.

In 2009-10 Bria led the Hatters to their seventh consecutive A-Sun tournament appearance. In her first season at Stetson, Bria made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as her 2009-10 incoming class was ranked by Michael T. White's noted scouting service All-Star Girls Report as the best in the Atlantic Sun and in the top third of all NCAA Division I teams.

Bria has coached women's basketball for 20 years with 14 seasons of Division I head coaching experience to her credit at UCF, Ohio University and Stetson. In addition to coaching, she has extensive classroom experience at the university level and is committed to developing young women both athletically and academically.

From 1999-2006, Bria was the head coach at Ohio University in Athens, Ohio. She also led UCF for three seasons from 1996-99. Her final Golden Knights team in 1998-99 was the TAAC (now Atlantic Sun) regular season and tournament champions and appeared in the NCAA Tournament. Her first head coaching position came at Division II Texas Woman's University in Denton, Texas for three seasons from 1993-96.

A standout performer for the Charleston Golden Eagles, the Class of 1990 graduate was inducted into her alma mater's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2003. She scored 1,146 points in her career, averaging 10.3 points per game and was a 75.3 percent free throw shooter over her career.
