Stetson will honor its four seniors prior to Saturday's regular season finale against UNF. Tip-off is scheduled for 1 p.m. with live coverage on ESPN3 and WSBB radio.

The All-Time Series vs. UNF - 20th Meeting

Stetson leads the all-time series 11-8 over UNF. The Hatters have won the last three head-to-head meetings, including a 67-38 win in Jacksonville earlier this season. Jama Sharp had 16 points, 10 rebounds, eight steals and six assists in that game. Stetson also leads the series 8-1 in DeLand.

With a Win Today...

With a win today, the Hatters would ...

- · win their 22nd game of the year (school record is 27, set last year)
- · extend their winning streak to six, which would be a season-high
- · win for the fourth consecutive time against UNF
- · Finish conference play with an 11-3 mark

Postseason scenarios

Stetson will host the No. 7 seed in the A-Sun quarterfinals at 7 p.m. Friday night. That will likely be Lipscomb, unless UNF defeats Stetson and Kennesaw State defeats Lipscomb. Then UNF would jump into the No. 7 seed. Stetson has already clinched the No. 2 seed.

20 Wins Again

For the fifth year in a row and for the seventh time in school history, the Hatters have won 20 games in a season. In the past five seasons combined, the Hatters have compiled a record of 115-47 (.710). For baseball fans, that is 162 games - not a bad "baseball season" record.

Jama Sharp will play in her 130th career game today, tying Janelle Mills for the second-most all-time in school history. C.J. Coddington will play in her 129th career game, fourth-most all-time in school history.

Sarah Sagerer Seizes Her Opportunity

With starting center Amber Porter out with an injury, freshman Sarah Sagerer stepped up in a huge way on Feb. 12 vs. Lipscomb, registering 23 points, 18 rebounds, and five blocks. She then scored 16 points against Northern Kentucky and recorded 14 points and 11 rebounds vs. USC Upstate. Her minutes have been down the past two games as she battles an illness.

Miss Consistency

Myeisha Hall has scored in double figures in six straight games and in 14 of her last 15 games. She scored a career-high 23 points at Jacksonville on Wednesday, playing all 40 minutes.

With their 21-6 record, the Hatters are just one of 37 teams in the nation to own a winning percentage of .778 or better.

65 is the Magic Number

The Hatters are 19-0 this season when scoring 65 points ro more.

Four in Double Figures - Hard to Guard

The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At DeLand's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in

his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.

Everybody on the Glass

The Hatters have six players in the top 20 in rebounding in the Atlantic Sun Conference. All six are averaging 4.8 rebounds per game or better.

Senior Jama Sharp ranks ninth in the NCAA with a 3.2 steals-per-game average. Sharp has collected 279 steals in her career, the fourth-most in school history and the eighth-highest total among active players in the NCAA.

Great Records

Stetson's 21-6 mark is tied for the team's second-best 27-game start in school history. The Hatters were 22-5 after 27 games last season.

This 'N' That

Stetson has now won four games this year when trailing during the second half ... The Hatters have won six games this year where they led wire-to-wire.

Home Cooking

Stetson is 11-1 at home this year. The Hatters have also won 12 out of 13, 27 of 29, 43 of 46, and 55 of its last 59 games at the Edmunds Center. All four losses during that stretch have come to FGCU.

Defense Paves the Way

Stetson's defense has been a critical componet to the team's 21-6 start. Take a look at some of the team's accomplishments on the defensive side the court.

- The Hatters have held 20 of their 27 opponents to under 65 points
- The Hatters have held 14 opponents to under 60 points

Jama Sharp Named CLASS Award Candidate

Stetson University senior quard Jama Sharp (Mooresville, Ind.) has been selected as one of just 30 national candidates for the prestigious 2015 Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible for the award, a studentathlete must have notable achievements in four areas of excellence - community, classroom, character and competition. Sharp's on-court accolades include an Atlantic Sun first team all-conference and all-tournament team selection in 2013-14 and two Atlantic Sun Player of the Week honors this season.

