Preview

The Stetson Hatters will host the Richmond Spiders Friday night in the first round of the 2015 WNIT. Tipoff is schedule for 7 p.m. with live coverage on ESPN3 and WSBB radio. The winner will face the winner of the Youngstown State vs. Duquesne game at a date and location to be announced.

The All-Time Series vs. Richmond - Second Meeting

Stetson and Richmond are meeting for just the second time ever, and for the first time in 27 seasons. The teams last met on Jan. 4, 1988, a 61-58 victory by Richmond at the Edmunds Center.

WNIT Postseason Play

Stetson is 1-2 all-time in Postseason WNIT action. In 2012, the Hatters fell at Florida International 75-47. In 2014, Stetson defeated Miami in Coral Gables by a 70-63 margin. In the second round, the Hatters fell at USF 75-56.

With a Win Today...

With a win today, the Hatters would ...

- · advance to the WNIT second round for the second year in a row
- · win their second all-time NCAA postseason game
- · win their 24th game of the year (school record is 27, set last year)
- · improve to 14-2 at home

Four Years of Excellence

Stetson's four winningest seasons have all come in the past four years. With 23 victories, this year's squad has tied the 2011-12 team for the third-most wins in school history. The 2012-13 team won 24 games and last year's team won 27 games:

With their 23-7 record, the Hatters are just one of 35 teams in the nation to own a winning percentage of .767 or better.

65 is the Magic Number

The Hatters are 21-0 this season when scoring 65 points ro more. Stetson is also:

- 20-1 when leading at halftime
- · 21-2 when outshooting its opponent
- 19-2 when having fewer turnovers
- 19-2 when shooting more free throws

Four in Double Figures - Hard to Guard

The Hatters are the only team in the Atlantic Sun Conference with four players averaging double figures in scoring - Brianti Saunders (13.9), Jama Sharp (13.9), Myeisha Hall (13.5), and Amber Porter (13.2). In fact, the Hatters are one of only two teams in the NCAA with four players averaging 13.0 points per game or better (lowa). All four players rank in the top 11 in the A-Sun in scoring.

Everybody on the Glass

The Hatters have six players in the top 20 in rebounding in the Atlantic Sun Conference. All six are averaging 4.7 rebounds per game or better.

Home Cooking

Stetson is 13-2 at home this year. The Hatters have also won 14 out of 16, 29 of 32, 45 of 49, and 57 of its last 62 games at the Edmunds Center.

Aisha Turner Strong in A-Sun Tournament

Sophomore Aisha Turner had two solid performances in the Atlantic Sun Championship. Against Lipscomb in the quarterfinals, she scored a season-high 14 points on 6-of-7 shooting from the floor. Against Northern Kentucky in the semifinals, she scored 11 points on 4-for-5 shooting. She also went 2-for-2 from behind the arc and averaged 4.0 rebounds per game.

Miss Consistency

Myeisha Hall has scored in double figures in 16 of her last 18 games. She has scored five or more points in every game this season, and has hit at least one 3-pointer in 25 of her 30 games.

Double Trouble

Amber Porter has collected seven double-doubles this season and 17 in her career.

The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At DeLand's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in

his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.

Fall Signees

On Nov. 17, head coach Lynn Bria announced the signing of McKenna Beach (Cape Coral, Fla./ Cape Coral HS) and Myka Johnson-Matthews (Upper Marlboro, Md./Bishop McNamara HS) to National Letters-of-Intent. Beach, a 5-6 point guard, was named second team All-State, first team all-area and first team all-conference. Johnson-Matthews, a 5-8 guard, earned first team all-conference honors and was named honorable mention all-area.

On Jan. 8. Bria announced the signing of twotime JUCO All-American Abigail Asoro to a Grant-in-Aid offer. Asoro hails from Stockholm, Sweden, and was MVP of Sweden's U-18 team.

NCAA Active Leaders

As of Mar. 17th, Amber Porter ranks fifth among NCAA Division I active leaders in blocks-pergame (3.24). Jama Sharp, meanwhile, ranks eighth in career steals (288) and 27th in career assists (440). She is the active Atlantic Sun leader in both categories.

News and Notes

In The Record Book

With 1251 career points, senior Jama Sharp is just one of 12 players in school history with 1250 points or more. She also ranks third in 3-point field goals (165), fifth in assists (440), fourth in steals (288), and second in games played (132).

