Preview

The second-seeded Stetson women's basketball team will face third-seeded and host Mercer in the Atlantic Sun semifinals at 2:30 p.m. Friday afternoon on CSS, ESPN3 and WSBB. The Hatters advanced to the semifinals with a hard-fought 66-55 victory over no. 7 seed ETSU Wednesday night.

Dynamic Trio

Stetson's trio of Victoria McGowan, Shanasa Sanders, and Sasha Sims combined for 53 of the team's 66 points against ETSU on Wednesday. Against conference opponents this season (19 games), the trio is averaging a combined 44.1 points per game.

Stetson's Recent Atlantic Sun Conference Success

Since the start of the 2010-11 season, Stetson is a combined 45-18 (.714) against Atlantic Sun opposition. That includes a 39-17 (.696) regular season mark and a 6-1 record in A-Sun tournament games. The Hatters advanced to the A-Sun Championship game in each of the last two seasons, winning the title in 2011.

Atlantic Sun Champions

The Hatters have win the Atlantic Sun Championship three times previously (1989, 2005, and 2011), and earned an automatic bid to the NCAA Tournament in 2005 and 2011.

The All-Time Series vs. Mercer / The Last Meetings

Stetson leads the all-time series 35-29 over Mercer, including wins in both meetings earlier this season. The teams have met twice in the postseason, once in 1989 (W, 70-69 ot) and once in 2009 (L, 84-51)

A-Sun Awards

For the first time in school history, the Stetson women's basketball team landed three student-athletes on the Atlantic Sun all-conference first and second teams, the league announced with its annual postseason awards on Tuesday.

Senior guard **Victoria McGowan** (Inkster, Mich.) earned first-team all-conference honors for the second straight year, while senior **Shanasa Sanders** (Jacksonville, Fla.) and junior **Sasha Sims** (Fayetteville, Ga.) were each selected to the all-conference second-team.

A three-time Atlantic Sun Player of the Week, McGowan is averaging 16.1 points and 6.8 rebound per game this season. She ranks third in the league in scoring, assists (4.3), and steals (2.1). The Hatter senior has scored in double figures in 25 of her 28 games, and she is tied for the league-lead with 62 three-point field goals.

McGowan surpassed 20 points seven times, including a career-best 33-point performance in a come-from-behind victory at Kennesaw State on Jan. 2. She posted four double-doubles and the league's only triple-double on Feb. 18 at Lipscomb (19 pts./12 reb./10 ast.). Her .434 three-point field goal pct. ranks second in the A-Sun and seventh in the NCAA.

McGowan joins Michelle Michael and Kristy Brown as the only players in program history to be a two-time, first-team allconference honoree.

Sanders averaged 13.8 points and 6.5 rebounds per game en route to her first all-conference selection. The team's leading scorer in 12 contests this season, Sanders ranks fourth in the league in scoring, 11th in rebounding, and 10th in assists (2.5). She was named A-Sun Player of the Week in back-to-back weeks in early February.

For the season Sanders has started all 29 games and averages a team-high 32.7 minutes per game. She has scored in double figures 20 times, including four 20+point games. The Hatter senior enters the postseason on a roll, having averaged 17.2 points and 7.2 rebounds over the final 10 games of the regular season.

A second-team all-conference selection for the second straight year, Sims is averaging 11.4 points, 3.9 rebounds, and 1.4 blocks per game. She posted the seventh highest scoring average in the league in A-Sun games, averaging 13.5 ppg and shooting 49.7 percent against conference opponents. In fact, Sims scored 20 or more points six times in conference play, including the last three games of the regular season.

A strong defensive post player, Sims has registered 42 blocks this season. She ranks third among A-Sun players in that category and her 111 career blocks ranks third in Stetson history.

Stetson set a school record with an 11-game winning streak from Dec. 15-Jan. 21. That streak ranked as the third-longest active winning streak in the nation on the day it ended, Jan. 26.

16-Games at Home

Stetson set a school record with a 16game home court winning streak from Jan. 26-Feb. 11. That streak ranked as the seventh-longest active home court winning streak in the nation on the day it ended, Feb. 23.

The Hatters Nickname

The unlikely combination of a famous hat manufacturer and a university produced a novel nickname for Stetson University. The athletic teams are called "Hatters," reflecting the university's association with John B. Stetson, maker of the well-known Stetson hats. It all began in 1883 when Henry DeLand founded the DeLand Academy. Three years later, after a disastrous freeze affecting the citrus industry left DeLand in financial distress, Stetson, who had a winter home in DeLand, became interested in the school. At Deland's request, Stetson was made chairman of the Board of Trustees in 1889 and the university was renamed in

his honor. Stetson University fielded the first football team in Florida in 1901. The name "Hatter" was used then and is still in use today.

News and Notes

Dynamic Duo

Stetson's senior backcourt duo of Victoria McGowan and Shanasa Sanders are averaging a combined 30.1 points per game, the most of any duo in the Atlantic Sun. Mercer's Precious Bridges and Kendra Grant are averaging 29.8 points per game. The last Hatter duo to average over 30 points per game was Nefertiti Walker (21.5) and Janene Maclin (8.7) in 2005-06.