A three-time Atlantic Sun Conference champion as a head coach, Lynn Bria is in her seventh season at the helm of Stetson women's basketball program.

Over the past four seasons Bria has turned the Hatters into a formidable force in the Atlantic Sun. She has guided the Hatters to two conference titles, two NCAA Tournament appearances, two WNIT bids, and now five consecutive 20+ win seasons. In fact, Stetson is just one of two schools in the state of Florida to post as many as 114 victories since the start of the 2010-11 season.

In 2013-14 and for the third year in a row, the Hatters set a school-record for most victories in a single-season with 27. Stetson also won a school-record 16 conference games and won a schoolrecord 16 consecutive contests during the regular season. The Hatters also earned their second-ever bid to the WNIT and the program's first-ever NCAA postseason victory, a 70-63 win at Miami on Mar. 20. Stetson had three players named First Team All-Conference, including A-Sun Freshman of the Year

The 2012-13 season was one for the history books as the Hatters set numerous team records and captured their second A-Sun title in the past three seasons. Bria helped lead the Hatters to a schoolrecord 24 wins overall, a 12-1 record at home, a school-record 14 wins in A-Sun play, and winning streaks of 11 straight overall and 16 in a row at home. In the A-Sun Championship game, Stetson rallied from a 15-point second-half deficit to defeat top-seeded and previously undefeated FGCU 70-64, and then earned their highest-ever NCAA Tournament seed (14) and an appearance in the Columbus, Ohio regional against UCLA.

In 2011-12, the Hatters won a school-record 23 games and advanced to the postseason for the second year in a row, participating in the WNIT for the first time in school history. Three players earned All-Atlantic Sun honors including A-Sun Player of the Year and All-Tournament Team selection Victoria McGowan, who led the nation with three triple-doubles. Also honored were Second Team All-Alantic Sun forward Sasha Sims and A-Sun All-Freshman Team forward Cherisse Burris.

Bria's 2010-11 Hatters won 20 games for the first time in 10 seasons, captured their third Atlantic Sun Conference tournament championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second time in school history and first time since 2005.

Stetson's turnaround under Bria from 6-24 to 20-13 (+12.5 games) was the second largest improvement in NCAA Division I women's basketball. Honors that came to members of the team included A-Sun Tournament MVP (Victoria McGowan), A-Sun All-Tournament Team (Tierra Brown, Sasha Sims), Second Team All-Atlantic Sun (McGowan), A-Sun All-Freshman Team (Sims), A-Sun Player of the Week (Natasha Graboski) and A-Sun Newcomer of the Week (McGowan twice, Sims). Graboski went on to sign a professional contract with Alexandria of Romania's Division 1 League in the summer of 2011.

In 2009-10 Bria led the Hatters to their seventh consecutive A-Sun tournament appearance. In her first season at Stetson, Bria made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as her 2009-10 incoming class was ranked by Michael T. White's noted scouting service All-Star Girls Report as the best in the Atlantic Sun and in the top third of all NCAA Division I teams.

Bria has coached women's basketball for 20 years with 14 seasons of Division I head coaching experience to her credit at UCF, Ohio University and Stetson. In addition to coaching, she has extensive classroom experience at the university level and is committed to developing young women both athletically and academically.

From 1999-2006, Bria was the head coach at Ohio University in Athens, Ohio. She also led UCF for three seasons from 1996-99. Her final Golden Knights team in 1998-99 was the TAAC (now Atlantic Sun) regular season and tournament champions and appeared in the NCAA Tournament. Her first head coaching position came at Division II Texas Woman's University in Denton, Texas for three seasons from 1993-96.

A standout performer for the Charleston Golden Eagles, the Class of 1990 graduate was inducted into her alma mater's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2003. She scored 1,146 points in her career, averaging 10.3 points per game and was a 75.3 percent free throw shooter over her career.