Take it Away

Jama Sharp ranks ninth in the NCAA with a 3.2 steals-per-game average. Sharp has collected 288 steals in her career, the fourth-most in school history and the eighth-highest total among active players in the NCAA.

Block Party

Sophomore Amber Porter's 75 blocks this season is the second highest single-season total in school history, behind her own 129 blocks recorded as a freshman. Her 2014 career blocked shots is the most in school history, the eighth highest total in A-Sun history, and 21st among all active players in the NCAA.

This 'N' That

Stetson has won four games this year when trailing during the second half ... The Hatters have won eight games this year where they led wire-to-wire.

Strong Transition Defense

Over the past 11 games, Stetson has only allowed 15 fastbreak points. The Hatters have a 91-15 advantage over their opponents in fastbreak points during that stretch.

Defense Paves the Way

Stetson's defense has been a critical component to the team's 23-7 record. Take a look at some of the team's accomplishments on the defensive side the court.

- The Hatters have held 22 of their 30 opponents to under 65 points
- The Hatters have held 16 opponents to under 60 points
- Opponents are shooting just 35.0 percent from the floor best mark in the A-Sun and 14th in the nation
- Stetson leads the A-Sun in blocks-per-game (5.1) and steals per game (9.5).
- Stetson held UNF to 38 points, the fewest allowed ever on the road against a Division I opponent

Taking Charge

Senior C.J. Coddington has taken a team-best 23 charges this season. Myeisha Hall ranks second on the team with 13 charges drawn.

20 Wins Again

For the fifth year in a row and for the seventh time in school history, the Hatters have won 20 games in a season. In the past five seasons combined, the Hatters have compiled a record of 117-48 (.709).

Games Played

Jama Sharp will play in her 133nd career game today, marking the second-most all-time in school history and two shy of the school record. C.J. Coddington will play in her 132nd career game, making the thirdmost all-time in school history.

Jama Sharp Named CLASS Award Candidate

Stetson University senior guard Jama Sharp (Mooresville, Ind.) was selected as one of just 30 national candidates for the prestigious 2015 Senior CLASS Award. To be eligible for the award, a studentathlete must have notable achievements in four areas of excellence - community, classroom, character and competition. Sharp is a two-time first team all-conference selection, an academic all-conference selection, and a two-time A-Sun Player of the Week.

Five-Year Success in the State of Florida

Since the start of the 2010-11 season, the Hatters have compiled a 117-48 record (.709). Only one other team in the state of Florida has more wins than Stetson during that stretch:

A three-time Atlantic Sun Conference champion as a head coach, Lynn Bria is in her seventh season at the helm of Stetson women's basketball program.

Over the past four seasons Bria has turned the Hatters into a formidable force in the Atlantic Sun. She has guided the Hatters to two conference titles, two NCAA Tournament appearances, two WNIT bids, and now five consecutive 20+ win seasons. In fact, Stetson is just one of two schools in the state of Florida to post as many as 116 victories since the start of the 2010-11 season.

In 2013-14 and for the third year in a row, the Hatters set a school-record for most victories in a single-season with 27. Stetson also won a school-record 16 conference games and won a schoolrecord 16 consecutive contests during the regular season. The Hatters also earned their second-ever bid to the WNIT and the program's first-ever NCAA postseason victory, a 70-63 win at Miami on Mar. 20. Stetson had three players named First Team All-Conference, including A-Sun Freshman of the Year

The 2012-13 season was one for the history books as the Hatters set numerous team records and captured their second A-Sun title in the past three seasons. Bria helped lead the Hatters to a schoolrecord 24 wins overall, a 12-1 record at home, a school-record 14 wins in A-Sun play, and winning streaks of 11 straight overall and 16 in a row at home. In the A-Sun Championship game, Stetson rallied from a 15-point second-half deficit to defeat top-seeded and previously undefeated FGCU 70-64, and then earned their highest-ever NCAA Tournament seed (14) and an appearance in the Columbus, Ohio regional against UCLA.

In 2011-12, the Hatters won a school-record 23 games and advanced to the postseason for the second year in a row, participating in the WNIT for the first time in school history. Three players earned All-Atlantic Sun honors including A-Sun Player of the Year and All-Tournament Team selection Victoria McGowan, who led the nation with three triple-doubles. Also honored were Second Team All-Alantic Sun forward Sasha Sims and A-Sun All-Freshman Team forward Cherisse Burris.

Bria's 2010-11 Hatters won 20 games for the first time in 10 seasons, captured their third Atlantic Sun Conference tournament championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second time in school history and first time since 2005.