Best Class Ever

Stetson's senior class is the winningest four-year class in the history of the women's basketball program. Since the start of the 2009-10 season, the Hatters have won 71 games. Ashley Dennis, Janelle Mills, and Simone Taylor are each in their fourth season with the Hatters. Victoria McGowan also came to Stetson in 2009 as a sophomore transfer but sat out the 2009-10 season.

Atlantic Sun Statistical Leaders

The Hatters currently rank among the top three Atlantic Sun statistical leaders in nearly every category except rebounding. The Hatters lead the league in field goal percentage (.440), and three-point field goal percentage (.339), they rank second in scoring offense, scoring margin, free throw pct., blocks, and fewest turnovers, and they rank third in scoring defense, assists and steals. Individually, Victoria McGowan leads the league in three-point field goals (65) and she ranks second in three-point FG pct. (.434).

NCAA Statistical Leaders

In the Mar. 4 release of NCAA national statistics, the Hatters ranked 22nd in the nation in field goal pct., 41st in three-point field goal pct., and 45th in scoring. Victoria McGowan ranked seventh in the nation three-point field goal pct. (.434).

McGowan Chasing School Points Record

Senior Victoria McGowan has been climbing the charts towards the school record for most career points. She currently ranks third in Stetson history and 25th in A-Sun history with 1492 points. The school record holder for points scored is Michelle Michael with 1570. At her current season scoring pace, McGowan would have to play five more games to break the record.

Triple-Doubles

After recording an NCAA-best three triple-doubles a year ago, Victoria McGowan picked up her fourth career triple-double against Lipscomb on Feb. 18. McGowan joined Baylor's Brittney Griner as the only two active players in Division I with four career triple-doubles. Stetson's eight triple-double performances all-time is tied with Kansas State and Stanford for the most in NCAA Women's Basketball history.

The Head Coach

Lynn Bria is in her fifth season at the helm of Stetson women's basketball in 2012-13 after a second straight excellent campaign in 2011-12. Under Bria, the Hatters won a school record 23 games and advanced to the postseason for the second year in a row, participating in the WNIT for the first time in school history. Three players earned All-Atlantic Sun honors including A-Sun Player of the Year and All-Tournament Team selection Victoria McGowan, who led the nation with three triple-doubles. Also honored were Second Team All-Alantic Sun forward Sasha Sims and A-Sun All-Freshman Team forward Cherisse Burris.

Bria's 2010-11 Hatters won 20 games for the first time in 10 seasons, captured their third Atlantic Sun Conference tournament championship and advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the second time in school history and first time since 2005.

Stetson's turnaround under Bria from 6-24 to 20-13 (+12.5 games) was the second largest improvement in NCAA Division I women's basketball. Honors that came to members of the team included A-Sun Tournament MVP (Victoria McGowan), A-Sun All-Tournament Team (Tierra Brown, Sasha Sims), Second Team All-Atlantic Sun (McGowan), A-Sun All-Freshman Team (Sims), A-Sun Player of the Week (Natasha Graboski) and A-Sun Newcomer of the Week (McGowan twice, Sims). Graboski went on to sign a professional contract with Alexandria of Romania's Division 1 League in the summer of 2011.

In 2009-10 Bria led the Hatters to their seventh consecutive A-Sun tournament appearance. In her first season at Stetson, Bria made an immediate impact on the recruiting trail as her 2009-10 incoming class was ranked by Michael T. White's noted scouting service All-Star Girls Report as the best in the Atlantic Sun and in the top third of all NCAA Division I teams.

Bria has coached women's basketball for 20 years with 14 seasons of Division I head coaching experience to her credit at UCF, Ohio University and Stetson. In addition to coaching, she has extensive classroom experience at the university level and is committed to developing young women both athletically and academically.

Prior to joining the Hatters, Bria spent the previous two seasons as an assistant coach at top-level programs West Virginia (2006-07) and most recently the University of Miami. Her excellent recruiting skills led to the Hurricanes signing a Top 25 incoming class according to recruiting experts at www.HoopGurlz.com. With WVU, Bria served as recruiting coordinator in addition to her on-court coaching duties. Her leadership helped the Mountaineers achieve one of their best seasons in school history, which featured an at-large bid to and second round appearance in the NCAA Tournament as well as the second-largest turnaround in W-L record in Big East Conference history (15-16 to 21-11 overall and from 4-12 to 11-5 in Big East games).

From 1999-2006, Bria was the head coach at Ohio University in Athens, Ohio. She is second all-time in career wins at Ohio and was the first coach in Bobcats history to sign a recruit that would become Mid-American Conference Freshman of the Year.

Prior to taking the position at Ohio, Bria led UCF for three seasons from 1996-99. Her final Golden Knights team in 1998-99 was the TAAC (now Atlantic Sun) regular season and tournament champions and appeared in the NCAA Tournament. For her efforts, Bria was named the 1998-99 TAAC Coach of the Year. In just three seasons, she ranked second in career wins at UCF.

Bria's first head coaching position came at Division II Texas Woman's University in Denton, Texas for three seasons from 1993-96. At the age of 24, Bria was the fourth-youngest head coach in the country when she was hired. She coached the team, coordinated fundraising and taught in the Kinesiology department in addition to serving on the NCAA Division II Tournament regional selection committee. Her Pioneer squads won more games each year of her tenure than the one previously.

Her first three years out of college at the University of Charleston (W. Va.) were spent on the coaching staffs at Marshall (where she obtained her Master's degree in 1992) and Radford, where she helped lead the Highlanders to the Big South regular season and tournament titles in 1992-93.

A standout performer for the Charleston Golden Eagles, the Class of 1990 graduate was inducted into her alma mater's Athletic Hall of Fame in 2003. She scored 1,146 points in her career, averaging 10.3 points pergame and was a 75.3 percent free throwshooter over her career.



The Stetson women's basketball team began Atlantic Sun Conference play Monday with a convincing 74-41 victory over host Mercer at Hawkins Arena in Macon. Ga

Victoria McGowan and Sasha Sims each scored 21 points as the Hatters (8-4, 1-0 A-Sun) won for the seventh time in their last eight games.

"I really liked our defense, I thought we played very tough," Stetson head coach Lynn Bria said. "Mercer is probably the most improved team in our league, and you have to guard them because they can score points in a hurry. We had a really good team effort."

The Hatters also exceled on offense, topping the 70-point mark for the fifth straight game. Stetson shot a season-high 56.3 percent from the floor and used a 16-0 run across halftime en route to the 33-point victory.

Playing the first game of a two-game road swing, Stetson was able to start conference play on a winning note.

"I think it's really important, especially when you open up on the road," Bria said. "Anytime you get wins on the road it's a bonus. We played well, and I am really pleased with how we played more than anything."

McGowan and Sims combined to hit 16 of their 23 shots from the floor. McGowan went 8-for-11 and hit four threes, while Sims was 8-for-12 including a pair of buckets from behind the arc. She also added two assists, two blocks, and a steal.

"I thought Sasha Sims gave us probably her best game of the year, and it came at a great time," Bria said. "She is our most versatile player and hopefully she can keep it going in 2013."

Adding to the offensive effort was Shanasa Sanders with eight points and five assists, while Cherisse Burris, Janelle Mills, and Jama Sharp chipped in six points apiece.

"Getting off to a good start in conference is key, especially for us," Sims said. "We executed the game plan very well today. We also seem to be very comfortable playing in this gym."

The Hatters have played well of late at Hawkins Arena, winning eight of their last nine games including conference tournament games. Mercer will host the A-Sun Championship again in 2013.

McGowan surpassed the 1200-point mark for her career, becoming the 14th player in school history to do so. She led the Hatters with nine rebounds, but the Bears (6-6, 0-1 A-Sun) held a 38-27 advantage on the boards.

The Stetson women's basketball team captured the no. 2 seed for next week's Atlantic Sun Conference tournament with a 74-60 victory over Mercer in the regular season finale Saturday afternoon at the Edmunds Center.

Stetson will play seventh-seeded ETSU in the quarterfinals on Wednesday at 6 p.m.

Sasha Sims scored a career-high 27 points on 9-of-15 shooting as the Hatters (21-8, 14-4 A-Sun) set a school-record for most conference victories in a single-season.

Victoria McGowan added 12 points and 11 rebounds for her 13th career double-double, while Jama Sharp pulled down a career-high 13 rebounds.

In an intense, physical battle which may be a precursor to the style of play coming in the postseason, the Hatters led by as many as 13 points in the first half before taking a 33-27 lead into halftime.

"Mercer is a much improved team, they are much better than they were when we played them earlier this season," Stetson head coach Lynn Bria said. "We kind of kept a 10-to-12 point lead for a while, but Mercer decreased it right before halftime.

"I thought our response in the first five minutes in the second half was really good," Bria added. "We got two quick steals and four points and kind of got more of a cushion there."

Both teams traded baskets throughout the second half, but the Hatters never let Mercer get any closer than eight the rest of the way.

"Sasha is playing at such a high level right now and really carried us today," Bria said. "She did such a great job on their post player and that's hard work. I thought Shanasa did a great job on Precious Bridges, and we had a lot of other kids step up as well."

Bridges came into the game as the leading scorer in the Atlantic Sun, averaging over 17 points per game. With a strong defensive effort led by Sanders, Bridges finished with just two points and was held without a field goal in 13 attempts.

"We knew if we held her under her scoring average, we would have a good chance at winning," Sanders said about Bridges. "My main focus was to rebound, play defense, and then the offense picked up from there."

Stetson shot 42% for the game and outrebounded Mercer (19-10, 13-5) 41-38.