Stetson's turnaround under Bria from 6-24 to 20-13 (+12.5 games) was the second largest improvement in NCAA Division I women's basketball. Honors that came to members of the team included A-Sun Tournament MVP (Victoria McGowan), A-Sun All-Tournament Team (Tierra Brown, Sasha Sims), Second Team All-Atlantic Sun (McGowan), A-Sun All-Freshman Team (Sims), A-Sun Player of the Week (Natasha Graboski) and A-Sun Newcomer of the Week (McGowan twice, Sims). Graboski went on to sign a professional contract with Alexandria of Romania's Division 1 League in the summer of 2011.

In 2009-10 Bria led the Hatters to their seventh consecutive A-Sun tournament appearance. In her first season at Stetson, Bria made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as her 2009-10 incoming class was ranked by Michael T. White's noted scouting service All-Star Girls Report as the best in the Atlantic Sun and in the top third of all NCAA Division I teams.

Bria has coached women's basketball for 20 years with 14 seasons of Division I head coaching experience to her credit at UCF, Ohio University and Stetson. In addition to coaching, she has extensive classroom experience at the university level and is committed to developing young women both athletically and academically.

From 1999-2006, Bria was the head coach at Ohio University in Athens, Ohio. She also led UCF for three seasons from 1996-99. Her final Golden Knights team in 1998-99 was the TAAC (now Atlantic Sun) regular season and tournament champions and appeared in the NCAA Tournament. Her first head coaching position came at Division II Texas Woman's University in Denton, Texas for three seasons from 1993-96.

A standout performer for the Charleston Golden Eagles, the Class of 1990 graduate was inducted into her alma mater's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2003. She scored 1,146 points in her career, averaging 10.3 points per game and was a 75.3 percent free throw shooter over her career.

All-Conference Awards

Four members of the Stetson women's basketball team were honored by the Atlantic Sun Conference with postseason awards on Wednesday, including sophomore Amber Porter (Woodbridge, Va.) who was named the A-Sun Defensive Player of the Year.

Senior Jama Sharp (Mooresville, Ind.), senior Myeisha Hall (West Palm Beach, Fla.), and Porter were all named First Team All-Conference. Sarah Sagerer (Vocklabruck, Austria) was named to the Atlantic Sun All-Freshman Team.

Porter garnered her second straight first team allconference selection and her first Defensive Player of the Year honor. Entering postseason play, the 6-foot-3 center leads the conference and ranks 26th in the NCAA with an average of 2.6 blocks per game. She also ranks among the conference leaders in scoring (13.2), rebounding (7.4), and field goal percentage (.475). She has scored in double figures 18 times this season and has four games with 20+ points.

Porter is just four blocks shy of 200 in her career and ranks eighth in A-Sun history in blocked shots. She maintains the sixth-highest blocks average among all active players in the NCAA (3.21).

Sharp also earned her second straight first team all-conference honor in 2014-15. She was a twotime A-Sun Player of the Week and was just one of 30 national Senior CLASS Award candidates.

Sharp has started all 28 games at point guard for the Hatters and has scored in double figures 24 times. She leads the team with a 14.1 scoring average, and she ranked third in the league with a 15.3 scoring average in conference games. Defensively, She leads the league and ranks eighth in the NCAA in steals (3.3). In addition, she ranks second in the A-Sun in assists (4.1), second in assist-to-turnover ratio (2.0), and seventh in 3-point field goal percentage (.382).

For her career, Sharp ranks 14th all-time in school history in points (1228) and third in career 3-pointers (163). She has played in all 130 games without missing any.

Hall earned her first A-Sun postseason honor after averaging 13.8 points and 5.2 rebounds per game. She has started all 28 games, and she scored in double figures 22 times. In conference games, Hall averaged 14.6 points per game and scored in double figures in 13 of the team's 14 contests.

Always a threat from long range, Hall has hit 60 3-pointers this year, tied for the eighth-highest single-season total in school history. Her 2.1 trifectas per game rank second in the league. She also ranks fourth in the conference in minutes played (33.9).

Sagerer earned all-freshmen team honors after averaging 5.7 points, 5.0 rebounds, and 1.3 blocks per game so far this season. She earned Atlantic Sun Newcomer of the Week honors after recording a 23-point, 18-rebound double-double vs. Lipscomb in her first career start. She also had a 14-point, 11-rebound double-double at USC Upstate.


